### 1.New explosive detection device, developed by DRDO & IISc Bangalore

- RaIDer-X, a new explosive detection device, was unveiled at the National Workshop on Explosive Detection (NWED-2020) in Pune.
- It has the capability to detect explosives from a stand-off distance.
- Bulk explosive in a concealed condition can also be detected by the device.
- RaIDer-X has been co-developed by High Energy Materials Research Laboratory (HEMRL) Pune and Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore.

### 2.Narendra Singh Tomar inaugurates the Pusa Krishi Vigyan Mela-2020

### **15.Government permits Wifi on Flights**

- Government has permitted airlines operating in India to provide in-flight Wi-Fi services to passengers.
- The Pilot-in-Command may permit the access of Internet services by passengers on board an aircraft in flight, through Wi-Fi onboard,
- Wi-Fi is a family of wireless networking technologies, commonly used for local area networking of devices and Internet access.

### 16.Centre declared National Chambal Sanctuary in MP as eco-sensitive zone

- The Government of India has declared 870 sq km area around National Chambal Century (Madhya Pradesh) as the Economic Sensitive Zone for conservation of its ecology.
- It lies across Sheopur, Morena and Bhind districts of Madhya Pradesh.
- The sanctuary is located along river Chambal which is the cleanest river and harbours fresh water dolphin.

### 19.Shafali Verma gained the top spot in the ICC women's T20I rankings

- Teen sensation Shafali Verma rises to top in ICC women's T20 rankings, riding on her stellar run at the ongoing World Cup scoring a total of 161 runs in four innings.
- She has become only the second India player after Mithali Raj to top the women's T20 International rankings.
- The 16-year-old Shafali has replaced New Zealand's Suzie Bates, who had been at the top of batting charts since October 2018.

### 20.Jaydev Unadkat broke 21-year-old record in Ranji Trophy

• Left-arm pacer Jaydev Unadkat broke a 21-year-old record in history of Ranji Trophy to emerge as the highest-wicket taking pacer in a single season.

### 21.Sunil Joshi appointed as the New Chairman of BCCI's Selection Committee

- Former India spinner Sunil Joshi is selected as the chairman of the national selection panel by the BCCI's Cricket Advisory Committee (CAC) replacing MSK Prasad.
- Along with him, former fast bowler Harvinder Singh replaces Gagan Khoda in the panel as the committee member.
- The CAC comprised of Madan Lal, RP Singh and Sulakshana Naik.

### 22.Luxembourg becomes first country to provide free public transport

- Luxembourg abolished fares for trains, buses and other public transport to tackle road congestion and pollution, as well as supporting low earners.
- Travellers can still pay for first class, at a cost of 660 euros a year.
- Luxembourg has just over 600,000 inhabitants, but 214,000 travel for work every day from neighbouring Germany, Belgium and France, causing heavy traffic jams. causing greenhouse gas emissions.

### 23. Mumbai to host International Olympic Committee Session 2023

- Mumbai is set to host the International Olympic Committee's session 2023.
- The year 2023 will be significant for India as it coincides with the India's 75th independence year.
- This will be the second-ever IOC session to be held in India after a long gap of 37 years.
- India last hosted an IOC session way back in 1983 in New Delhi.
