### 1. Kerala became first Indian state to fix MSP for vegetables

- Kerala has become the first state of India to fix **minimum support price (MSP) for vegetables,** along with floor price for 16 varieties of vegetables with effect from Nov 1.
- The move will relief as well as support for the farmers targeting towards enhancement of agriculture in the state
- MSP will be 20% above the production cost of the vegetables and it will be revised on a regular basis
- It will be coordinated by Kerala local self-government bodies
- CM: Pinarayi Vijayan

### 2. Anzar Mustaeen Ali wins special prize in ICCR Global Art Competition

- Bangladeshi boy **Anzar Mustaeen Ali (6 year)** won \$1000 special prize for his artwork in the global art competition organised by **Indian Council of Cultural Relations (ICCR).**
- ICCR launched global painting competition titled as 'United Against CORONA- Express through Art' that attracted 8000 artwork entries from around the world.
- Final list was evaluated from each category in 4 sections: **Contemporary Art; Folk and Tribal Art; Cartoons-Illustrations** and **Digital-New Age Art.**

### 3. CSIR-CDRI Scientist, Satish Mishra bags Dr. Tulsi Das Chugh Award 2020

- CSIR-CDRI Scientist, **Dr Satish Mishra** has been awarded with **Dr. Tulsi Das Chugh Award-2020** for his research on Malaria parasite's life cycle
- The award is given by National Academy of Medical Sciences (India) and consists of a Scroll, Commemorative Medal and Cash Incentive
- His research work focused on **Secreted Protein with Altered Thrombospondin Repeat (SPATR)** which is Essential for Asexual Blood Stages but not Required for Hepatocyte Invasion by Malaria Parasite

### 4. Former Gujarat CM Keshubhai Patel passes away

- Former Gujarat Chief Minister **Keshubhai Patel (92 years)** passed away in Ahmedabad due to COVID-19
- He joined Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) in 1945 as a pracharak and started his political career as Jan Sangh career
- He served as the Gujarat chief minister in 1995 and again during 1998-2001
- He was a member of **Gujarat Legislative Assembly** six times.
- He quit the BJP in 2012 and floated **Gujarat Parivartan Party**, which merged with the BJP in 2014.

### 5. Air-connectivity between Bangladesh & India resumes



- **Bangladesh** and **India** resumed air-connectivity between them with two flights leaving Dhaka under air-bubble arrangement
- This air service was inaugurated at Hazrat Shahjalal airport in Dhaka
- It will help people who needed urgent medical support in India, along with strengthening cordial ties.
- Under this, 3 Bangladeshi airlines named Biman Bangladesh, US-Bangla Airlines and Novo Air will initially operate 28 flights a week to India.

### 6. India Post, US Postal Service sign MoU for electronic customs data exchange

- **Department of Posts, India** and **United States Postal Service** have entered into MoU for **electronic exchange of customs data** related to postal shipments exchanged between the two nation.
- It will facilitate **transmission of electronic data of international postal items prior to their physical arrival** at the destination enabling customs clearance of postal items in advance in line with the evolving global postal framework.
- This will also improve postal services performance

### 7. 'Electricity Access in India and Benchmarking Distribution Utilities' report

- NITI Aayog, Ministry of Power, Rockefeller Foundation and Smart Power India has rolled out 'Electricity Access in India and Benchmarking Distribution Utilities' report for 10 states
- Report underlines best practices adopted by electricity distribution utilities and highlights govt led power schemes
- As per the report, 92% of customers reported overall availability of electricity infrastructure with improved hours of supply and 87% got access to grid-based electricity.

### 8. Delhi CM launches 'Green Delhi' App to redress pollution complaints

- Delhi CM **Arvind Kejriwal** has launched **'Green Delhi'** mobile app through which citizens can bring pollution-causing activities to govt's notice.
- Citizens can click pictures or make a video of pollution-causing activities in the region and upload them on the application.
- The app will identify the location and complaint will be automatically forwarded to the concerned dept in time-bound manner
- **Green war room** has been set up to monitor the status of complaints.

### 9. India hosted 19th SCO Ministers Meet of Foreign Economy & Foreign Trade

- India virtually hosted 19th Meeting of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Ministers of Foreign Economy and Foreign Trade.
- The meeting was held to leverage the economic strength and explore partnerships that enhance trade and investment in the region and greater cooperation for access to medicines
- It was attended by Secretary General of SCO and Ministers from **Kyrgyz Republic, Kazakhstan, Pakistan, Russia, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan.**

### 10. SBI raises USD 1 billion untied loan with JBIC, other lenders

- **SBI** has signed \$1 billion loan agreement with **Japan Bank for International Cooperation (JBIC)** to promote smooth funds flow for business operations of Japanese automobile manufacturers in India
- As per the agreement, JBIC must finance \$600 million while the remaining amount will be financed by other participants-SMBC, MUFG Bank, Mizuho Bank, Shizuoka Bank and Bank of Yokahama
- SBI is entering into an untied loan for the 1st time with JBIC
- SBI Chairman: Dinesh Kumar Khara

### 11. IFSCA prescribes regulatory framework for listing of Depository Receipts

- **International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA)** has prescribed the regulatory framework for listing of **Depository Receipts (DRs)** to develop financial products and services in GIFT IFSC
- It will provide listing of DRs by companies that are listed in FATF compliant jurisdictions
- It will also enables eligible listed companies to raise capital on stock exchanges in GIFT IFSC.
- **DR** is a foreign currency denominated instrument, listed on an international exchange

### 12. Tamil Nadu launched Young Advocates Welfare Fund

• Tamil Nadu CM **Edappadi Palaniswamy** has launched **Young Advocates Welfare Fund** to provide Rs 3000 monthly financial assistance for 2 years to lawyers who just come out of law colleges.





- Usually, a law fresher takes 3 to 4 years to begin practice as an advocate as registration in the Bar Council, and the mandatory practicing under a senior advocate takes time, forcing them to change profession
- It is aimed at helping fresh candidates to withstand the initial challenges.

### 13. Om Puri honoured with Lifetime Achievement Award at IIFFB 2020 posthumously

- Indian actor Om Puri has been honoured posthumously with Lifetime Achievement Award at the 3rd edition of India International Film Festival of Boston (IIFFB 2020)
- His wife Nandita Puri received the award on his behalf
- Om Puri has worked in multiple critically acclaimed film in his career like Gadar, Lakshya, Rang De Basanti, Yuva, Lakshya, Dabang, The Hangman
- He was honoured with Padma Shri in 1990 and National Film Award for Best Actor
- IIFFB is a 3-day film festival

### 14. Ministry of Science & Technology launches SERB-POWER scheme

- Ministry of Science & Technology has launched 'SERB-POWER' (Promoting Opportunities for Women in Exploratory Research) scheme designed to mitigate gender disparity
- It has 2 components: **Fellowship and Research Grants**
- **Age group:** 35-55 years
- **Components of support:** Fellowship of Rs. 15,000 per month in addition to regular income
- **Duration:** 3 years
- It will empower women researchers under Level I and II Category
- Regulated by: SERB-CRG guidelines

### 15. Indian Railways launches Meri Saheli initiative for women security

- **Indian Railways** has rolled out 'Meri Saheli' initiative across all zones to provide safety and security to lady passengers travelling by trains till the destination station.
- It is an initiative of Railway Protection Force (RPF)
- Under this, lady passengers are briefed about all precautions to be taken during the journey and told to **dial 182** in case they face or see any problem in the coach.
- It started as a pilot project in **South Eastern Railway** in September 2020

### 16. Indian Army develops messaging app 'Secure Application for Internet'

- **Indian Army** has developed messaging application titled as **Secure Application for Internet (SAI)** to facilitate secure messaging within Army across the nation
- SAI will support end to end secure voice, text and video calling services for Android platform over the internet.
- It is similar in function to apps like Whatsapp, Telegram, SAMVAD and GIMS
- It also has **security features with local in-house servers and coding** which can be tweaked as per requirements.

### 17. PM inaugurates Arogya Van and Arogya Kutir in Gujarat

- PM Narendra Modi has inaugurated Arogya Van and Arogya Kutir at Kevadia, Narmada district
- PM also inaugurated Ekta Mall Children Nutrition Park and Jungle Safari and Geodesic Dome Aviary
- **Arogya Van:** It is set up on 17 acres for spreading awareness on Yoga, Ayurveda and Meditation and has 380 species of plants and trees with rich medicinal values.
- PM will also inaugurate about 17 different projects and lay the foundation stone for 4 projects at Statue of Unity Complex

### 18. Indian Oil launches common Indane refill booking number across India

- **Indian Oil** has rolled out **one common number for Indane LPG refill booking** for customer convenience across India, which will be available 24x7 for the customers

- **Indane** is a Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) brand developed and owned by **Indian Oil Corporation in India.**

### 19. Telangana CM launches 'Dharani' Portal for land and property registrations

- Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrasekhar Rao has rolled out 'Dharani' Portal for land and property registrations at Mudu Chinatalapalli as a part of revenue reforms of govt
- Registrations will begin from November 2.
- Property details which are not uploaded on the portal will be treated as illegal
- One can register their property, succession and also the partition of agriculture lands and once the registration is done, the owner will be provided with **e-pattadar passbook**.

### 20. CCEA approves Mechanism for procurement of ethanol

- Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved Mechanism for procurement of ethanol by Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies under Ethanol Blended Petrol Programme.
- Prior to this, there was uniform rate for ethanol but now there will be different prices like new Price fixed for Ethanol produced from sugar will be Rs. 62.65 per litre, ethanol from heavy molasses will be Rs. 57.61 per litre
- **GST** and **transportation charges** will also be payable.

### 21. Odisha launches 'Integrated Odisha State Scholarship' and 'Sumangal' portal

- Odisha Govt has launched 'Integrated Odisha State Scholarship' (IOSS) and 'Sumangal' portal to aid beneficiaries
- **IOSS portal:** It will help eligible students in availing scholarship benefits in a seamless transparent manner. 21 scholarships will be offered to more than 11 lakh students from SC, ST, OBC and educationally backward classes





• **Sumangal Portal:** It will help people avail inter-caste marriage incentives, under Odisha Right to Public Services Act, 2012.

### 23. Govt revises PLI Schemes for bulk drugs & medical devices manufacturing

- Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers has revised Production Linked Incentive (PLI) schemes for promoting domestic manufacturing of bulk drugs and medical devices.
- As per revised guidelines, 'Minimum Threshold' investment requirement has been replaced by
   'committed investment' taking into account availability of technology choices which varies from product to
   product.
- It has been released to encourage efficient use of productive capital under **Department of Pharmaceuticals**

### 24. Ministry of Shipping issues draft of Coastal Shipping Bill, 2020

- **Shipping Ministry** has issued draft of **Coastal Shipping Bill, 2020** for public consultation augmenting people's participation and transparency in the governance.
- It will replace part XIV of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1958.
- It will **expand definition of coastal shipping and coastal waters** and will eliminate the requirement of trading licence for Indian flag vessels
- It will reduce transportation costs encouraging Indian vessels to increase their share in coastal shipping.

### 25. Yashvardhan Kumar Sinha appointed as Chief Information Commissioner

- Yashvardhan Kumar Sinha (retired IFS officer) has been appointed as the new Chief Information Commissioner (CIC) of India
- He was sworn in as information commissioner in the CIC on January 1, 2019
- He served as the former diplomat as high commissioner of India to the United Kingdom and Sri Lanka
- He will succeed Bimal Julka
- Along with him, **Uday Mahurkar** has been named as information commissioner
- CIC is statutory body, which came to effect from Oct 2005 under RTI Act 2005

### 26. LTC tax voucher scheme extended to all employees

- **Govt** extended the income-tax exemption available under **LTC** cash voucher scheme to non-central **government employees** that include employees of state govt, state-owned enterprises and private sector.
- Income tax exemption shall not be applicable for those opting for concessional income tax regime introduced last year and employees will have to refund the unspent LTC fare received
- The scheme was launched to provide Cash payment and leave encashment in lieu of one LTC

### 27. National Unity Day being observed on 31st October

- National Unity Day or Rashtriya Ekta Diwas is observed every year on October 31 to commemorate the birth anniversary of the Iron Man of India, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel.
- The year 2020 marks the **145th anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel,** who played an instrumental role in India's struggle for independence, and during the integration of princely states to form India
- He was the first Home Minister and Deputy Prime Minister of India.
- It was first commemorated in 2014.

### 28. Prime Minister inaugurates Sardar Vallabhai Patel Zoological Park

- PM Narendra Modi has inaugurated Sardar Patel Zoological Park and Geodesic Aviary Dome in Kevadia, Gujarat
- The **zoological park or Jungle Safari** is spread over an area of 375 acres at seven different levels ranging from 29 to 180 meters and has more than 1100 Birds & Animals and 5 lakh plants.
- **Geodesic Aviary Dome:** It has 2 aviaries for Domestic birds and exotic birds. It is the world's largest geodesic dome for aviary
- Ekta Cruise Service was also flagged off.

### 29. IndusInd Bank first bank to go live on RBI's 'Account Aggregator Framework'

- IndusInd Bank has become the first bank in India to go live on 'Account Aggregator Framework' of Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
- The Bank has gone live as a 'Financial Information Provider' (FIP) under the new 'Account Aggregator Framework'
- **Account Aggregator framework of RBI:** It will enable customers to avail benefits like viewing statements of their accounts, track deposits, plan investments and avail credit cards on a single window

- India's largest and richest uranium deposits in Domiasiat and Wahkyn areas of Meghalaya.
- Domiasiat uranium deposit was discovered in 1984 and has 9.22 million tonnes of high-grade uranium ore deposits.

- **Publications Division of Ministry of Information and Broadcasting** has also put up 3 virtual stalls that had 120 publications covering 12 wide categories including Gandhian literature, Art and Culture.

### 36. Centre extends Bansi Lal Bhat's term as officiating Chairperson of NCLAT

- Centre has extended the term of Justice (retd) **Bansi Lal Bhat** as the **acting Chairperson of National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT).**

### 37. Nasa's SOFIA confirms water on sunlit surface of Moon

- Nasa's **SOFIA telescope** has confirmed water presence on the moon's north and south poles surface
- Water molecules have been found at Clavius Crater, one of the largest craters visible from Earth on lunar surface
- This discovery indicated that water may be distributed across moon's surface
- SOFIA: **Stratospheric Observatory for Infrared Astronomy**, is a joint project of Nasa and the German Aerospace Center to maintain and construct an airborne observatory.

- Award-winning author and editor **Daniel Menaker (79 years)** passes away in Massachusetts, United States due to pancreatic cancer

### 42. Former Turkish Prime Minister Mesut Yılmaz passes away in Istanbul

- Veteran Politician and former Prime Minister of Turkey, **Mesut Yilmaz (72 years)** passed away in Istanbul
- He was the Chief of now-defunctional centre-right Motherland Party or ANAP from 1991 to 2002.
- He was the Prime Minister of Turkey three times in 1991, 1996 and than from 1997 to 1999
- He was the first prime minister to be tried in Turkey's supreme court for the charge of misfeasance in public office
- Turkey's Capital: Ankara
- Currency: Turkish lira

- Panna Tiger Reserve of Madhya Pradesh has been included in the 'World Network of Biosphere Reserves' (WNBR) list of UNESCO.
- This is the 12th Indian biosphere reserve to be included in 'World Network of Biosphere Reserves', and third from MP after Pachmarhi and Amarkantak
- At present, Panna Tiger Reserve is home to **54 tigers**.
- **UNESCO's WNBR** covers internationally designated protected areas that demonstrate a balanced relationship between people and nature

### 45. World's first scientoon book "Bye Bye Corona" released

- Uttar Pradesh Governor Anandi Ben Patel has released World's first scientoon book 'Bye Bye Corona', which is based on COVID-19
- The book has been written by 'scientoonist' **Dr Pradeep Srivastava**, former Senior Principal Scientist at CSIR-Central Drug Research Institute (CDRI), Lucknow
- It has been published by Vigyan Prasar of DST
- It is a 220 pages book that contains comprehensive information on coronavirus, its symptoms and its prevention
- It will also be released in **Brazil**.

- He was first sworn in as the president in 2010 and was re-elected in 2015.
- He also served as the Prime Minister of Côte d'Ivoire from November 1990 to December 1993.
- Capital of Ivory Coast: Yamoussoukro
- Currency: West African CFA franc
