1. Article 370 of the constitution grants special status to Jammu and Kashmir. Article 370 is included in which part of Constitution: **XXI**
 - Article 370 is included in Part XXI of the Constitution which grants a special status Jammu and Kashmir
 - Under the same Part XXI of the Constitution, many other states of the Indian Union also enjoy special status
2. Who can initiate impeachment of the President? **one-fourth members of that house**
 - The Impeachment charges can be initiated in either of the houses of the Parliament with atleast one-fourth members of that house signing the charges
 - A 14 day notice should be given to the President
 - The house should pass this resolution with a majority of two-thirds of the total membership of the house and then send it to the other house
 - The second house should investigate the charges and President has the right to appear and to be represented at such an investigation
 - If the second house also passes the resolution with two-thirds majority of the total membership of the house, then the President stands impeached from that date
3. Which article promotes equal justice and free legal aid for all the citizens? **39A**
 - Article 39A- Promotes equal justice and free legal aid for all the citizens
 - Article 32- Regarding constitutional remedies
 - Article 43A- Article 43A of the Constitution of India deals with 'Participation of workers in management of industries
 - Article 48A- Protection and improvement of environment and safeguarding of forests and wild life
4. Right to Privacy as a Fundamental Right is implied in: **Right to Life and Personal Liberty**
 - According to Supreme Court privacy is a fundamental right as it is intrinsic to the right to life. Right to Privacy is an integral part of Right to Life and Personal Liberty guaranteed in Article 21 of the Constitution
5. Safdarjung's tomb, set in the middle of a garden, was built by nawab Shuja-ud-daulah in: **Delhi**
6. Viyahula Giddha' is a popular folk dance performed during marriages in the Indian state of: **Punjab**

 - It is performed during marriages in the Indian state of Punjab

10. Which is a vestigial organ in human body? **Tailbone**

- Some examples of vestigial organ of human body are: tailbone, wisdom teeth, appendix, body hair etc

11. Which liquid is contained inside the nucleus of a cell? **Nucleoplasm**

- Nucleoplasm is a liquid contained inside the nucleus of a cell. Nucleoplasm is a type of protoplasm and enveloped by the nuclear membrane. It is made up of water, a mixture of various molecules and dissolved ions. It contains chromosomes and nucleolus

- Cytoplasm is contained inside the cell similarly as nucleoplasm is contained inside the nucleus

- Nucleosome is also contained inside the cell but it is not a liquid

12. The histogen, from which epidermis is formed is: **Dermatogen**

- There are three meristematic layers in plants which consist of three sets of initials known as histogen. Dermatogen is the outer most layers, the cells of which divide anticlinally and give rise to the epidermis, Periblem and plerom are the other two histogene

13. The Council of Ministers is collectively responsible to the : **People's House (Lok Sabha)**

- Article 75 (3) of the Indian Constitution stipulates that The Council of Ministers is collectively responsible to the Lok Sabha

- That is a vote of no confidence even against a single Minister means the entire Council must resign

- Ministers are also responsible for their departments & can be removed from the office by President on the advice of the Prime Minister . This is essentially an individual responsibility under Article 75 (2)

14. Who was known as 'lady with Lamp'? **Florence Nightingale**

- Florence Nightingale was a celebrated English social reformer and statistician, and the founder of modern nursing. She came to prominence while serving as a manager of nurses trained by her during the Crimean War, where she organised the tending to wounded soldier

15. The stone formed in human kidney consist mostly of: **Calcium oxalate**

- Calcium oxalate (in archaic terminology, oxalate of lime) is a calcium salt of oxalic acid with the chemical formula CaC_2O_4 . It is a chemical compound that forms envelope-shaped crystals, known in plants as raphides

16. 'Misch Metal' is widely used in manufacture of: **Cigarette lighters**

- Mischmetal (Mischmetall - "mixed metal") is an alloy of rare earth elements

- A typical composition includes approximately 50% cerium and 25% lanthanum, with small amounts of neodymium and praseodymium

17. Which has no blood, but respire? **Hydra**

- The epidermis, which surrounds the hydra, is able to take in the oxygen from the water and helps it in respiration. Having a thin epidermis and lacking a respiratory system allows hydras and other organisms in this phylum to breathe using passive diffusion

18. Where do plants synthesize protein from? **Amino Acids**

19. Who of the following is known as 'Father of Zoology'? **Aristotle**

- Aristotle is known as the 'Father of Biology' as well as "Father of Zoology"

- Theophrastes earns the title of 'Father of Botany
