Japan's Prime Minister Shinzo Abe and the head of the International Olympic Committee agreed to postpone the Tokyo 2020 Games by a year in an extraordinary move, unprecedented in peacetime, as the world battles the coronavirus pandemic.

The Human Development Index (HDI) is a tool developed by the **United Nations Development Program** to measure and rank countries' levels of social and economic development. Four principal areas of examination are used to rank countries: mean years of schooling, expected years of schooling, expectancy at birth and gross national income per capita. This index makes it possible to follow changes development levels over time and to compare the development levels of different countries. Thus, the correct answer is (A).

Note:

India was ranked 129 out of 189 countries on the 2019 Human Development Index (HDI) improving from the 130th position in 2018.HDI is part of the Human Development Report that is published by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).

Norway, Switzerland, Ireland are the top three nations on the index.

Germany occupies the fourth position along with Hong Kong, and Australia secured the fifth rank on the global ranking.India's neighbours Sri Lanka and China ranked higher, at 71 and 85 positions, respectively.

- As part of its solar mission, it plans to source approximately 1000 megawatt (MW) of solar power & to source around 200 MV of wind power, based on the techno-commercial assessment. 24. Ans. B.
