ROOT- 'Liver' & 'Liber' means Free

- **Liberal**- Free from prejudice
- **Libertarian**- A person who advocates liberty, especially with regard to thought or conduct
- **Liberticide** - Destruction of Liberty
- **Deliverance** – State of being freed, release
- **Deliberation**- Long and careful consideration or discussion
- **Unliberated** - Not liberated
- **Neoliberal** - Relating to or denoting a modified form of liberalism tending to favour free-market capitalism
- **Libertine** - Characterized by free indulgence

Root – 'Fic & Fect' means Make

- **Beneficiary** - A person designated as the recipient of funds or other property under a will, trust, insurance policy, etc.
- **Deification**- Making a god out of something
- **Cofection**- The act or process of making something
- **Personification** - The attribution of human nature or character to animals, inanimate objects, or abstract notions, especially as a rhetorical figure
- **Versification**- The act, art, or practice of composing poetic verse; the construction or measure of verse or poetry; metrical composition.
- **Affectability**– The capacity to be affected or influenced
- **Affection**- A gentle feeling of fondness
- **Confectionary**- Sweets and chocolates considered collectively.

ROOT- 'vale' means Strength, Worth & Valor

- **Valetude**: State of health
- **Valetudinarian**: A person who is unduly anxious about their health
- **Valedictory**: A farewell address at graduation
- **Valediction**: A farewell
- **Valiant**: A person who is brave
- **Equivalent**: Of equal value
- **Valid**: having a sound basis in logic or fact
- **Valorization**: Government subsidy for support of the prices of a commodity

Root – 'Neo' which means New & Recent

- **Neoblastic**- Having the nature of new growth
- **Neoprene** - Belonging to the tertiary period
- **Neocosmic**- Relating to the present known world and races
- **Neocracy**- Government by new, inexperienced officials
- **Neo-Darwinism**-A new form of Darwin's theory
- **Neofetus**- A new form of Darwin's theory
- **Neogenesis**- A new formation or regeneration of tissue
- **Neogrammarian**- A new, scientific direction to linguistics

ROOT- 'FILA & FIL' means Thread

- **Filiform** - Threadlike
- **Filamentous** - Composed of or containing filaments
- **Filature** - The process of obtaining silk from the cocoons of silkworms.

- **Dromedary** - A swiftly running camel
- **Prodromal** - A combining form meaning "running," "course," "racecourse"
- **Hippodrome** - An oval track for horse races and chariot races
- **Motorodrome** - A track for races of automotive vehicles
- **Syndrome** - A group of symptoms that together are characteristic of a specific disorder, disease, or the like.
- **Aerodrome** - A small airport or airfield.
- **Velodrome** - A cycle-racing track, typically with steeply banked curves.
- **Seadromes** - A floating airdrome serving as an intermediate or emergency landing place for airplanes

ROOT- 'OPUS & OPER' means Work, Operate/Cooperate

- **Operatic** - Characteristic of opera
- **Opuscule** - A small or minor literary or musical work
- **Cooperate** - Work jointly towards the same end
- **Operatory** - A room or other area with special equipment and facilities
- **Cooper** - A maker or repairer of casks and barrels
- **Operable** - Can be treated by an operation
- **Eloper** - To leave without permission
- **Improper** - Not in accordance with accepted standards
- **Properly** - Correctly
- **Reoperate** - An operation to correct a condition not corrected by a previous operation

Root – 'Vita, Vivi & Viv' means Alive & Life, Vitamin/Vital

- **Activities** - The condition in which things are happening or being done
- **Affidavit** - A written statement confirmed by oath or affirmation, for use as evidence in court
- **Antivitamin** - Any substance that interferes with the action of a vitamin
- **Bioactivity** - The effect of a given agent
- **Cognovit** - An extraordinary document by which a debtor authorizes his or her creditor's attorney to enter a confession in court that allows judgment against the debtor
- **Connectivity** - The state of being connected or interconnected
- **Declivity** - A downward slope
- **Devitrify** - Opaque, and crystalline

ROOT- 'NASC & NAT' means To Be Born & To Spring Forth

- **Nascent** - Just Coming into existence
- **Natal** - Relating to Birth
- **Native** - Belonging to by birth
- **Naturalize** - To give citizenship to the foreign born
- **Naturopathy** - A system of alternative medicine
- **Renascences** - Revival of something that has been dormant
- **Nascency** - Beginning to exist or develop
- **Evitabile** - Capable of being avoided

Root – 'Para' means Beside, Alongside & Position

- **Parabiosis** - Union of two organisms
