#### **Banking & Financial Awareness**

1. Which financial company in collaboration with National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) launched 'Salary Card', a Zero-Touch Digital card \_\_\_\_\_ EarlySalary.

Note:

- The Salary Card credit solution is powered by Rupay. It provides instant access for salaried professionals, allowing them to make purchases instantly across merchants in India.
- Vivifi India Finance Private Limited (Vivifi) has launched FlexPay, which offers credit on Unified Payments Interface (UPI).
- 2. Which bank has collaborated with Apollo Hospitals to launch the "HealthyLife Programme", a holistic healthcare solution \_\_\_\_\_\_ HDFC Bank.

#### Note:

- This programme will be launched for HDFC Bank customers, to make healthy living accessible and affordable while making the process convenient and easy for the customers.
- Customers will get round the clock access to emergency Apollo Doctor at No Cost on Apollo's digital platform, Apollo 24|7.
- It will also come with various other benefits such as choice of payment options and ease of finance for treatments at all Apollo Hospitals.
- 3. With which entity the NITI Aayog has set up a Frontier Technologies Cloud Innovation Center (CIC) that will work on addressing societal challenges around areas like agriculture and healthcare through digital innovation \_\_\_\_\_ Amazon Web Services (AWS).

Note:

- The NITI Aayog Frontier Technologies Cloud Innovation Center is the first AWS CIC in India, and the first such centre that has been set up at a national level.
- It has such centres across countries like Australia, Bahrain, Canada, France, Germany, South Korea, and the US, including one in partnership with the University of British Columbia.
- Which bank will provide USD 346 million loan for power supply project in rural Maharashtra \_\_\_\_\_ Asian Development Bank.

#### Note:

- The program aims to provide efficient and reliable power to agricultural customers in Maharashtra's rural areas through adoption of HVDS that will help reduce distribution losses, and improve agricultural productivity and farmer incomes.
- The program will be implemented until March 2022, by which time about 1.50,000 metered HVDS connections are expected.
- 5. Which commodity exchange has launched futures trading in real-time Base Metals Index 'METLDEX' \_\_\_\_\_ Multi Commodity Exchange of India (MCX).

Note:

- The Base Metals Index will track real-time performance of a basket of MCX Base Metal (near month) futures that includes zinc, copper, nickel, lead, and aluminium.
- > Index trading will facilitate instant portfolio diversification and encourage passive, thematic elements in portfolios.
- > The Index will soon emerge as a new real time barometer for Indian metal industry.
- 6. Which company won \$14.1 million NASA contract to set up 4G network on Moon \_\_\_\_\_ Nokia.

Note:

The grant is part of \$370 million worth of contracts signed under NASA's "Tipping Point" selections, meant to advance research and development for space exploration.

Note:

- Recently, BondEvalue got approval as a global Recognised Market Operator (RMO) from the Monetary Authority of Singapore (MAS).
- The RMO allows BondbloX Bond Exchange (BBX), the world's first blockchain-based bond exchange, to trade globally a wide range of fixed-income securities.

1. Noted poet and 55th Jnanpith awardee Akkitham Achuthan Namboothiri passed away recently, he was a poet of which language \_\_\_\_\_ Malayalam.

#### Note:

- Akkitham also won the Sahitya Akademi Award in 1973.
- He became a household name in the 1950s when his work Irupatham Noottandinte Ithihasam, a khandakavya, which is one of the first modernist poems of Malayalam literature, gained popularity.
- ▶ It even won the Sanjayan Award in 1952.
- 2. Veteran Test cricketer John Reid passed away recently, for which country did he played \_\_\_\_\_ New Zealand. Note:
  - Reid, regarded as one of the world's best all-rounders during his heyday in the fifties and early sixties, captained New Zealand in 34 Tests including, most notably, the country's first three victories.
  - A hard-hitting right batsman and a seam bowler, he played 58 Tests after making his debut as a 19-year-old in 1949, scoring 3428 runs at 33.28, while taking 85 wickets at 33.35.
- 3. Renowned personality Shobha Naidu passed away recently, she was a veteran \_\_\_\_\_ Classical Dancer. Note:
  - Her major achievements include choreography and presentation of Ballets Vipranarayana, Kalyana Srinivasam and many others, in which she was the main protagonist and portrayed various roles like Satyabhama, Devadevaki, Padmavathi, Mohini, Sai Baba, and Goddess Parvati which won her great appreciation.
  - Some of the famous awards won by her includes, Padma Shri in 2001, Sangeet Natak Akademi in 1991.
- 4. Renowned personality Bhanu Athaiya passed away recently, she was a veteran \_\_\_\_\_ Costume Designer. Note:
  - She won the Best Costume Design Oscar for her work in the 1982 film Gandhi, directed by Richard Attenborough.
  - > In 2012, Athaiya returned her Oscar to the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences for safekeeping.
  - > Bhanu Athaiya had also designed costumes for over 100 Bollywood movies.
- 5. Renowned personality Kishore Bhimani passed away recently, he was a veteran \_\_\_\_\_ Journalist. Note:
  - He was a leading cricket commentator in the Eighties and Nineties and is best remembered for being on the air during the tied Test of 1986 between India and Australia in Chepauk, Chennai.
  - He had received a lifetime achievement award for his decades-long contribution in the fields of media and commentary in 2013.
- Legendary singer Kaumudi Munshi, passed away due to COVID 19, she is also known as 'Nightingale' of which state \_\_\_\_\_\_
  Gujarat.

#### Note:

- During the early stage of her career, Munshi sang mostly in Gujarati, gaining fame with songs like 'Sachi re maari satre bhavani maa'.
- The singer also sang Bhojpuri songs, for the 1963 movie Bidesiya she sang 'Neek Saiyan bin' with renowned singer Geeta Dutt.

    - In India, the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare observes the day as the Rashtriya Mahila Kisan Diwas since 2016, to increase the active participation of women in agriculture.

- 4. National Women Farmers' Day is observed every year on \_\_\_\_\_15th October. Note:
  - Mahila Kisan Diwas was celebrated at ICAR Institutes and Krishi Vigyan Kendras across the country to recognize the contribution of women in Agriculture.
  - The day was celebrated by ICAR-CIFRI with the hope to empower and leverage farm women with fisheries sector to bring Second Blue Revolution in the country.
- 5. World Food Day is observed every year on which date \_\_\_\_\_16th October.

#### Note:

- This day generates awareness globally for those who suffer from hunger and to ensure the need for food security and nutritious diets for all.
- > Theme 2020: "Grow, Nourish, Sustain. Together".
- 6. The World Statistics Day is observed every year on which date \_\_\_\_\_20th October.
  - Note:
    - The celebration of World Statistics Day 2020 is a global collaborative endeavour, organized under the guidance of the United Nations Statistical Commission.
    - > The World Statistics Day 2020 theme "Connecting the world with data we can trust."
    - > This theme reflects the importance of trust, authoritative data, innovation and the public good in national statistical systems.
- 7. The World Osteoporosis Day is observed every year on which date \_\_\_\_\_20th October. Note:
  - ➢ WOD is organized by the International Osteoporosis Foundation (IOF), by the launch of a year-long campaign with a specific theme.
  - In 2020 the Global WOD Campaign theme is "THAT'S OSTEOPOROSIS", highlighting emotionally impactful visuals and stories of real people living with osteoporosis in all regions of the world.

  - International Chef's day is celebrated on October 20 every year to honour the profession and educate people about healthy food.

- She was with RBI for over 37 years in different capacities.
- Her core competence is in the financial sector supervision but she has also been responsible for currency management, foreign exchange and the internal accounting and administration.
- 2. Who has been elected as the President of the Delhi and District Cricket Association (DDCA) \_\_\_\_\_ Rohan Jaitley. Note:
  - He was the single candidate left for the post, as the lone candidate who had filed his nomination against him withdrew his candidature.
  - The 31-year-old lawyer is slated to remain in the post till June 30, 2021. Notably, late Arun Jaitley had also served as the president of DDCA between 1999 and 2013.
- **3.** Jacinda Ardern has been elected as prime minister of which country for the second consecutive three-year term \_\_\_\_\_\_ New Zealand.

Note:

- In the battle against Covid, Ardern was alone among her western peers in pursuing an explicit elimination strategy and imposed one of the strictest nationwide lockdowns in the world.
- > Ardern's centre-left Labour Party won 49.2% of the total 83.7% votes counted in the 120-member parliament.
- 4. Who has been appointed as the chairman of the Indian Bank Association (IBA) for the term 2020-21 \_\_\_\_\_ Rajkiran Rai G.

#### Note:

- > Dinesh Kumar Khara, Chairman, State Bank of India, was elected as Deputy Chairman of the Association.
- > IBA is an association of banks and other entities in the banking ecosystem in India catering to its members.
- > The decision was taken during a meeting of the managing committee of IBA.
- 5. Who has been appointed as chief operating officer (COO) of Merchant payment network BharatPe \_\_\_\_\_ Dhruv Bahl. Note:
  - Merchant payment network BharatPe has elevated Dhruv Bahl as its chief operating officer (COO) with immediate effect.
  - In his new role, Bahl will be leading operations across customer support, deployments QR, Swipe & Cards, KYC, loan disbursals and lead generation.

- The project will have a total project cost of ₹5,718 crore, with the World Bank's support amounting to about ₹3,700 crore (\$500 million).
- A major component of the project is the establishment of PARAKH (Performance Assessment, Review, and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development) as a National Assessment Centre.
- On the occasion of 75th Anniversary of which organization Prime Minister Narendra Modi released a commemorative coin of Rs 75 denomination to mark the long-standing relation of India with the organization \_\_\_\_\_ FAO. Note:
  - > The Prime Minister also dedicated to the nation 17 recently developed biofortified varieties of eight crops.

  - > The MoU has been signed to promote cooperation in surface and groundwater training, education and research to achieve water security for agricultural, urban, industrial and environmental purposes.
- Under whose chairmanship the Central Government has formulated a panel of secretaries to streamline telecom spectrum allocation process and examine the possibility of making the auction of spectrum an annual calendar event \_\_\_\_\_ Rajiv Gauba.

- The panel comprises the secretaries of home, defence, railways, telecom, Information and Broadcasting (I&B) and department of space.
- The decision regarding formulation of the panel has been made on the lines of telecom sector demand for the requirement of a clear road map for auctioning spectrum enabling them to plan and allocate resources efficiently.

- What is India's rank in the "Global Hunger Index 2020" prepared jointly by Welthungerhilfe and Concern Worldwide \_\_\_\_\_94<sup>th</sup>.

Note:

- As per the report, India ranked 94th among 107countries.
- According to the report India has the highest prevalence of wasted children under five years in the world, which reflects acute undernutrition.
- **8.** What amount of loan will be provided by the National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) to the cooperatives under the recently launched Ayushman Sahakar Scheme \_\_\_\_\_ **Rs 10,000 crores.**

Note:

- > The scheme will assist the cooperatives to play a crucial role in creating health care infrastructure in the country.
- The scheme was formulated by the National Cooperative Development Corporation. The NCDC will provide loans of Rs 10,000 crores to the cooperatives under the scheme.
- > This includes financial assistance and working capital to meet operational requirements in health sector.
- 9. Who launched the development of Indigenous Software solution for Vessel Traffic Services (VTS) and Vessels Traffic Monitoring Systems (VTMS) in New Delhi \_\_\_\_\_ Mansukh Mandaviya.

Note:

> The launch of indigenous software is in line with Prime Minister's Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Mission.

- $\triangleright$ India has been recording an increase in PM 2.5 pollution since 2010 contrary to Centre's claims that annual air pollution levels in the country are coming down.
- 12. Which online portal has been launched by the Union Science and Technology Minister Harsh Vardhan that provides information about CSIR ushered repurposed drugs and their current stage of trials \_\_\_\_\_ CuRED.

#### Note:

- > The Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) has been exploring multiple combination clinical trials of antivirals with host-directed therapies for a potential treatment of COVID-19 since the beginning of the pandemic.
- > Apart from information about CSIR repurposed drugs, the website -- CuRED -- also provides details about clinical trials of diagnostics and devices in which the scientific body is involved.
- **13.** As per the Union Health Ministry the aim of the government is to make India Trans Fat free by **2022**.

#### Note:

- Chairing the event on World Food Day organized by FSSAI, Dr Harsh Vardhan said, due to the unprecedented  $\triangleright$ challenges faced by the world on account of the Covid pandemic, there has been a renewed focus on food. nutrition. health, immunity and sustainability.
- > He said, focus this year is on elimination of Trans Fats from the food supply chain.

- **16.** Which University bags first rank in India as stand-alone institution for filling highest number of patents in a year \_\_\_\_\_ Chandigarh University.

Note:

The annual rankings for the year 2018-19 was recently released by Office of Controller General of Patents, Designs  $\geq$ and Trademarks, Government of India which comprises of Academic Institutions and Multinational Companies.

- ▶ Four new Vice-Presidents were also chosen to represent the four regions of ISA.
- The representatives of Fiji & Nauru for Asia Pacific Region; Mauritius & Niger for Africa Region; UK & Netherlands for Europe and others Region, and Cuba and Guyana for Latin America and Caribbean Region assumed the vice presidency.
