Govt rolls out Aatmanirbhar Bharat Rozgar Yojana

- Union Finance Minister has announced new scheme named as **Aatmanirbhar Bharat Rozgar Yojana** to incentivize job creation during COVID-19 recovery
- **Beneficiaries:** Any new employee joining employment in EPFO registered establishments on monthly wages less than Rs.15,000
- Centre will provide subsidy for 2 years in respect of new eligible employees engaged on or after 01.10.2020
- The scheme will be effective from October 1, 2020 and will be operational till 30th June 2021.

China successfully launches world's first 6G communications test satellite

- China has successfully launched world's first 6G experiment satellite, along with 12 other satellites into the orbit
- Satellites were launched from the Taiyuan Satellite Launch Center, Shanxi Province from Long March-6 carrier rocket
- With this, China has become the world's first country to test **6G technology**.
- 6G technology is expected to be over 100 times faster than 5G.
- The satellite can even be used for crop disaster monitoring and forest fire prevention.

Indian Navy Ship Vagir launched at Mazgaon Dock in Mumbai.

- Indian Navy's fifth Kalvari-class Diesel Electric attack submarine INS Vagir has been launched.
- It is being constructed by Mazagon Dock Ltd (MDL) in Mumbai.
- The other vessels in the class are INS Kalvari, INS Khanderi, INS Karanj, INS Vela and INS Vagsheer.
- Vagir has been named after a Sand Fish, a predatory marine species.
- Kalvari class of submarines design is based on Scorpene class of submarines of French defence major Naval Group and Spanish counterpart

Lonar Lake in Maharashtra selected under 'Ramsar site'

- **Lonar Lake** in Buldhana district of Maharashtra has been chosen as wetland site of international importance under Ramsar conservation treaty.
- Ramsar Site is a wetland site designated to be of international importance under the Ramsar Convention. whose name comes from Ramsar City of Iran, where this treaty was signed.
- **Ramsar Convention:** It is an intergovernmental environmental treaty established in 1971 by UNESCO and came into force in 1975.

Lewis Hamilton wins F1 Turkish Grand Prix 2020

- Mercedes racer Lewis Hamilton (Great Britain) has won 2020 Turkish Grand Prix at the Istanbul Park Circuit.
- This was his **10th victory of the season**, and 94th F1 victory of his career.
- It was the 14th F1 race of the 2020 season.
- With this victory, he claimed the seventh Formula One championships title of his career to equal the record of Michael Schumacher.







 Sergio Perez (Racing Point-BWT- Mexico) secured second position and Sebastian Vettel of Ferrari finished third.

Tristan da Cunha declared fully protected marine reserves in Atlantic Ocean

- Tristan da Cunha has been declared the largest fully protected marine reserves in the Atlantic Ocean at 687,000 square km
- **Tristan da Cunha:** Remote group of volcanic islands in south Atlantic Ocean. It is the most remote human settlement archipelago in the world
- It is home to 10 millions of seabirds and unique land birds
- After joining UK's Blue Belt, it will become the largest no-take zone in Atlantic
- This will close over 90% of their waters to harmful activities

Asia-Pacific countries sign world's biggest free trade deal

- 15 Asia Pacific countries have signed world's biggest free trade deal led by China on sidelines of 37th Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Summit.
- Deal titled as 'Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP)', is the world's largest trading bloc comprising of 10 Southeast Asian countries as well as South Korea, China, Japan, Australia, New Zealand
- RCEP members accounts for 1/3rd of world's population and 29% of GDP
- India has joined RCEP as an observer

World's first Tram library for children launched in Kolkata

- World's first library on tram for children, 'Kolkata Young Reader's Tramcar' was launched in Kolkata on the occassion of children's day (14 November 2020).
- Tram: Rail vehicle that runs on tramway tracks along public streets
- It will run on **Shyambazar-Esplanade and Esplanade-Gariahat routes**, spanning across north and south Kolkata, every day from morning to evening.
- It has been jointly developed by West Bengal Transport Corporation (WBTC) and Apeejay Anand Children's Library

Union Labour Ministry Notifies Draft Rules under Code on Social Security

- Union Ministry of Labour and Employment has notified draft rules under Code on Social Security, 2020 inviting objections and suggestions from the stakeholders.
- Duration for suggestions: 45 days
- Draft rules provide for operationalization of provisions in the Code on Social Security, 2020 relating to EPF, ESIC, Gratuity, Maternity Benefit, Social Security and Cess, Social Security for Unorganised Workers, Gig Workers and Platform Workers.

Keetham lake in Uttar Pradesh added to Ramsar sites

- **Keetham lake,** which is also known as Sur Sarovar, in Agra, Uttar Pradesh has been added to Ramsar sites list.
- The site was declared as National Bird Sanctuary in 1991 by U.P. Forest Department
- Recently, Lonar lake of Maharashtra and Kabartal of Bihar have also been given Ramsar status







- Ramsar Site: Wetland site designated to be of international importance under Ramsar Convention.
- Wetlands declared as Ramsar sites are protected under strict guidelines of the convention.

CSIR-SERC develops indigenous Emergency Retrieval System (ERS) for Power

- Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) lab Structural Engineering Research Centre (SERC), Chennai has developed indigenous technology named as Emergency Retrieval System (ERS), for quick retrieval of power transmission in the event of failure of transmission line towers.
- CSIR-SERC has signed an agreement for licensing with M/s Advait Infratech, Ahmedabad for this
- Currently, ERS systems are imported.
- It will reduce the cost enhancing Indian power sector.

Nitish Kumar takes oath as Chief minister of Bihar

- Nitish Kumar (NDA) took oath as the Chief Minister of Bihar at Patna's Raj Bhavan, administered by Bihar Governor Phagu Chauhan
- He has been sworn in as Bihar's CM for the seventh time.
- Tarkishore Prasad and Renu Devi from BJP were sworn in as deputy Chief Ministers
- 14 other ministers took oath, 5 from Janata Dal (United), 7 from BJP, and 1 each from Hindustani Awam Morcha (Secular) and Vikassheel Insaan Party (VIP).
- NDA won 125 seats in the 243-member assembly.

PM Modi unveils 'Statue of Peace' on Jainacharya Vallabh birth anniversary

- PM Narendra Modi has unveiled 'Statue of Peace' to mark 151st Birth Anniversary celebrations of Jainacharya Shree Vijay Vallabh Surishwer Ji Maharaj.
- It is 151 inch tall statue and has been made from Ashtadhatu (8 metals with Copper being the major constituent)
- It is being installed at Vijay Vallabh Sadhana Kendra, Pali, Rajasthan.
- Shree Vijay Vallabh: Jain Saint working selflessly to spread the message of Lord Mahavira, education, eradication of social evils, etc

International Crops Research Institute permitted to use drones

- Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) and Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) have granted permission to International Crops Research Institute for Semi-Arid Tropics (ICRISAT), Hyderabad, Telangana for the deployment of drones for agricultural research activities.
- This conditional exemption is valid for 6 months or until full operationalization of Digital Sky platform
- ICRISAT will have to obtain clearances from local administration, and concerned Ministries, AAI.

DIPAM signs agreement with World Bank for asset monetization services

- Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM) has signed an agreement with **World Bank** for getting advisory services related to asset monetization
- DIPAM is mandated to facilitate monetization of non-core assets of government CPSEs under strategic disinvestment or closure and enemy property of value of INR 100 crores and above.







• It will analyse asset monetization, benchmarking its institutional and business models against international best practices.

Second phase of Malabar Exercise begins today in Northern Arabian Sea

- The second phase of Malabar 2020 Exercise has begun today in the Northern Arabian Sea.
- This phase will involve coordinated operations of increasing complexity between Navies of Australia, India,
 Japan and United States
- It includes cross-deck flying operations and advanced air defence exercises by Vikramaditya MIG 29K fighters and F-18 fighters and E2C Hawkeye from Nimitz.
- Advanced surface and anti-submarine warfare, seamanship evolutions will also be undertaken

PM Modi to attend 12th BRICS Summit today

- PM Narendra Modi will attend 12th BRICS Summit today that will be held in virtual format.
- 12th BRICS Summit is being hosted by Russia
- Theme: Global Stability, Shared Security and Innovative Growth.
- The summit will witness leaders discussing intra-BRICS cooperation and key issues in the global context, including multilateral system reform, COVID-19 measures, Counter Terrorism, trade, health, energy exchanges.
- India will host the 13th BRICS Summit next year.

MIB requests compliance of policy on FDI in digital media within a month

- Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (MIB) has requested compliance of policy on Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in digital media within a month.
- MIB has also issued a public notice to facilitate eligible entities involved in uploading and streaming of news through digital media, to comply Govt decision of 26% FDI in this sector
- Entities having foreign investment below 26% may furnish intimation to MIB within a month with details of company, shareholding pattern

EPFO facilitates multiple options for Digital Life Certificate submission

- **Employees' Provident Fund Organization (EPFO)** has facilitated multiple options for EPS pensioners to submit their **Jeevan Pramaan Patra (JPP) / Digital Life certificate (DLC)** through any mode
- All pensioners of EPS 1995 are required to submit Jeevan Pramaan Patra (JPP) / Digital Life certificate
 (DLC) each year to continue drawing pension
- In addition to 135 RC and 117 DC EPFO, EPS pensioners can now submit DLC at pension disbursing bank branch, post offices or CSC.

Harsh Vardhan chairs 147th session of WHO Executive Board

 Union Health Minister Harsh Vardhan chairs 147th session of WHO Executive Board, that was held virtually due to COVID-19







- Main functions of WHO executive board are to give effect to the decisions and policies of the Health Assembly, to advise it and generally to facilitate its work.
- It consist of **34 technically qualified members** elected for three-year terms.
- Harsh Vardhan will hand over the chairmanship of WHO executive board in May 2021

Rajasthan Minister Bhanwar Lal Meghwal passes away

- Rajasthan cabinet minister **Bhanwar Lal Meghwal (72 years)** passed away at Medanta hospital in Haryana's Gurugram due to prolonged illness
- He was the **Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment** in the Congress government under Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot in Rajasthan.
- He also served as the Education Minister of Rajasthan from 2009 to 2013
- BL Meghwal was a member of the state Legislative Assembly from Sujangarh constituency, Churu district of Rajasthan

IIT Guwahati formulates efficient "pincer" catalytic systems

- **IIT Guwahati** research team has formulated efficient 'pincer' catalytic systems that will transform biomass wastes into valuable chemicals.
- Small amounts of developed pincer catalysts repeatedly convert large amounts of industrial waste such as glycerol into lactic acid and hydrogen.
- It will also efficiently convert bioethanol, a low-energy density fuel, into high-energy density butanol.
- It has elicited interest worldwide and will be beneficial energy conversion method

Sonu Sood appointed as state icon of Punjab by Election Commission of India

- Actor Sonu Sood has been appointed as state icon of Punjab by the Election Commission of India (ECI).
- Decision of honouring Sonu Sood with this title comes after he earned laurels for his humanitarian work during the lockdown.
- Sonu Sood has been helping migrant workers reach their hometowns amid COVID-19, along with giving them face masks, food, mobile phones and more.
- CM of Punjab: Amarinder Singh

Education Minister virtually launched Lilavati Award 2020

- Total cost of project: Rs 100 crore

RBI names 2 startups as a part of its regulatory sandbox programme

- RBI has announced the names of two startups that have been selected under its regulatory sandbox programme. They are:

 - New Delhi based Nucleus Software Exports Limited with product 'PaySe'
- The programme shortlisted 6 companies out of 32 entities that had applied







Regulatory sandbox is a protected environment within which the selected companies will show their system preparedness

Dominic Thiem defeats 20-time Grand Slam champion Rafael Nadal

- Dominic Thiem defeated 20-time Tennis Grand Slam champion Rafael Nadal (Spain) in straight sets at the ATP Finals in London by 7-6, 7-6.
- Dominic Thiem is from Austria and is World number three Tennis player
- Earlier, Thiem had beaten reigning champion Stefanos Tsitsipas of Greece in his opening round-robin match and will qualify for the semi-finals if Tsitsipas beats Andrey Rublev later.
- Nadal defeated Rublev in their opener and will play next will Tsitsipas

Haryana's first woman MP Chandrawati passes away

- Haryana's first woman MP and former Puducherry Lt.-Governor Chandrawati (92 years) passed away at Rohtak's PGIMS hospital
- She became the first-ever woman MP from Haryana in 1977 after defeating Chaudhary Bansi Lal from Bhiwani constituency
- She served as the Lt.-Governor of Puducherry from 19 February 1990 to 13 December 1990.
- She was residing in Charkhi Dadri district and was a native of Dalawas village.

Japanese Nobel laureate physicist Masatoshi Koshiba passes away

- Japanese physicist Masatoshi Koshiba (94 years) passed away at the Edogawa Hospital in Tokyo
- He jointly won the **Nobel Prize in Physics in 2002** along with Raymond Davis Jr for his pioneering work in astrophysics and detection of cosmic neutrinos
- Honours:
 - o Asahi Prize in 1987
 - o Nishina Memorial Prize in 1987
 - o Humboldt Prize in 1997
 - Wolf Prize in Physics in 2000
 - o Panofsky Prize in 2002
 - o Benjamin Franklin Medal in Physics in 2003

Madhya Pradesh CM announces 'Gau Cabinet' for protection of cows

- Madhya Pradesh CM Shivraj Singh Chouhan has announced the setting up of 'Gau Cabinet' for protection, conservation and promotion of cows in the state.
- Gau Cabinet will comprise of the departments of animal husbandry, forests, panchayat and rural development, revenue, home and farmers welfare.
- Its first meeting will be held on 'Gopashtami' on November 22 at Kamdhenu Gau Abhyaranya Cow Sanctuary in Agar-Malwa district, which is India's first cow sanctuary

Japan & Australia signs Defence Reciprocal Access Agreement (RAA)

- Japanese PM Yoshihide Suga and his Australian counterpart Scott Morrison have signed a landmark defence deal named as Reciprocal Access Agreement (RAA)
- The deal is signed in a bid to counter China's growing influence in the South China Sea and over the Pacific island nations.

• RAA allows Japanese and Australian troops to visit each other's countries and conduct training and joint operations/exercises, strengthening security ties and cooperation between defence forces.

Indian supercomputer Param siddhi ranked 63rd most powerful computer system

- High performance computing-artificial intelligence (HPC-AI) supercomputer **Param Sidhi** has achieved global ranking of 63 in TOP 500 most powerful non-distributed computer systems in the world
- Param Siddhi supercomputer is established under National Supercomputing Mission (NSM) at C-DAC and developed jointly by Dept of Science and Technology (DST), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY)
- It is built on NVIDIA DGX Super POD architecture networking

World Toilet Day being observed today

- World Toilet Day is observed every year on 19 November to create awareness about sanitation and encourage people to use toilets.
- Ministry of Jal Shakti's Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation celebrate 'World Toilet Day'

- BRICS countries reaffirmed that terrorism in all its forms is a crime and has no justification.
- BRICS: Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa.
- HQs: **Shanghai**

- National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB) has conferred four awards to Assam for fishery sector.
- Assam Apex Cooperative Fish Marketing and Processing Federation Ltd has been selected under the category of best hilly and North eastern govt organization.
- Nagaon has been selected under best hilly and North Eastern district while Nalbari based farmer Amal Medhi is selected under hilly and North Eastern fish farmer category.
- Awards will be given on 21st Nov in Delhi.

Maia Sandu elected as First-Ever Woman President of Moldova

- Former World Bank economist Maia Sandu (48 years) from Party of Action and Solidarity (PAS) has been elected President of Moldova.
- She won Moldova's 2020 Presidential election with 57.72% of the vote.
- She is the first women to be elected as the President of Moldova and will assume office on 23rd December 2020.
- Incumbent President of Moldova, Igor Dodon received 42.28% of the vote.
- She was the **former Prime Minister of Moldova** from 8 June 2019 until 14 November 2019.

Moody's projects India GDP at -10.6% for FY21

- Moody's Investors Service has projected revised India's GDP growth forecast to (-) 10.6% for the current fiscal 2020-21 (FY21), in its November 2020 update
- It has projected India's GDP to be (-) 11.5% in September 2020 in FY21.
- Further, Moody has projected India's GDP at 10.8% for next fiscal 2021-22 as against the previous estimate of 10.6%.







• **World Bank** projected India's economy to grow **(-) 9.6%** this fiscal, while **IMF** projected it at (-) 10.3% in 2020.

Vijayanagara to become 31st district of Karnataka

- Karnataka Government has approved carving out of Vijayanagara as new district of state.
- After this, Vijayanagara will be the 31st district of Karnataka state.
- This new district would be carved out of **Ballari** and will be named after the Vijayanagara empire that ruled this region.
- Vijayanagara is famous for **world heritage site of Hampi**
- Vijayanagar empire was founded by Harihara and Bukka in 1336 and was the greatest south Indian empire
- Karnataka CM: B. S. Yediyurappa

Harsh Vardhan addresses 33rd Stop TB Partnership Board meet virtually

- Union Health Minister Harsh Vardhan has addressed the 33rd Stop TB Partnership Board meet in New Delhi through Video Conference
- The meet stressed on the need to create a mass movement for elimination of TB with strategized advocacy, thought leadership, disruptive social entrepreneurship, powerful, societal and political commitment.
- India is running 'TB Harega, Desh Jeetega' campaign to achieve the Sustainable Development Goal target related to TB by 2025

First India-Luxembourg Virtual Summit held

- Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi, and Prime Minister of Luxembourg, Xavier Bettel held the firstever India-Luxembourg Virtual Summit
- India and Luxembourg have friendly relation of over more than 7 decades since the establishment of 1948 diplomatic relations
- During the Summit, both parties agreed for enhanced cooperation in trade, finance, steel, space, ICT, innovation, including renewable energy, and climate change.
- **3 MoUs** were signed as a part of the Summit.

India placed 77 in TRACE Bribery Risk Matrix 2020

- India is placed at 77th position in the TRACE Bribery Risk Matrix 2020 with a score of 45 in the global list
- India was at 78th position in 2019
- Highest commercial bribery risk: North Korea, Turkmenistan, South Sudan, Venezuela and Eritrea
- Lowest bribery risk: Denmark, Norway, Finland, Sweden and New Zealand
- TRACE Matrix list is released by TRACE International, an anti-bribery standard setting organisation, which measures business bribery risk in 194 countries.

Defence Minister releases two books on President's speeches

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has released two books named as 'The Republican Ethic Volume III' and 'Loktantra Ke Swar'
- The books are collection of selected speeches of President Ram Nath Kovind during the third year of his presidency along with speeched on COVID-19.
- Ministry of Information and Broadcasting Prakash Javadekar unveiled the e-book versions of the two books.







• It is divided into eight sections with 57 speeches.

Union Minister lays foundation stone for the first 50 LNG fuelling stations

- Union Minister **Dharmendra Pradhan** has laid the foundation stone for **first 50 LNG fuelling stations**, across golden quadrilateral and major National Highways.
- Govt has identified LNG as a transport fuel as a priority area for reducing vehicular pollution, saving import bill.
