New Appointments

- Who has won the presidential election of Croatia Zoran Milanovic. Note:
 - > Zoran Milanovic is the former Prime Minister of Croatia, who has pledged to make Croatia a tolerant country.
 - The Social Democrat candidate, Milanovic took 52.7 percent of the vote, while President Kolinda Grabar-Kitarovic garnered 47.3 percent.
 - > Kolinda Grabar-Kitarovic was the first female President of Croatia.
- 2. Who has appointed as the new chairman of the organization A Sakthivel.

Note:

- ▶ He has been appointed for the period 2020-2021.
- > He is also the first person in the history of AEPC, who is sworn-in for the fourth time as Chairman of the AEPC.
- Sakthivel along with some exporters had founded Tirupur Exporters Association in 1990.
- 3. Who took over as Sultan of Oman ____ Haitham bin Tariq al-Said.

Note:

- > Late Sultan Qaboos bin Saeed had ruled Oman since 1970 as the 8th Sultan of the House of Al Said.
- The late sultan had himself chose Haitham Bin Tareq Al Saeed (cousin of late Sultan Qaboos) as his successor, as the Sultan had no children.
- > He was the longest-serving monarch among the recent Arab rulers.
- **4.** Who won the Taiwan presidential election_**Tsai Ing-wen**.

Note:

- Tsai won 8.17 million votes, while her main rival Han Kuo-yu bagged 5.52 million votes (38.6 percent).
- > Her Democratic Progressive party retained control of the legislature, according to final results.
- 5. Noted chemist has been elected as a bureau member (2020-23) of the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry (IUPAC) ___ Bipul Behari Saha.

Note:

- Bipul Behari Saha is the second Indian after CNR Rao (former Director of the Indian Institute of Science and Bharat Ratna) to be elected for this position in a century.
- IUPAC has the responsibility of naming all new elements and compounds, declare atomic weights and physical constants, update Periodic table and carry out research projects.
- 6. Who has been appointed the Director of the National Book Trust (NBT) ___ Lt Col Yuvraj Malik

Note:

- > He replaced Sahitya Akademi-awardee writer Rita Chowdhury.
- Malik has also served with the Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Home Affairs, Raj Bhawan in Jammu & Kashmir, United Nation Missions in Africa and several operational areas in administrative and operational assignments including Jammu and Kashmir, Sikkim, Punjab and Rajasthan.
- 7. Who sworn in as the 14th Prime Minister of Malta ____Robert Abela.

Note:

- He replaced ruling PM Joseph Muscat, who resigned amid accountability over the murder of an investigative journalist.
- > Abela is the son of former President of Malta George Abela.

- Robert Abela secured a surprising victory in Malta's governing party's internal leadership contest to be elected as the new leader.
- Who has been appointed as the Chairman and Managing Director (CMD) of the state-owned Housing and Urban Development Corporation (HUDCO)__M Nagaraj.

- ▶ He will replace Ravi Kanth. Nagaraj is also the Director (Corporate Planning) of the company.
- > HUDCO provides loans for housing and urban infrastructure projects.

Important News - India

1. The Union government has approved the release of how many Crores to seven states as assistance for the damage caused due to various disasters in 2019____ Rs. 5,908.56 crore.

Note:

- States include Uttar Pradesh, Karnataka, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, and Tripura.
- The relief amount is given under the additional central assistance to seven states from the National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF) in a High-Level Committee meeting in New Delhi.
- Indian Navy has launched an expedition, to promote the maritime heritage of India in the Naval Dockyard Mumbai.Maharashtra.

Note:

- The expedition extends from Arnala fort, Northernmost fort of Maharashtra to Sindhudurg fort, the southernmost fort of Maharashtra, covering more than 555 km.
- > The expedition will be held until 11th January.
- **3.** South Korean **automobile manufacturer** has entered into a partnership with US ride-hailing giant Uber to produce electric air taxis___ **Hyundai Motor Company.**

Note:

- Hyundai also unveiled a new full-scale concept PAV (personal air vehicle), developed jointly with Uber, at the ongoing Consumer Electronics Show 2020.
- > Hyundai is the first automotive company to join the Uber Elevate initiative.
- Under the partnership, Hyundai will produce and deploy the air vehicles and Uber will provide airspace support services, connections to ground transportation and customer interfaces through an aerial rideshare network.
- 4. Union Home Minister Amit Shah has released a book on the life of Prime Minister Narendra Modi_Karmayoddha Granth. Note:
 - The Home Minister addressed the gathering at the launch and said that the qualities of a Karmayoddha such as a beautiful heart for people, a statesman, a hard taskmaster, an able administrator and an ideal leader who leads by example, are represented by Narendra Modi.
- 5. Global Investors Meet 'ASCEND 2020' will be held in ___Kochi, Kerala.

Note:

- It enables filing of all cyber-crimes with a specific focus on crimes against women, children, particularly child pornography, child sex abuse material, online content pertaining to rapes.
- All the cyber-crime related complaints will be accessed by the concerned law enforcement agencies in the States and Union Territories for acting as per law.
- 9. Power Minister **R K Singh** has released the ____State Energy Efficiency Index 2019.

Note:

- > They track the progress of Energy Efficiency Initiatives in 36 States and Union Territories.
- > The index this year incorporates qualitative, quantitative and outcome-based indicators to assess energy efficiency initiatives, programs and outcomes in five distinct sectors.
- The index is developed by Bureau of Energy Efficiency in association with Alliance for an Energy-Efficient Economy.
- **10.** The fifth edition of the Pulses Conclave will be held in Lonavala, Maharashtra from _____ **12-14 February 2020.** Note:
 - IPGA expects close to 1500 trade stakeholders from India and key pulses exporting countries like USA, Australia, Canada, Myanmar, Ethiopia, Uganda, Tanzania, Mozambique, Malawi.
 - > IPGA is the nodal body for the country's pulses trade and industry.
 - The conference aims at increasing exports, processing efficiencies, protein extraction, value addition and postharvest management.

- **14.** India's first indigenous aircraft carrier Vikrant likely to be commissioned by ____2021.

Note:

- > This carrier is being built at the Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL) in Kochi.
- According to Navy Chief Admiral Karambir Singh, Vikrant will be fully operational by 2022 and it will have a fleet of MiG-29K aircraft
- **15.** Union Steel Minister **Dharmendra Pradhan** has launched a mission to accelerated development of eastern India through integrated steel hub _____Mission Purvodaya.

1. World Cup winner Italian retires from football __ Daniele De Rossi.

Note:

- The Italian midfielder Daniele De Rossi (37-year-old) announced his decision to retire from football in order to spend more time with his family.
- > Daniele De Rossi also earned 117 caps for Italy at the senior level, winning the FIFA World Cup in 2006.
- > In an 18-year of his career, he made 616 appearances and scored 63 goals, winning two Coppa Italia titles
- 2. Weightlifter has been slapped with a four-year ban for doping by the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) Sarbjeet Kaur.

Note:

- The sample of Sarbjeet, who won the 71kg event at the women's national weightlifting championships in February last year, was collected during 34th Women Senior National Weightlifting Championship held at Vishakhapatnam.
- "The Anti-Doping Disciplinary Panel has found weightlifter Sarbjeet Kaur guilty of anti-doping rule violation. She has been imposed a penalty of ineligibility for a period of four years.
- **3.** Japanese badminton player has won the Malaysia Masters 2020___ Kento Momota.

Note:

- > He defeated Denmark's **Viktor Axelsen** 24-22, 21-11.
- > The victory in Malaysia lends credence to Momota's drive to win the gold in July's Tokyo Olympics.
- \blacktriangleright The reigning world champion told reporters that his eyes more success in 2020.
- Momota, currently the best player on the planet, won a record 11 titles last year.
- **4.** Who has won the inaugural 2020 ATP Cup tennis tournament in Sydney___**Serbia**.

Note:

- Djokovic (World No. 2) claimed a straight-sets victory over Rafael Nadal (World No. 1) 6-2, 7-6 (7-4) in singles.
- In doubles, Djokovic and Viktor Troicki claimed 6-3, 6-4 straight sets victory over Feliciano Lopez and Pablo Carreno Busta.
- ATP Cup was the opener for the 2020 ATP Tour, as well as the first ATP team tournament since the last edition of the World Team Cup in 2012.
- 5. 3rd Khelo India Youth Games started in ____Guwahati.

Note:

- > 3rd Khelo India Youth Games 2020 started at Indira Gandhi Stadium in Guwahati, Assam.
- ▶ Khelo India Youth Games event is a National level multidisciplinary games conducted every year.
- Six thousand five hundred athletes from 37 teams will take part in the event.
- Cycling and Lawn Ball have been introduced as new disciplines in the games.
- Who has won the 7th National Ice Hockey Championship Women trophy_Ladakh.

Note:

- > The match was held at the Karzoo Ice Hockey Rink in Ladakh.
- The tournament was organized by the Ice Hockey Association of India (IHAI) in association with the Ladakh winter sports club.
- Four women teams representing Chandigarh, Delhi, Maharashtra, and Ladakh participated in the tournament.

- 1. Two Indian banks has decided to end their operations in Sri Lanka Axis Bank and ICICI Bank. Note:
 - The Central Bank of Sri Lanka has permitted these two Indian banks to close their operations in the island nation.
 - The licenses issued to them will be canceled once the winding-up operations are complete.
- 2. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has revised the supervisory action framework for Urban co-operative banks (UCBs). Note:
 - According to the guidelines, UCBs, with deposits of Rs 100 crore and above, will constitute the BoM, which will be a mandatory requirement for opening new branches.
 - The main functions of the Board of Management (BoM) include recommending action for recovery of NPAs, One Time Settlement and assisting the board in monitoring the same.
- 3. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has granted in-principle approval to Co-operative Bank to convert to a small finance bank (SFB) Shivalik Mercantile Co-operative Bank Ltd.

- It becomes the first urban cooperative bank (UCB) to make the transition since the guidelines came out nearly two years ago.
- > Approval granted will be valid for 18 months to enable the applicant to comply with the requirements under the scheme on the voluntary transition of the urban co-operative banks into a small finance bank.
- > Under the scheme, UCBs with a minimum net worth of ₹50 crores and capital to risk (weighted) assets ratio of 9% and above are eligible to apply for the voluntary transition to SFB.
- 4. According to the National Statistics Office release, India's GDP growth during fiscal 2019-20 is expected at _____5%. Note:
 - The estimated growth of real Gross Value Added (GVA) in 2019-20 is 4.9% as against 6.6% in 2018-19.
 - The manufacturing sector is expected to grow at 2% in 2019-20 as compared to 6.9% in the previous year.
 - The growth rate in per capita income is estimated at 4.3% during 2019-20, as against 5.6% in the previous year.
 - The agriculture sector is expected to see a growth of 2.8% as compared to 2.9% in the previous year.
- 5. According to the **Deutsche Bank report** Imagine 2030, the Indian economy is likely to become \$7 trillion by 2030. Note:
 - The Indian economy is expected to grow almost two and half times from about \$3 trillion now and thus it becomes the world's third-largest economy.
 - According to the report, India will grow with the Nominal GDP growth rate of just over 10% in the next decade.
- 6. Public sector bank has announced the 'Residential Builder Finance with Buyer Guarantee' (RBBG) scheme to give a push to residential sales and improve homebuyers' confidence____ State Bank of India. Note:

- Under this scheme, the SBI will issue a guarantee for the completion of select residential projects to customers who have availed home loans from it.
- The scheme will focus on affordable housing projects priced up to 2.50 crore rupees in 10 cities initially.
- Under RBBG, the guarantee would be given by the bank until the project gets the Occupation Certificate (OC).
- 7. Who has enabled selected banks in India to offer forex rates to Indian clients round-the-clock (24×7) ____ Reserve Bank of India (RBI).

Note:

- In effect, this opens up the forex market in India round the clock, allowing Indians to hedge their foreign exchange risks at any time of the day.
- This will also make the offshore currency markets in Dubai and Singapore less attractive for Indian investors.
