1. Madhya Pradesh set to get its seventh tiger reserve

- Madhya Pradesh is set to get its 7th tiger reserve which has been proposed to be carved out of the Ratapani wildlife sanctuary; will be known as the Ratapani Tiger Reserve.
- The Ratapani wildlife sanctuary is spread over the area of Raisen and Sehore districts of Madhya Pradesh.
- Other six Tiger Reserves in Madhya Pradesh are o Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve, Sanjay Dubri Tiger Reserve, Panna Tiger Reserve, BoriSatpura Tiger Reserve, Kanha Tiger Reserve, Pench Tiger Reserve.

Tiger Reserves

- These are established under the Project Tiger in 1973.
- Jim Corbett in Uttarakhand is the first Tiger Reserve to be established under Project Tiger.
- According to the All India Tiger Estimation Report– 2018, Madhya Pradesh has the highest number of tigers followed by Karnataka and Uttarakhand.

2. Crime in India Report 2017

- Recently after a delay of two years, the annual Crime in India Report 2017 was published by the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB).
- National Crime Records Bureau- It is a nodal agency under Union Home Ministry for the authentic source of data on crime on various parameters including accidents, suicides from across all the states of the country and prisons for policy matters and research
- Highlights of the report
Uttar Pradesh topped the list followed by Maharashtra and West Bengal in the number of cases.

3. Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board has organized a month-long City Walk Festival in 11 cities

- The City Walk Festival organized in Bhopal, Indore, Ujjain, Gwalior, Panna, Vidisha, Khajuraho, Chanderi, Jabalpur, Burhanpur and Orchha.
