1. PM Modi to address India Mobile Congress 2020 tomorrow

- **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** will give the inaugural address at the virtual **India Mobile Congress (IMC) 2020** tomorrow at 10:45 AM.
- IMC 2020 is being organised by the **Department of Telecommunications, Government of India, and the Cellular Operators Association of India (COAI)**. It will be held from 8th to 10th December 2020.
- The theme for IMC 2020 is **"Inclusive Innovation - Smart, Secure, Sustainable"**.
- It aims to align to the Prime Minister's vision to promote 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat', 'Digital Inclusivity', and 'Sustainable development, entrepreneurship & innovation'.
- It also aims to drive foreign and local investments, encourage R&D in the telecom and emerging technology sectors.
- IMC 2020 will see the participation from various Ministries, the telecom CEOs, global CEOs, and domain experts in 5G, Artificial Intelligence (AI), Internet of Things (IoT), Data Analytics, Cloud and Edge computing, Blockchain, Cyber-security, Smart Cities and Automation.

2. Bangladesh signs first Preferential Trade Agreement (PTA) since its independence

- **Bangladesh signed its first Preferential Trade Agreement (PTA) with Bhutan** allowing duty free access to a range of goods between the two countries.
- **This is the first PTA Bangladesh has signed with any country in the world.**
- The agreement was signed on Sunday between **Bangladesh Commerce Minister Tipu Munshi and Bhutan's Economic Affairs Minister Lyonpo Loknath Sharma in Dhaka**. The agreement was signed on the occasion marking the 50 years of diplomatic ties between the two countries.
- **In 1971, Bhutan was the first country in the world, followed by India as the second, to recognise Bangladesh as an independent country.**
- Under the PTA 100 Bangladeshi products will get duty free access to Bhutan. At the same time, 34 items from Bhutan will get duty free access into Bangladesh. Further items can be added in the list later on the basis of discussion between the two countries.

- **Gwalior and Orchha of Madhya Pradesh** have been included in the list of **World Heritage City by UNESCO**.
- Tourism experts are calling it a big achievement.
- **Orchha located in the Bundelkhand region of Madhya Pradesh** is famous all over the world for its temples and palaces.
- **Orchha was the 16th century capital of the erstwhile Bundela dynasty.**
- Many temples and palaces are located here, which have some legend. **Orchha Raj Mahal, Jahangir Mahal, Ramaraja Mandir, Rai Praveen Mahal, Laxminarayan Mandir** and many other famous temples and palaces are famous for a unique confluence of Rajput and Mughal architectural influences.
- At the same time, Gwalior city has been the capital of **Gurjar Pratihara, Tomar, Baghel Kachhwahs and Scindia Rajvansh.**
- After being included in the list of World Heritage, UNESCO will work with the tourism department of the state to preserve and refine these archaeological and historical monuments of Orchha and Gwalior.

5. International Civil Aviation Day being observed on Dec 7.

- UN General Assembly proclaimed the day in 1996.

- ICAO HQs: **Montreal, Canada**

6. RTGS system to be available on 24*7 basis from December 14, 2020

- **RBI** has announced that **Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS) system** will be made available **round the clock (24 hours) on all days of the year** with effect from **Dec 14, 2020**.
- RTGS system is currently available between **7:00 AM and 6:00 PM**.
- It shall continue to be governed by **RTGS System Regulations, 2013**.
- It will be available round the clock, except end-of-day and start-of-day processes
- For smooth operation, **Intra-Day Liquidity (IDL) facility** shall be made available

7. The Second Cancer Genome Atlas (TCGA) 2020 Conference inaugurated

- **Harsh Vardhan** has virtually inaugurated the **2nd Cancer Genome Atlas (TCGA 2020) conference** in New Delhi.
- It brings together scientists and clinicians of the globe to build **Indian Cancer Genome Atlas (ICGA)**
- **TCGA:** Landmark cancer genomics program that molecularly characterized over 20,000 primary cancer and matched normal samples spanning 33 cancer types.
- It is a joint effort between **US- National Cancer Institute** and **National Human Genome Research Institute** since 2016

8. Adar Poonawalla named among 6 Asians of the Year 2020

- Serum Institute of India CEO **Adar Poonawalla** has been named among six ‘**Asians of the Year**’ 2020, by The Straits Times for his work against COVID-19
- SII collaborated with Oxford University and AstraZeneca to develop COVID-19 vaccine, ‘**Covidshield**’
- **Other 5 Asians of the Year:**
 - Zhang Yongzhen (China)
 - Chen Wei (China)
 - Ryuichi Morishita (Japan)
 - Ooi Eng Eong (Singapore)
 - Seo Jung-jin (South Korea)
- **The Straits Times** has collectively referred these 6 as ‘**the virus busters**’

9. Venkaiah Naidu releases book ‘40 Years with Abdul Kalam – Untold Stories’

- Vice President **Venkaiah Naidu** has released book titled ‘**40 Years with Abdul Kalam – Untold Stories**’ on from former president Dr A.P.J. Abdul Kalam.
- It has been written by Dr. **A. Sivathanu Pillai**, former chief of **BrahMos Aerospace**.
- The book described his life experience where he had the opportunity of working with Kalam for more than 4 decades
- It discusses untold event during the journey at ISRO, DRDO and BrahMos.
- The book has been published by **Pentagon Press**.

10. New Zealand all-rounder Corey Anderson retires from international cricket

- New Zealand all-rounder cricketer **Corey Anderson (29 years)** has announced retirement from all form of international cricket
- He rose to fame after scoring fastest 100 in the history of 1-Day International cricket (ODI), in 36-ball against West Indies in January 2014.
- This record was broken by AB de Villiers, in January 2015.
- He has played **13 Tests, 49 ODIs and 31 T20Is** for New Zealand, scoring **2277 runs** with two hundreds and 10 half-centuries and 90 wickets.

11. 7th WASH virtual Conclave concluded

- The **7th WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) Conclave** was organised in virtual mode from 2 to 4 December 2020

- It is being organised by **UNICEF** and **National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj (NIRDPR)**.
- Theme of the conclave: **Hygiene Matters**
- **Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka** and **Telangana** participated in the conclave to discuss key issues with particular focus on hygiene creating opportunity for collaborations
- Govt target to provide safe drinking water by 2024

12. 'Pixxel' to launch remote-sensing satellite on ISRO rocket in early 2021

- Space-technology start-up '**Pixxel**' has signed pact with **Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO)** to launch its first remote-sensing satellite on **ISRO's PSLV rocket** in early 2021.
- It was about to be launched in 2020
- Agreement was signed between **Pixxel** with **NewSpace India Limited (NSIL)** and is first-of-a-kind private earth-observation mission on IN-SPACE
- Pixxel aims to put constellation of 30 earth observation micro-satellites into sun-synchronous orbit by mid-2023.

13. Ministry of Ayush to set up AYUSH Export Promotion Council to boost exports

- **Ministry of Commerce and Industry** and **Ministry of AYUSH** have decided to set up **AYUSH Export Promotion Council** to boost AYUSH exports, along with establishment of an **AYUSH Export Promotion Council (AEPC)**
- Standardisation of HS code for AYUSH will be expedited.
- **Ministry of AYUSH** will work in collaboration with **Bureau of Indian standards** to develop international standards for AYUSH products as well as services
- It will work on ensuring quality, standards, price-competitive

14. Bangladesh signs Preferential Trade Agreement (PTA) with Bhutan

- **Bangladesh** has signed **first Preferential Trade Agreement (PTA)** with **Bhutan** to allow duty free access to a range of goods boosting bilateral trade
- This is the **1st PTA signed by Bangladesh** with any country in the world since its independence in 1971
- Bhutan was first country to recognise Bangladesh as an independent nation in 1971
- Under PTA, 100 Bangladeshi products will get duty free access to Bhutan, while 34 items from Bhutan will get duty free access into Bangladesh.

15. Armed Forces Flag Day being observed 7 Dec.

- **Armed Forces Flag Day** (Flag Day of India) is observed every year on **December 7** as an honour to the soldiers, sailors and airmen of India who fought on the borders to keep the country safe.
- It was first observed on **1949**
- Three branches of Armed Forces of India, namely, Indian Army, Indian Air Force and Indian Navy are remembered on this day.
- **Armed forces Flag Day Fund' (AFFDF)** has been constituted by Govt for the welfare and rehabilitation of Ex-Servicemen (ESM)

16. Veteran Marathi actor Ravi Patwardhan passes away

- Popular face in Marathi entertainment industry, **Ravi Patwardhan (84 years)** passed away after suffering from a massive heart attack.
- This veteran actor became popular through his role in Marathi TV series **Agabai Sasubai**.
- He has acted in more than 150 plays and more than 200 Hindi and Marathi films so far.
- He was known for his roles in the films like **Ankush (Hindi)**, **Ashya Asawya Suna (Marathi)**, **Umbartha (Marathi)**, **Tejab (Hindi)**, **Jyotiba Phule (Marathi)**.

17. PM Modi, HM Amit Shah congratulate Invest India for winning United Nations Investment Promotion Award for 2020

20. RBI tightens oversight of NBFCs and UCBs

- **RBI** has announced introduction of risk-based internal audit norms for large **urban cooperative banks (UCBs)** and **non-banking financial companies (NBFCs)**
- It is introduced as a part of measures to improve governance
- Along with this, appointment of statutory auditors for commercial banks, UCBs and NBFCs guidelines will also be harmonized to improve financial reporting.
- RBI has also proposed to issue **Digital Payment Security Controls directions** for regulated entities.

21. PM Modi virtually inaugurates Agra Metro project construction work

- **PM Narendra Modi** has inaugurated **construction work of Agra Metro project** in Agra, Uttar Pradesh through video conferencing
- **About the project:**
 - It comprises of 2 corridors with total length of **29.4 km**.
 - It will connect major tourist attractions like Taj Mahal, Agra Fort, Sikandra with railway stations and bus stands.
 - **Cost:** Rs 8,379.62 crore.
 - **Time:** 5 years.
- **Uttar Pradesh Metro Rail Corporation (UPMRC)** has set the target to complete its first phase by December 2022.

22. ICAR wins FAO's 2020 King Bhumibol World Soil Day Award

- **Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)** has won prestigious **International King Bhumibol World Soil Day Award for 2020** on World Soil Day
- ICAR has been conferred for its commitment to raise awareness about healthy soil addressing soil erosion under motto '**Stop soil erosion, save our future**', taken in **2019**
- Award was launched in 2018 to acknowledge individuals or institutions for public awareness of soils. Award is presented by **Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO)**.

23. Centre Launches QRMP scheme for GST payers with turnover up to Rs 5 crore

- Centre has rolled out '**Quarterly Return filing & Monthly Payment of Taxes (QRMP)**' scheme for small taxpayers under GST system.
- **Eligibility:** Taxpayers with Rs 5 crore annual turnover in the preceding financial year and who have filed their October GSTR-3B (sales) return by Nov 30, 2020.
- Under the scheme, the eligible taxpayer will be allowed to furnish their **GSTR-1** and **GSTR-3B** returns on quarterly basis (January-March quarter of 2020-21)

- **Native:** Bihar's Purnia district.

- Other shows: **Sanskaar, Jeet Gayi Toh Piyaa Morre, Vish and Sanware Sabko Preeto**.

27. ICICI Bank launches iMobile Pay to offer Payments & Banking Services

- **ICICI Bank** has launched new version of its mobile payment app called **iMobile Pay**, to offer payment and banking services to customers of any bank.
- Its latest version is interoperable and will now allow payments with other banking services to even those customers who do not hold an ICICI Bank account.
- Using this, customers of other banks can link their bank account, generate UPI ID, etc
- It also offers instant banking services such as savings account, investments, loans.

28. Kotak Mutual Fund launches India's First International REIT Fund Of Funds

- **Kotak Mahindra Asset Management Company (Kotak Mutual Fund)** has rolled out Kotak International REIT Fund of Funds, **India's first diversified REIT (Real Estate Investment Trust) Mutual Fund**.
- **New MF scheme:** It is an open-ended mutual fund scheme that will have diversified investment portfolio comprising listed REITs to invest in realty projects
- **Kotak International REIT Fund of Funds** will invest in units of Japan-based **SMAM Asia REIT Sub Trust Fund**.

29. UK become first country to roll out Covid-19 vaccine

- **United Kingdom (UK)** will become **first country today to roll out the Covid-19 vaccine**.
- Vaccine will be initially available at hospitals before distributing stocks to doctors' clinics.
- The approved vaccine has been developed by Pfizer and BioNTech
- **National Health Service** is giving top priority to vaccinating those above 80 years, frontline healthcare workers and care home staff and residents.
- Britain has ordered 4 crore doses of COVID Vaccine

30. Punjab National Bank launches 'LenS' Solution to speed up loan delivery

- **Punjab National Bank (PNB)** has rolled out loan management tech-solution titled '**LenS-The Lending Solution**', to speed up online loan processing and sanctioning of credit proposals with accuracy.
- **Objective:**
 - Standardise the system, process and appraisal formats for loan processing
 - Speed up credit sanctions
 - Auto-generate loan documents, etc
- It will be implemented in a phased manner for all kinds of loans including MSME, agriculture, retail and other credits.

31. Cabinet approves Rs 22,810 crore outlay for Atmanirbhar Bharat Rozgar Yojana

- The **Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved Rs 22,810 crore outlay** for a new employment scheme that aims at encouraging businesses to do fresh hiring.
- Under the **Atmanirbhar Bharat Rojgar Yojana**, the government for two years will provide employee and employer contribution to the retirement fund for new hires by businesses and entities, **Labour Minister Santosh Gangwar** said.
- The scheme would till 2023 entail an outgo of Rs 22,810 crore and would benefit around 58.5 lakh employees.

- **US President-elect Joe Biden has set a goal of 100 million Covid vaccinations in his first 100 days in office.** Attending a press conference in Delaware Mr Biden said, he can't promise that his first 100 days would end the Covid-19 but the course of the disease will be changed and life in America will also be changed for the better.
- The President-elect introduced his health team during the press conference. Mr Biden gave few details of how the largest vaccination programme in US history would be carried out. He said that getting children back to school would also be a priority for him.
- Yesterday, a report paved the way for a **Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine** to be approved and rolled out for Americans.

33. Sergio Perez Wins Sakhir Grand Prix 2020

- Mercedes racer **Sergio Perez** (Mexico) has won **2020 Sakhir Grand Prix** at Bahrain International Circuit in Sakhir, Bahrain.
- The race was **16th race of 2020 Formula One World Championship**.
- This is the 1st Formula One victory for Sergio Perez.
- He is also 1st Mexican F1 driver to win a race since Pedro Rodríguez won 1970 Belgian Grand Prix.
- **Esteban Ocon** (Renault-France) secured 2nd position, followed by **Lance Stroll** (Mercedes-Canada) at 3rd place.

34. Govt introduces 'CO-WIN' for COVID-19 vaccine delivery

- Govt has introduced new digital platform as well as mobile app titled '**CO-WIN**' for COVID-19 vaccine delivery.
- It will allow people to register for the vaccine.
- **CO-WIN app** is set to be available for smartphone users and will be publicly available soon.
- Platform will be used for recording **vaccine data and database of healthcare workers**, along with **COVID-19 related data**
- App will have separate modules for registration, vaccination, acknowledgement and reports.

35. Jehan Daruvala becomes first Indian to win Formula 2 Race

- **Jehan Daruvala** (22 year) has created history as he became the 1st Indian to win Formula 2 race at **2020 Sakhir Grand Prix**.
- This was the final race of F2 season.
- He is currently member of Red Bull Junior Team and competes for Carlin Motorsport.
- **Yuki Tsunoda (Japan)** bagged 2nd position while Britain's **Daniel Ticktum** was at 3rd spot.
- Michael Schumacher's son **Mick Schumacher** was crowned as the overall F2 champion of the season.

36. India remains under top 10 in Climate Change Performance Index

- **India** is ranked 10th for 2nd year in a row in **global Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI)** from among 58 economies
- India is ranked **9th in CCPI 2019**
- **Sweden** bagged 4th place, followed by **UK(5th), Denmark (6th), Morocco (7th)**
- China bagged 33rd rank and USA, appears at the bottom
- Only 2 G20 countries (UK and India) are among the high rankers
- CCPI is developed by **Germanwatch** and **NewClimate Institute (Germany)** together with the **Climate Action Network (CAN International)**.

37. Uttarakhand gets its first eco-bridge for reptiles and smaller mammals

- **Ramnagar Forest Division** in Nainital district, Uttarakhand has built its **first Eco-bridge/ Eco-ducts for reptiles and smaller mammals**
- **Aim:** To enhance wildlife connectivity that can be disrupted because of highways or logging.
- It consists of:
 - **canopy bridges** (usually for monkeys, squirrels and other arboreal species)
 - **concrete underpasses or overpass tunnels or viaducts** (usually for larger animals)

- **amphibian tunnels or culverts.**
- They are overlaid with contiguous look.

38. International Anti-Corruption Day being observed Dec. 9

- **International Anti-Corruption Day** is being observed annually on **9 December** to raise public awareness for anti-corruption.
- The day is observed since UN adopted United Nations Convention Against Corruption on 31 October 2003.
- Theme 2020: **‘RECOVER with INTEGRITY.’**
- The theme focuses on recovery through corruption mitigation and emphasizes that inclusive COVID-19 recovery can only be achieved with integrity.

39. SJVN signs MoU with IREDA for Green Energy Projects

- **SJVN Ltd** signs MoU with **Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency (IREDA)** for Green Energy projects through virtual mode.
- Under this, IREDA will provide its services to SJVNL and will also assist in Renewable Energy projects for 5 years
- IREDA will undertake Techno-Financial due diligence of Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency, Conservation Projects for SJVN.
- SJVN is developing 100 MW Dholera & 100 MW Raghanseda Solar Power Project in Gujarat.

41. UP Govt launches scheme for Tharu tribe

- UP govt has embarked upon scheme to take the unique culture of its ethnic **Tharu tribe** across the world.
- **Tharu tribe:** They belongs to Terai lowlands, Shivaliks, lower Himalayas of Uttarakhand, UP, Bihar, Nepal
- Tharu women have stronger property rights
- UP government is working to connect **Tharu villages of Balrampur, Bahraich, Lakhimpur and Pilibhit** bordering Nepal, with **home stay scheme of UP Forest Department** to offer tourists an experience of living in Tharu habitat

42. NTPC inks MoU with IIFM-Bhopal for Narmada Landscape Restoration Project

Many courts under the e-Courts project are located in far flung areas where terrestrial cable cannot be used for providing connectivity. Such areas are termed as Technically Not Feasible and in Department of Justice's endeavor to bridge the digital divide; connectivity is being established at the sites using alternative means like RF, VSAT etc.

65. Elephant health camp organised by Kaziranga national park

- An **elephant health camp** has been organised by the **Kaziranga national park** authority for the routine health care of the departmental elephants of the park.
- At present KNP have 63 (Sixty three) numbers of camp elephants in various ranges of both Eastern Assam wildlife division and **Western Assam wildlife division** as well as in Laokhowa Burhachapori wildlife sanctuary.
- A thorough health check up of the all departmental elephants were carried out by microscopic examination of the faecal samples for probable parasitic load.
- Blood samples were collected from selected elephants for routine blood profile and general health check-up.
- Anthelmintics, liver supportive medicines, Vitamins & mineral supplements and other supportive were distributed among the elephants.
- One of the most sought after wildlife holiday destinations in India, **Kaziranga National park’s 430 square kilometer area** sprinkled with elephant-grass meadows, swampy lagoons, and dense forests is home to more than **2200 Indian one-horned rhinoceros, approximately 2/3rd of their total world population. Formed in 1908 on the recommendation of Mary Curzon**, the park is located in the edge of the Eastern Himalayan biodiversity hotspots – Golaghat and Nagaon district. **In the year 1985, the park was declared as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.** It is said when Mary Curzon, the wife of the **Viceroy of India – Lord Curzon of Kedleston**, visited the park to see Indian one-horned rhinoceros; she wasn’t able to found even one. Then she persuaded her husband to take urgent measures to protect the dwindling species which he did by initiating planning for their protection. After a series of meetings and documentations, the **Kaziranga Proposed Reserve Forest** was created with an area of 232 km² (90 sq mi) in 1905.
- Along with the iconic Greater one-horned rhinoceros, the park is the breeding ground of elephants, wild water buffalo, and swamp deer. Over the time, the tiger population has also increased in Kaziranga, and that’s the reason why **Kaziranga was declared as Tiger Reserve in 2006.**
