#### **Important Days**

1. The 77th anniversary of the August Kranti Din, was observed all across the country on\_\_\_8th August 2019. Note:

On this date in 1942, Mahatma Gandhi gave a clarion call to end the British rule and launched the Quit India Movement at the session of the All-India Congress Committee in Mumbai.

Gandhiji gave the call to Do or Die in his Quit India speech delivered at the Gowalia Tank Maidan in Mumbai.

2. The International Day of the World's Indigenous People is being observed each year on \_\_\_\_\_9th August.

#### Note:

- > The theme of this year is 'Indigenous Languages'.
- On December 23, 1994, The United Nations General Assembly proclaimed 9th August as the International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples through its resolution 49/214.
- 3. World Biofuel Day is observed every year on \_\_\_\_10th August.

#### Note:

- The day create awareness about the importance of non-fossil fuels as an alternative to conventional fossil fuels and highlight the various efforts made by Government in the biofuel sector.
- 4. The World Elephant Day (WED) is celebrated every year on \_\_\_\_12th August.

#### Note:

- The goal of International Elephant Day is to create awareness of the urgent plight of African and Asian elephants and to share knowledge and management of captive & wild elephants.
- > On 12 August 2012, the first international Elephant Day was celebrated.
- As per the census conducted in 2017, the Elephant population in India is estimated at 29,964.
- 5. The International Youth Day (IYD) is observed every year on \_\_\_\_12th August.

#### Note:

- > The theme for International Youth Day 2019 is "Transforming education".
- International Youth Day 2019 will examine how Governments, young people and youth-led and youth-focused organizations, as well as other stakeholders, are transforming education and how these efforts are contributing to the achievement the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
- 6. The festival of sacrifice is being celebrated with religious fervour and gaiety across the country **\_\_\_Eid-ul-Azha**. **Note:** 
  - > The faithful will offer Eid prayers in Eidgahs and mosques.
  - The festival is an ode to the virtues of devotion, faith and sacrifice and inspires feelings of brotherhood, compassion and unity.
  - ▶ In the Islamic lunar calendar, Eid al-Adha falls on the 10th day of Dhu al-Hijjah and lasts for three days.
  - In the international (Gregorian) calendar, the dates vary from year to year shifting approximately 11 days earlier each year.

#### **New Appointments**

 Who has been appointed as Chairman and managing director (MD) of the State-owned Power Grid Corporation of India\_ Kandikuppa Sreekant.

#### Note:

- > Previously he was working as Director (Finance) in the Power Grid Corporation.
- > According Ministry of Power order, the tenure of Kandikuppa Sreekant will be till 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023.
- 2. Who has been appointed as the brand ambassador for the Chief Minister's Green Manipur Mission\_\_\_**Valentina** Elangbam.

#### Note:

Manipur's Valentina Elangbam (12-years) was seen weeping profusely in a viral video after two trees that she had planted were cut down.

  - > Alejandro Giammattei will assume office on **14th January 2020**.

- Union HRD Minister Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' has launched a drive to create awareness about Water Conservation among all school Children in the country \_\_\_\_Samagra Shiksha-Jal Suraksha. Note:
  - ote:
    - Inspired by Prime Minister's impetus to Jal Sanchay, Government of India has launched the Jal Shakti Abhiyan (JSA).
    - This concept of water conservation is essential for students so that they can understand the importance of water and how it is shaping their lives meaningfully, thereby enabling them to participate in water conservation activities in their day to day lives.
- 2. Researchers from the **IIT Madras** and **National Institute of Ocean Technology** (NIOT) are developing turbines that can harness the power of ocean waves to \_\_\_\_**generate electricity**.

#### Note:

- India's long coastline and many estuaries and gulfs provide ample opportunities to harness wave power to meet rising energy needs.
- The Department of Ocean Engineering, IIT Madras, under the aegis of the Indian Government's Department of Ocean Development has been working to bring wave energy closer to reality since 1983.
- The most recent research IIT Madras in collaboration with National Institute of Ocean Technology, is being funded by ministry of earth sciences.
- 3. Who has signed an agreement with **United Nations Industrial Development Organization** (UNIDO) to initiate a skill development programme for different levels of beneficiaries in the solar thermal energy sector <u>National Institute of Solar Energy (NISE)</u>.

Note:

- Under the agreement NISE and UNIDO will engage national and international experts to bring the best practices by developing specialized training material.
- The agreement is part of the ongoing MNRE-GEF-UNIDO project implemented jointly by UNIDO and to support capacity building and skill development of technical manpower in the Concentrated Solar Thermal Energy Technologies (CST).
- **4.** PIBA special postage stamp to be released to commemorate golden jubilee of \_\_\_\_\_IFFI. Note:
  - > The festival will take place from the **20th to 28th November** in Goa.
  - Competition for designing the Postage Stamp and First Day Cover has been launched by the Ministry of Information & Broadcasting on MyGov platform.
  - > Those interested may log in on to www.mygov.in to participate in the competition.
  - The contest is open till 15th August. The winner will receive a Certificate of Appreciation along with travel and hospitality for three nights and three days to Goa to attend the Festival.

  - It has been launched with a view to make aspirants aware of job opportunities in government sector including public sector enterprises.

- 7. Home Minister Amit Shah has released a book titled \_\_\_\_\_Listening, Learning & Leading. Note:
  - > The book was released in Chennai at a function organised by Information and Broadcasting Ministry.
  - The book also showcases the Vice President's feat as the Rajya Sabha Chairman in enhancing its effectiveness and promoting its efficiency.
  - The book captures the glimpses of the Vice President's 330 public engagements across the country in the last two years.
- 8. The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has increased the fees (from Rs 50 to Rs 1,200) of Class 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> board examinations for \_\_\_\_\_ SC and ST students.

#### Note:

- According to the revised norms, the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students will have to pay Rs 1,200 for five subjects, while earlier they were supposed to pay Rs 50 for the same, a hike of 24 times.
- > The general category students who were paying Rs 750 earlier, will now pay Rs 1,500 for five subjects.
- The students enrolled in CBSE schools abroad will have to pay Rs 10,000 for five subjects for both Class 10 and 12. Earlier it was Rs 5000.
- 9. Union ministers Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank and Gajendra Singh Shekhawat have launched the Suraksha drive to promote water conservation activities among school students Samagra Shiksha-Jal.

#### Note:

- > They have launched the drive at Kendriya Vidyalaya Number 2 at Delhi Cantonment.
- The Department of School Education and Literacy under the HRD Ministry has started the drive to promote water conservation activities among school students so that they can become competent, conscientious and committed citizens of the nation.
- > The department has prepared a detailed outline to implement the programme in all the schools of the country.

#### Note:

#### Note:

- > The song is sung by singer Javed Ali penned by lyricist Alok Shrivastav and musically composed by Dushyant.
- > The patriotic song is produced by **Doordarshan**.
- The song highlights several paths breaking initiatives of the government including the determination and vision behind the recent successful launch of "Chandrayaan 2".
- It also shows PM Modi flagged off India's fastest train the Vande Bharat Express as well as Yoga Day celebrations.

Note:

Note:

- On 31st October, the President's assent to the newly passed Jammu and Kashmir Re-organization Act comes into effect.
- > According to the new Act, UT J&K will have Assembly while Ladakh will be UT without a Legislature
- The Ladakh UT will have three districts that are Leh, Kargil and Ladakh while the rest 12 districts will remain with J&K UT.
- > Each UT will be governed by a separate **Lieutenant Governor (LG)**.
- **16.** Jammu and Kashmir government will host a three-day Global Investors Summit 2019 in \_\_\_\_Srinagar.

Note:

- The first-ever summit in the state will provide J&K with an opportunity to showcase its strengths, strategies and potential.
- The summit will provide an opportunity to allay fears and apprehensions in the minds of outside trade and the business community.
- **17.** India has contributed **one million US Dollars** to the **United Nations Special Purpose Trust Fund** for \_\_\_\_\_**the Resident Coordinator System.**

Note:

- According to the UN information, Special Purpose Trust Fund (SPTF) is a specific fund housed within the UN Secretariat, established to receive, consolidate, manage all contributions and financial transactions of the new Resident Coordinator system in a transparent and effective way.
- > SPTF web portal, displays in real-time all commitments, contributions and expenditures recorded for the fund.

#### Important News - State

- 1. Who has topped the ranking in **Breastfeeding** and Infant and Young Child Feeding Practices in the country\_\_\_\_ **Manipur.** Note:
  - > Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Bihar are at the **bottom positions** in the report card.
  - > National capital Delhi is also among the worst-performing States.
  - The Breastfeeding report card has been developed by devising a composite score based on three indicators namely early initiation of breastfeeding, exclusive breastfeeding for six months and complimentary feeding at 6-8 months of child's age.
- 2. An expedition team of mountaineers were flagged off by Union Minister of State for Defense Shripad Yesso Naik to \_\_\_\_\_Mount Elbrus, Russia.

Note:

- The team is aiming to hoist the Indian national flag atop the mountain on Aug 15, on the occasion of the 73rd Independence Day of India.
- The expedition team of eight professionals from Himalayan Mountaineering Institute (HMI) in Darjeeling, led by its principal GP Captain Jaikishan.
- > The team will also perform 'asanas' atop the mountain in an attempt to showcase the importance of Yoga to the international community.





3. Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu has launched the Jharkhand government's \_\_\_\_\_Mukhya Mantri Krishi Ashirwad Yojana.

#### Note:

- The objective of the 'Chief Minister Krishi Aashirwad Yojana' is to provide financial assistance to the farmers of Jharkhand and to help the farmers facing problems in agriculture due to loans.
- > The target of providing financial assistance of Rs. 3 thousand crores to 35 lakh farmers of the state are set.
- > In the first phase of this scheme, 15 lakh farmers of the state will be given the benefit of the scheme.
- 4. Thousands of students and members of several social organizations unfurled a 15-km long national flag by forming a

#### human chain in \_\_\_\_\_Raipur, Chhattisgarh.

Note:

- Thousands of people and students from various schools created a human chain while holding the 15-km long tricolour from Amapara Chowk to Pt Ravishankar Shukla University.
- > The event has been organized by Vasudgaiv Kutumbakam Foundation.
- 5. Who has initiated a massive drive to provide more than **28000 agro-machines/farm equipment** to farmers\_\_\_**Punjab Agriculture Department.**

Note:

- Subsidy component of 278 crore rupees will be provided for the scheme during the current fiscal year under the first phase for in-situ management of paddy residue.
- Subsidy ranging from 50 per cent to 80 per cent is being provided to the farmers under the scheme with 80 per cent subsidy to cooperative societies and farmers groups while 50 per cent for individuals.
- The Agriculture Department has fully geared up to complete the task of distribution of this equipment before 15th September this year.
- 6. Karnataka Government has launched an initiative to empower student start-ups\_\_\_\_ E-Step.

Note:

- The "E-Step" initiative has been launched by The Department of IT, BT and S&T in Karnataka, through Karnataka Innovation and Technology Society (KITS).
- Under the E-step initiative boot camps, mentoring and training programmes will be organised which will cover various aspects of entrepreneurship.
- The programme is specially crafted for students/start-ups/entrepreneurs to understand the basics of entrepreneurship from experienced trainers.
- 7. West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has inaugurated the world's first museum in Kolkata on \_\_\_\_\_Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu.

Note:

- > The museum has been constructed by Baghbazar Gaydiya Mission.
- > The Chaitanya museum has paintings on one of the aspects of Lord Krishna's life known as 'Vrindavan Leela'.
- Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu was the 16th-century Bengali Hindu mystic and saint and the chief proponent of the Gaudiya Vaishnavism tradition within Hinduism.

#### Important News - World

- 1. American carrier rocket Falcon 9 lifts off successfully the Israeli communication satellite into the orbit\_\_\_\_AMOS-17. Note:
  - The rocket was launched from Cape Canaveral Air Force Station in Florida. Amos-17 is set to replace Amos-5 satellite launched in 2011.
  - Communication with Amos-5 was lost in 2015. Amos-17, built by Boeing, will provide Ka, Ku and C-band signal transmission and expand Israeli communications satellite operator Spacecom's coverage in Africa, the Middle East and Europe.

- 2. India and Bangladesh have agreed to set up a Joint Technical committee for optimum utilization of \_\_\_\_\_Ganges water. Note:
  - Both the countries also agreed to prepare a framework for interim water-sharing agreement for eight rivers including Feni, Gumti and Teesta.

Note:

- In its 2D form, gold becomes flexible that adds to its potential of being used more efficiently such as in bendable screens, electronic inks, medical diagnostic tests, and water purification systems.
- 4. Indian Railways has cancelled train after Pakistan suspended operations on its side\_\_Samjhauta Express. Note:
  - According to Northern Railway, Pakistan has cancelled the Samjhauta Express running between Lahore and Attari.
  - The railways run the train on Sundays from Delhi to Attari and back, while Pakistan used to run the train between Lahore and Attari.
  - The train (Samjhauta Express) was started on 22 July 1976 following the Shimla Agreement and ran between Amritsar and Lahore, a distance of about 52 km.
  - On 14 April 2000, in an agreement between Indian Railways and Pakistan Railways (PR), the distance was revised to cover just under three km.
- 5. India and Russia to **boost ties** to achieve USD **30 billion** bilateral trade by **\_\_2025**.

Note:

- Piyush Goyal (Commerce and Industry Minister) led a high-power delegation of Chief Ministers of Haryana, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh and Goa and about 140 Indian companies to Vladivostok, Russia (11-13 August 2019).
- Goyal underlined the need to diversify and deepen trade links in priority sectors, in order to meet the trade target of USD 30 billion by 2025.
- > The 5th Eastern Economic Forum will be held in September in Vladivostok, Russia.

#### Honor & Awards

1. India's transsexual women has won the Miss World Diversity beauty pageant 2019 for third consecutive year\_ Naaz Joshi.

Note:

- > The **transsexual beauty** has won the title in 2017 and 2018 as well to become the first person ever to win the title for three consecutive years.
- > This **beauty contest** was held in **Port Louis, Mauritius**.
- She has also been crowned as Miss Republic International Beauty Ambassador 2017 and Miss United Nationals Ambassador.
- 2. As part of **centenary year celebrations** of **Dr Vikram Sarabhai**, the **Indian Space Research Organization** (ISRO) has announced **two categories** of awards in\_\_\_\_\_ **Journalism.**

Note:

- The first category holds a cash price of Rs 5,00,000, a medal and citation and two journalists or freelancers of print media will be awarded.
- The second category of the award holds 3 cash prizes of Rs 3,00,000, 2,00,000 and 1,00,000 and citation each for journalists or freelancers of print media.
- "Vikram Sarabhai Journalism Award in Space Science, Technology and Research" is to recognize and reward journalists who have actively contributed towards the field of space science, applications, and research.
- 3. A team of researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati (IIT-G) has developed a portable device to detect bacteria without \_\_\_\_\_Microbiological assays.

Note:

- > The hand-held device, with bio-compatible sensor can also diagnose time-critical illnesses such as meningitis.
- > The present techniques are extremely time- consuming. Currently, cells derived from a patient are cultured or grown in laboratories to detect and microanalyse bacteria.
- The research has enabled rapid detection of bacteria, which is not just important in healthcare but also in antibioterrorism measures and environmental monitoring.
- **4.** President Ram Nath Kovind conferred country's highest civilian award Bharat Ratna \_\_\_\_\_ **Pranab Mukherjee, Bhupen Hazarika & Nanaji Deshmukh.**

- > **Pranab Mukherjee** received the award from the President, at a function in Rashtrapati Bhawan.
- Bhupen Hazarika's son Tej Hazarika received the award on his behalf. While a relative of Nanaji Deshmukh, Virender Jeet Singh received the award for him.
- Nanaji Deshmukh was born in 1916 in a Marathi family in Parbhani, Maharashtra. As a child, he was inspired by freedom fighter Bal Gangadhar Tilak.
- > Nanaji established India's first Saraswati Sishu Mandir at Gorakhpur in 1950.
- Bharat Ratna Awardee receives a certificate known as 'Sanad' signed by the President of India and a medallion.
- **5.** The policy think tank of the government of India has launched the Fourth Edition of Women Transforming India (WTI) Awards \_\_\_\_\_ NITI Aayog.

Note:

- The Women Transforming India (WTI) Awards is being organized in collaboration with the United Nations to recognize women entrepreneurs from across India.
- > This year's theme is **'women and Entrepreneurship'**, in continuation of the theme for WTI Awards 2018.
- During the launch Amitabh Kant, CEO NITI Aayog, Ms. Renata Lok-Dessallien, UN Coordinator in India and partners of Women Entrepreneurship Platform (WEP) were present.
- 6. Indian Air Force's (IAF) Wing Commander has been honoured with Vir Chakra <u>Abhinandan Varthaman</u>. Note:
  - > The Vir Chakra is the third highest wartime gallantry award after the Param Vir Chakra and Maha Vir Chakra.
  - Wg Cdr Abhinandan had sustained injuries while ejecting from his MiG-21 Bisonduring the aerial combat between Indian and Pakistani air forces on February 27.
  - IAF Squadron Leader Minty Agarwal will also be honoured with Yudh Seva Medal for her role as a fighter controller during the 27th February aerial conflict between India and Pakistan.
  - Indian Army's Sapper Prakash Jadhav of 1 Rashtriya Rifles (Mahar) will also be conferred Kirti Chakra (posthumously), for the role he played in an operation in Jammu and Kashmir.
- 7. The first Indian chef has been awarded the Chevalier de l'Ordre du Mrite Agricoleto \_\_ Priyam Chatterjee. Note:
  - The Order of Agricultural Merit is an order of merit bestowed by the French Republic for outstanding contributions to agriculture.
  - > He has been awarded for his contribution towards reinventing the gastronomic scene in India.
  - Priyam is known for revisiting the traditional dishes from his native state of West Bengal and giving it a French twist.

#### **Sports News**

Who have been selected for the upcoming women's world boxing championships to be held in Russia\_\_\_M C Mary Kom & Lovlina Borgohain.

#### Note:

- Mary Kom (36-years) has already claimed two gold medals this year India Open and a recent tournament in Indonesia, has been selected in the 51kg category.
- > While World and Asian bronze-medallist Borgohain will be competing in the 69kg category.
- 2. Former Uruguay captain has announced his official retirement at the age of 40-years\_\_\_Diego Forlan. Note:
  - > In 2011, the striker helped Uruguay win the Copa America, a competition both his father and grandfather won.

ATTEMPT NOW

- > He was also named the best player at the 2010 World Cup in South Africa where Uruguay finished fourth.
  - > He scored 36 goals in 112 matches for his country.
- **3. South African** player announced his retirement from all forms of international cricket\_\_\_\_\_ **Hashim Amla. Note:** 
  - > Hashim Amla made his international debut in a Test match vs India in Kolkata in 2004
  - > Amla played 349 matches across three formats for the Proteas, scoring more than 18 000 runs
  - Amla is the fastest batsman to reach 2000, 3000, 4000, 5000, 6000 and 7000 ODI runs
- 4. Who suspended the Archery Association of India (AAI) for defying its guidelines by electing two parallel bodies\_\_\_\_\_\_ World Archery (WA).

#### Note:





- The decision is effective from 12th August and the last event in which the archers can participate under the Indian flag is the World Archery Youth Championships in Madrid from 19th to 25th of this month.
- Olympic quota places will be up for grabs at the Asian Championships and Asian Para Championships, to be held in Bangkok in November.
- > India so far have three men's places secured for the next Olympics but has yet to win a women's spot.
- 5. Former New Zealand captain announced his retirement from all forms of competitive cricket\_\_\_\_ Brendon McCullum. Note:
  - McCullum, who is playing for Toronto Nationals, had retired from all forms of international cricket in 2016 but continued to ply his trade in various T20 leagues across the globe.
  - The 37-year-old former Black Caps skipper has played 101 Tests in which he scored 6453 runs with 12 hundred and highest score of 302.
  - ▶ In 260 ODIs, he scored 6083 runs with five hundred while 71 T20 Internationals fetched him 2140 runs.
- 6. As per Forbes list of the highest-paid female athletes 2019, Who has topped in the annual list for a 4th the consecutive year\_\_\_\_ Serena Williams.

- She has topped the annual list for a 4th the consecutive year with estimated total earnings of USD 29.2 million.
- Naomi Osaka (Japan) was 2nd on the list with earnings of USD 24.3 million.

- ▶ US World Cup-winning striker Alex Morgan is the first non-tennis player at 12 after earning \$5.8m (£4.77m).
- 7. Indian junior shuttlers have won **six medals** (gold-3, silver-1 and bronze-2) at the Bulgarian Junior International

Championships in \_\_\_\_\_Pazardzhik, Bulgaria.

Note:

- The gold medals were won by Samiya Imad Faruqui in women's singles, the duo of Edvin Joy and Shruti Mishra in Mixed Doubles and pair of Tanisha Crasto and Aditi Bhatt in women's doubles.
- Men's doubles combination of Ishan Bhatnagar and Vishnuvardhan settled for the silver medal.
- > Malvika Bansod and Meiraba Luwang won a bronze each in other singles events.
- 8. Who clinched the **Men's Singles title** in the Hyderabad Open Badminton title\_\_\_\_**Sourabh Verma.** Note:
  - He beat Singapore's Loh Kean Yew 21-13, 14-21, 21-16 in a 52-minute final clash.
  - Earlier, Sourabh had won two Super 100 titles last year at the Dutch Open and Russian Open.
  - > Top seeds Ashwini Ponnappa and N Sikki Reddy, however, finished runners up in women's doubles.
  - The 2019 Hyderabad Open was a badminton tournament which took place at G. M. C. Balayogi SATS Indoor Stadium in Hyderabad, India.
- 9. India's top wrestler has won the gold medal at Tbilisi Grand Prix in Georgia \_\_\_\_\_Bajrang Punia. Note:
  - ▶ He defeated Iran's Peiman Bibyani by 2-0 in the 65 kg final of the men's freestyle competition.
  - It is fourth gold of the season for Bajrang after standing atop the podium at Dan Kolov, Asian Championship and Ali Aliev tournament.
  - Tbilisi Grand Prix of V. Balavadze and G. Kartozia is organised by the Georgian Wrestling Federation at the New Sports Palace, Georgia.
- **10.** The **Board of Control for Cricket in India** (BCCI) has agreed to **come under** the ambit of the \_\_\_\_\_**National Anti-Doping Agency**.

Note:

- This landmark decision makes Indian Cricket's governing body a sports federation as per government norms despite being financially autonomous.
- The National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) is the national organization responsible for promoting, coordinating, and monitoring the doping control program in sports in all its forms in India.

### **11.** Who has become the **first Indian** to claim a world title in **motorsports** in women's category \_\_\_\_\_ **Aishwarya Pissay.** Note:

- Earlier, Aishwarya has won the first round in Dubai.
- Aishwarya, who won the first round in Dubai and was placed third (Portugal), fifth (Spain) and fourth (Hungary) in the subsequent outings, finished with a tally of 65 points, just four ahead of Portugal's Rita Vieira in the final overall standings for women.

- > It is the 139th edition (for the men) and the 128th (for the women) of the Canadian Open.

#### Note:

- One of the 32 freedom fighters from **Panimora**, he joined the Quit India movement against the British government and was a devout follower of Mahatma Gandhi.
- > During the Quit India movement, he was jailed for nine months.
- 5. Ivorian musician passed away after getting involved in an ugly road accident\_ Houon Ange Didier.

#### Note:

- DJ Arafat(33-year) issued 11 albums, mainly of "coupe-decale", a dance music form combining rapid percussion, choppy rhythms with hip hop-style vocals.
- > He was also named "Best Artist of the Year" at the Ivorian "Coupe-decale" Awards in 2016 and 2017.

#### 6. Senior advocate and former Additional Solicitor General passed away\_\_\_Amarendra Sharan.

#### Note:

- Sharan was the Additional Solicitor General in the Supreme Court from 2004 to 2009.
- In 2008, Sharan won the award for "outstanding contribution for the development of scientific jurisprudence" on National Law Day.
- The senior advocate was amicus curiae in the Supreme Court in the case related to the SC/ST Act last year and another related to Mahatma Gandhi's assassination.
