1. First e-waste clinic in India has been opened in Bhopal.

- India's first e-waste clinic has been opened in Bhopal by **Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB)** and **Bhopal Municipal Corporation**.
- It is a trial project established for 3 months, if successful, other clinics will be opened across the country on the same lines.

2. Mukhyamantri karmachari swasthya bima yojana

- According to the scheme Rs 5 lakh for general illness and Rs 10 lakh for critical illness & Cashless treatment facility up to Rs 10,000 per annum in OPD (Outpatient Department) will be provided, also, free medicines will be distributed.
- This scheme will benefit all the current and retired employees of the state government.

3. Madhya Pradesh government has made the reading of preamble of the constitution mandatory in all schools of the state.

- MP is the second state after Maharashtra that has made reading of preamble mandatory in the schools.

4. Indore has topped the Swacchsurvekshan League 2020 among cities which have more than 10 lakh population

- Indore was followed by Bhopal.
- Swacchsurvekshan was started in the year 2016.
- West Bengal did not participate in the theswacchsurvekshan.

5. Suman kalyanpur and Kuldeep singh to get MP's Lata Mangeshkar award for 2017 and 2018 respectively

- Suman kalyanpur is an Indian singer and Kuldeep singh a music director. Both have been chosen for the award for their contribution to the field of music.
- The award consists of a cash prize of Rs 2 lakh along with a shawl, a citation and a 'shreephal' (coconut).
- The award has been instituted by MP in 1984-85 in honour of renowned singer Lata Mangeshkar (90 years). MP is the birthplace of the Lata.
- Music director Naushal Ali was the 1st person to receive the award in 1984-85.

6. 63rd National Shooting championship competitions 2019 held in Bhopal, MP

- Zeenakitta of himachal Pradesh won the women's national 10m Air Rifle.
- Saurabh Chaudhary of UP won the gold medal in men's 10m Air Pistol.

7. Bhopal's titular queen Saleha Sultan passed away at 80.

- Princess Saleha Sultan also known as Dimpu, the "titular queen of Bhopal" passed away in Hyderabad due to brain haemorrhage at the age of 80.

8. Sunita Chandra 76 years old, passed away in her hometown Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.

- She was an Arjuna awardee and also the captain of India's hockey team.
