Step 5: If an even number follows an odd number (non-prime) then the even number is the resultant.

Step 6: If an odd number follows an odd number (non-prime) then the odd number that follows the non-prime odd number, is the resultant.

Step 7: [Priority rule] If any number in the column is a factorial of a number (Except 1 and 2) then the resultant of that column would be that number.

Resultant of all three columns can be found out by adding the resultants of three columns.
