1.	Which organization has been managing the Indian Pavilion at Cannes Film Market 2020 on behalf of the GoI at Cannes
	FICCI.

Note:

- ➤ The e-inauguration of the Virtual India Pavilion at Cannes Film Market 2020 was done by Minister of Information & Broadcasting Prakash Javadekar.
- ➤ He also unveiled the booklet and poster of the 51st International Film Festival of India (IFFI), which is scheduled to take place from November 20 to 28, 2020 in Goa.
- 2. Which chartered accountancy firm has been appointed to audit PM Cares Fund ______ SARC & Associates. Note:
 - > The appointment is significant because critics have questioned the rationale for a fund other than the Prime Minister's National Relief Fund (PMNRF) for relief work and have also sought more transparency about the usage of monies from the Fund.
- Researchers at which IIT has created a chip named 'Dhruva' that can be mounted in smartphones and navigation devices to find places and routes within the country ______ IIT Bombay.
 Note:
 - > The radio frequency receiver chip was designed in 18 months by students and researchers at IIT Bombay. It can receive in multiple frequency bands and handle weak signals.
 - ➤ Besides, it can be converted into digital bits and processed by any standard digital signal processor (DSP) to determine one's location precisely.
- **4.** A Five-day Virtual Healthcare & Hygiene Expo was organized by which of the following industry bodies ______FICCI. Note:
 - > The event is to create a self-reliant ecosystem in the Pharmaceuticals and Health & Hygiene Sector by ramping up domestic production.
 - In our resolute fight against the COVID-19 pandemic, this sector has a greater significance.
- **5.** For reducing the carbon dioxide emission caused due to transportation in the country, NITI Aayog will launch the project 'Decarbonising Transport in India' in collaboration with _____International Transport Forum (ITF). Note:
 - ➤ India's Decarbonising Transport initiative is a part of the DTEE project. DTEE stands for Decarbonising Transport in Emerging Economies.
 - > DTEE is a project of ITF under which apart from India, currently Argentina, Morocco, and Azerbaijan are the participants.
- 6. Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched 'Garib Kalyan Rojgar Abhiyaan (GKRA)' via video conference from which district of Bihar _____ Khagaria.

Noto:

- ➤ The outlay of this campaign is Rs 50,000 Crores and the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) is the nodal Ministry for its implementation.
- ➤ GKRA, the mission mode campaign of 125 days will cover 116 districts comprising more than 25,000 returnee migrant workers each across 6 states viz. Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Jharkhand and Odisha
- 7. Which Maharatna company has entered into the partnership with NITI Aayog's flagship initiative Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), to actively support the key innovation and entrepreneurship initiatives across India _____ Coal India Limited.

Note:

The tie up will help the talented youth of our country to develop great innovations that have not developed or fallen short and thus enable them to have a AtmaNirbhar Bharat (self-reliant India).



8. The United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) India has partnered with which IIT to support state and national governments in achieving food and nutrition security ______ IIT Delhi.

Note:

- ➤ The overall objective of this partnership is to use advanced analytics and operations research to develop practical solutions that support long term strategic planning of procurement, storage, and movement of food grains by agencies such as the Food Corporation of India (FCI).
- ➤ It also focuses on to create cost-effective supply chain networks for distribution of food grains under the Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) at the state level.
- **9.** What is the budget outlay for the recently approved Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) by the Union Cabinet ______15,000 crore.

Note:

- > The aim of setting up AHIDF is to unlock private sector investments in the animal husbandry sector.
- > Through the fund, Infrastructural developments will be promoted in dairy, animal feed, and meat processing plants.
- As per Government estimate, the fund will help in creating up to 35 lakh jobs across the country.
- **10.** The Union Cabinet has approved the declaration of the Kushinagar Airport as an international airport, it is located in which state _____ Uttar Pradesh.

Note:

- ➤ Khushinagar is a Buddhist pilgrimage town where Gautama Buddha attained Mahaparinirvana.
- The move will provide a much-needed boost to the tourism sector of the country in the post-COVID-19 world as International connectivity will increase number of foreign and as well as domestic tourists.
- **11.** The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) approved additional investment of USD 121.27 million by ONGC Videsh Ltd. in Shwe oil and gas project located in which country _____ Myanmar.

Note:

- ➤ OVL, the overseas arm of state-owned Oil and Natural Gas Corp (ONGC), had picked up a stake in the Shwe Project in Myanmar in 2002.
- The firm has invested USD 722 million in the project till March 31, 2019.
- ➤ The first gas from the Shwe Project was received in July 2013 and plateau production was reached in December 2014.
- **12.** Who launched the scheme 'Distressed Assets Fund- Sub- Ordinate Debt for MSMEs' announced as part of AtmaNirbhar Bharat Package by GoI ______ **Nitin Gadkari**.

Note:

- > The scheme is also called as Distressed Assets Fund- Sub- Ordinate Debt for MSMEs.
- This scheme was announced as a part of the AtmaNirbhar Bharat Package by Finance Minister.
- **13.** As per the data released by the United States (US) Treasury Department what is India's position as a holder of US government securities ______12th.

Note:

- ➤ Notably, the holding touched a record high of \$177.5 billion in February, 2020 which was drastically reduced in March.
- The country with maximum exposure to US government securities is Japan at US\$1.266 trillion followed by China and the United Kingdom (UK) at the second and third positions, respectively at the end of April 2020.
- **14.** Which power company will acquire US-based The AES Corporation's 49 per cent equity stake in Odisha Power Generation Corporation _____ **Adani Power Ltd.**

- Adani Power Ltd (APL) has signed an agreement to acquire the 49% of stake (a total of 89,30,237 equity shares) in Odisha Power Generation Corporation (OPGC) from the affiliates of the US-based global energy company, AES Corporation(AES) for USD 135 million (around Rs 1,019 crore).
- The remaining 51% stake in OPGC is held by the Government of Odisha.
- > The 49% stake includes the total issued, paid-up and subscribed equity share capital.



15. A behaviour change campaign named 'Navigating the New Normal' has been launched by NITI Aayog in partnership with which foundation _____ Melinda Gates Foundation.

Note:

- As the country is now in an Unlock phase, the aim is to develop an appropriate COVID safe behavior in the country, such as by making people adapt to wearing masks as a part of their daily routine.
- Until a vaccine is developed, it is essential for the citizens of the country to adopt certain behavioral changes in their day to day life by practicing hand hygiene, wearing masks, etc.
- **16.** As per the Annual Tuberculosis Report 2020 released by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare what is the percentage rise in TB patient in 2019 _____14 per cent.

Note:

- ➤ It should be noted that the sustainable goal of eradicating TB globally is 2030, but the Indian government is committed to achieve this target in the country by 2025.
- **17.** Which becomes the 1st airport in India to get an indigenously-developed Aviation Weather Monitoring System (AWMS) at both ends of the runway _____ Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru.

Note:

- > The technology is developed by Bengaluru-based CSIR-National Aerospace Laboratories (NAL).
- ➤ The AWMS sensor has been installed on a 10 meters mast which is a 1st of its kind, designed by NAL.
- **18.** According to the report, 'Global Startup Ecosystem Report (GSER) 2020 released by the Startup Genome, Bangalore, which become the only city in the country to be included in the world's top-30 startup ecosystem ranking ______ Bengaluru.

Note:

- ➤ Bengaluru become the only city in the country to be included in the world's top-30 startup ecosystem ranking & placed 26th position.
- At the same time, the nation's capital Delhi has been ranked 36th in the list.
- **19.** Which two Indian Institutes secured their ranks in the top 100 in the "THE Young University Rankings 2020" released by the Times Higher Education ______ IIT Ropar and IIT Indore.

Note:

- ➤ The Times Higher Education (THE) released THE Young University Rankings 2020 for the universities which are 50 years old or younger.
- ➤ The Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (Pune) and Indian Institute of Technology Gandhinagar ranked 101-150.
- **20.** Which ministry is celebrating the "Sankalp Parva" from 28th June to 12 July 2020 _____ Ministry of Culture. Note:
 - > This initiative has been launched following the call of Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi to plant at least five trees either in Office campus or wherever it is possible in order to ensure clean and healthy environment of the country.
 - ➤ Under the "Sankalp Parva" celebrations, Ministry of Culture expects its Subordinate Offices, Academies, Attached Institutions as well as Affiliated Institutions to plant trees in its campus or at the surroundings wherever it is possible.
- **21.** The Government of India has signed an agreement with World Bank to provide affordable housing to the urban poor of which state _____Tamil Nadu.

- The agreement signed has two projects under it- (i) Tamil Nadu Housing Sector Strengthening Program and (ii) Tamil Nadu Housing and Habitat Development Project.
- > The loans for both the project are from the lending arm of the World Bank Group the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD).
- **22.** Union Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas & Steel, Dharmendra Pradhan virtually inaugurated Battery Swapping Facility Quick Interchange Service (QIS) in which city of India _____Chandigarh.

 Note:
 - > The battery swapping technology provides the best alternative to slow charging and enables drivers to optimize the use of the operational hours.



➤ The model was initiated to target the commercial segment like electric autos, rickshaws, electric 2W and the electric vehicle, which is factory fitted or retrofitted.

- > Under this scheme, pure and nutritious food on concessional rates is going to be provided to the needy twice each day.
- ➤ The State government will spend ₹100 crores every year on the scheme.
- 2. Which state government is to launch a job guarantee scheme to provide 100-day work guarantee to the unskilled workers living in the urban areas of the state ______ Jharkhand.

Note:

- The scheme aimed to enhance the livelihood security for the urban poor will be named Mukhyamantri SHRAMIK (Shahri Rozgar Manjuri For Kamgar).
- Ayyankali Urban Employment Guarantee Scheme (AUEGS) is the 100-day employment guarantee scheme of the Kerala Government for urban poor.
- **3.** Which state government has signed an agreement with Reliance Jio TV to benefit around 52 lakh rural students during the COVID-19 pandemic _____ Haryana.

Note:

- > The four channels of EDUSAT can be accessed through television, Laptop, desktop, tablets and smartphones for free of cost which will be available on the Jio platform.
- > The contents aired on the television will be available on Jio TV for a week so that the students can access the content to their convenience and time.
- **4.** Which state's Panchayati Raj Department won the 1st prize under e-Panchayat Puraskar-2020 _____Himachal Pradesh.

Note:

- ➤ All the 3,226 panchayats of the state have been provided internet facility and people can access various services online.
- > The various services such as family register, registration of birth, death and marriages are registered online in the panchayats.
- **5.** Which state government has launched Mukhyamantri Matru Pushti Uphaar scheme to provide nutrition kits to pregnant and lactating women ______ **Tripura**.

Note:

- > The scheme is a part of the state's efforts to fight malnutrition and maternal mortality.
- > The scheme was announced by state Minister for Social Welfare and Social Education Santana Chakma.
- The government expects to incur an expenses of about Rs 8 crore annually for this scheme.
- **6.** What amount of financial support an eligible woman from Kapu Community will get will get annually under Kapu Nestham scheme launched by Andhra Pradesh Government _____ Rs 15,000.

Note:

- > The objective of the scheme is to financially empower Kapu women by enhancing their livelihood and living standards with financial assistance.
- > Women in the age group of 45-60 belonging to Kapu Community are benefited with this scheme.
- In a period of Five years an eligible woman will get a sum of Rs 75000.
- 7. Which state government will launch a campaign called 'Kill Corona' from 1st July 2020 under which door-to-door Survey will be conducted to control the spread of COVID-19 _____Madhya Pradesh.

- During the campaign, the highlight will be the number of tests conducted.
- ➤ The campaign will double the COVID-19 testing capacity from 4000 per 10 lakh people to 8000 per 10 lakh people in the state.

- ➤ Lichens are found in the Himalayas up to 5000 metres are important species as they are the best bioindicators of the pollution levels.
- ➤ Uttarakhand has more than 600 species of lichens followed by Himachal Pradesh and Jammu and Kashmir with 503 and 386 species respectively.
- **10.** Which state government has launched 'At One Click' Initiative for MSMEs & Other Bigger Industries _____ **Gujarat. Note:**
 - Through the initiative, the State Government looks to restore the former vibrancy of the state by motivating sectors such as MSME, traders, bigger industries, and businesses.
 - > The online initiative is to encourage these sectors for taking up the challenge that the COVID-19 crisis has bought and convert this into an opportunity.

- ➤ China was one of the 23 countries back in 2013 when it abstained from the vote to adopt the treaty at the United Nations.
- The U.S. President has announced in April 2019 that the U.S. will never ratify the Arms Trade Treaty under his administration (the U.S has signed the treaty but was yet to ratify).
- 2. Which country has successfully launched the last Satellite of its BeiDou Navigation Satellite System (BDS) ______China.

Note:

- > The satellite was launched from the Xichang Satellite Launch center in Sichuan Province.
- ▶ BDS is one of the four global navigation networks among the US's GPS, Russia's GLONASS and European Union's Galileo.
- **3.** Mt. Merapi an active volcano erupted twice in June, 2020 is in which country _____Indonesia.

Note:

- Merapi (Mountain of Fire) is the most active of Indonesia's 130 active volcanoes.
- ➤ Indonesia is located on the Pacific Ring of Fire.
- It is a path along the Pacific Ocean characterized by active volcanoes and frequent earthquakes.
- **4.** As a commemorations of the 6th International Yoga Day, world's first Yoga University outside India was launched in which city of United State _____ Los Angeles.

Note:

- ➤ The university will be known by the name- Vivekananda Yoga University.
- ➤ The University was launched as a part of the commemorations for the 6th International Yoga Day.
- Chancellor of SVYASA- Swami Vivekananda Yoga Anusandhana Samsthana, Dr. H R Nagendra will be the first Chairman of the Vivekananda Yoga University.
- **5.** Which of the following countries remained in the FATF's Grey List _____Pakistan.

- The decision has been taken as Pakistan has failed to check flow of money to terror groups like Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) and Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM).
- > The decision was taken at the Financial Action Task Force's third and final plenary held virtually due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

 - ➤ India is the first country to control locusts through drones. Under the Make in India initiative, the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers' Welfare (DAC&FW), Agriculture Ministry has indigenously developed a vehicle-mounted Ultra-low volume (ULV) sprayer for locust control.
 - ➤ Locust is a crop-threatening migratory pest that has entered the country through the India-Pakistan border.
- According to latest study by OECD's 'Global Forum on transparency and exchange of information for tax purposes, which are top three countries as Exchange of Information partners of Switzerland _____ India, France and Germany.

Note:

- ➤ India is getting detailed information on request, from Switzerland about bank accounts and beneficiary ownership of entities established by its residents.
- ➤ India is also rated as 'largely compliant' by this OECD's review.
- > It has also named Italy, Netherlands and Spain among other significant EOI partners for Switzerland.
- **10.** What was the theme of the '36th ASEAN Summit held via video conference under chairmanship of Vietnamese Prime Minister Nguyen Xuan Phuc _____ Cohesive and Responsive ASEAN.

Note:

 - > This day is widely known by various public service organisations and departments around the world by organising several events to recognise the role of public servants in making developments and improvements in the community.
 - On 20 December 2002, the United Nations General Assembly designated 23 June per annum to watch as United Nations Public Service Day.
- 2. The International Widows Day is observed globally every year on _____ 23rd June.

Note:

- The day is widely known to draw attention to the voices and experiences of widows and to galvanize the unique support that they have.
- > Several women around the world after losing her life partner faces challenges and do long-term struggle for basic needs, their human right and dignity.
- 3. What is the theme of Day of the Seafarer, 2020 celebrated every year on 25th June _____ Seafarers are Key Workers.

- ➤ The Day of the Seafarer was first celebrated in 2011, following its establishment by a resolution adopted by the Conference of Parties to the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers (STCW), 1978, held in Manila, Philippines, in 2010.
- > The Day of the Seafarer has now been included in the annual list of United Nations Observances.

Note:

- > For countering the impact that drug has on our societies, it is important that cross border cooperation increases among countries across the globe.

- **5.** International Day in Support of Victims of Torture is observed every year on which date _____26th June. Note:
 - > This day is observed by the United Nations to raise awareness among the people about the human torture that it is not only unacceptable but it is also a crime.
 - > It's to be remembered that pain or suffering caused by legal penalty isn't considered as torture. On 26 June 1998, the primary International Day in Support of Victims of Torture was held.
- 6. National Statistics Day 2020' celebrated every year on _____ 29th June.

Note:

- > The National Statistics Day to commemorate the birth anniversary of PC Mahalanobis, often referred to as the 'father of Indian statistics.
- > On June 29, 2006, the first Statistics Day was observed.
- "Good Health and Well Being and Gender Equality", is the theme for National Statistics Day 2020.
- 7. The UN's International Day of Parliamentarism is observed globally every year on which date _____30th June.

 Note:
 - > It is also a chance for parliaments to spot challenges and stock ways to deal with them effectively.
 - ➤ The Day was established in 2018 through a United Nations General Assembly Resolution.
 - This day also acknowledges the formation of the Inter-Parliamentary Union, the global organization of parliaments which was established in 1889.
- 8. International Asteroid Day is observed globally every year on _____ 30th June.

Note:

- > The day is widely known to raise public awareness about the asteroid impact hazard and to tell the public about the crisis communication actions to be taken at the worldwide level just in case of a credible near-Earth object threat.
- Several events are organised everywhere in the world to teach people about asteroids.

1. Who has appointed as new as the Chief Executive Officer of the Professional Risk Managers' International Association (PRMIA) of its new India office _____ Nirakar Pradhan.

Note:

- > Pradhan has led teams at State Bank of India and Generali Group in India and Europe.
- > PRMIA is a non-profit led by top professionals dedicated to promoting best practices in risk management.
- 2. Who has been re-nominated as a Part-Time Non-Official Director on RBI Central board for 2 years _____ Natarajan Chandrasekaran.

- > The government had 1st nominated him as the Director on RBI Central board for 4 years from March 4, 2016.
- The Natarajan Chandrasekaran joined Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) in 1987, he became its Chief Executive Officer from 2009-17, prior to which he was Chief Operating Officer (COO) and executive director of TCS.
- 3. Who has been appointed as head coach of the Uttarakhand Ranji team for the upcoming season _____ Wasim Jaffer. Note:
 - The highest run-getter in Ranji Trophy, Jaffer had announced retirement in March this year after playing for over two decades, primarily for domestic giants Mumbai and Vidarbha.
 - > This will be his first stint as a head coach with a team.

- **5.** Who has been named as the first female president of the Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC) in its 233 year-old history _____ Clare Connor.

Note:

- > Connor is the current England and Wales Cricket Board's managing director of women's cricket. The 43-year-old will take up the post on 1 October, 2021.
- Current president, former Sri Lanka captain Kumar Sangakkara, has been offered to stay in the role for a second tenure in the wake of the coronavirus pandemic.
- **6.** IAS Vini Mahajan becomes 1st woman chief secretary of which state ______ **Punjab.**

Note:

- She will replace Karan Avtar Singh, who has now been posted as Special Chief Secretary, Governance Reforms and Public Grievances.

 - Lal Ji Tandon, the Governor of Madhya Pradesh has been under treatment at a private hospital in Lucknow since 11th June 2020.
 - Ms. Patel served as Governor of Madhya Pradesh before Mr. Tandon took over last year.
- 9. Lazarus Chakwera was elected as the new President of which country after the annulment of the results of the 2019 Presidential Elections following evidence of irregularities _____Mali.

Note:

Lazarus Chakwera was elected as the new President of Malawi after winning 2,604,043 votes, which is 59.34 percent of the total valid votes. 2019 Presidential Election winner Peter Mutharika secured 39.92 percent of the total valid votes in the 2020 Presidential Elections.

Note:

- ➤ It also forecasts Indian economy to register 6.9% growth in fiscal year 2021.
- ➤ Global Macro Outlook also indicated that China would be the only G-20 country to record growth of 1% in fiscal year 2020 and expects it to grow at 7.1% in fiscal year 2021.
- Moody's also forecasted the growth of G-20 economies and expects it to contract by 4.6% in fiscal year 2020 followed by 5.2% growth in 2021.

- The ICP 2017 results, revised results for 2011 and estimates of annual PPPs for the period 2012-2016 are available on the ICP website and the World Bank's Databank and Data Catalog.
- ➤ In 2017, India retained and consolidated its global position, as the third largest economy and accounted for 6.7% of global GDP in terms of PPPs.
- China was at first position with 16.4% and the USA at the second position with 16.3%.
- 8. As per the data released by the United States (US) Treasury Department what is India's position as a holder of US government securities _____12th.

Note:

- Notably, the holding touched a record high of \$177.5 billion in February, 2020 which was drastically reduced in March.
- The country with maximum exposure to US government securities is Japan at US\$1.266 trillion followed by China and the United Kingdom (UK) at the second and third positions, respectively at the end of April 2020.
- 9. The International Monetary Fund (IMF) steeply slashed India's growth outlook for the current fiscal year to _____-4.5 per cent.

- ➤ The International Monetary Fund (IMF) steeply slashed India's growth outlook for the current fiscal year to a minus 4.5 per cent from 1.9 expansion estimated in April owing to an extended Covid-19 lockdown and slower economic revival. This will be the lowest in several decades.
- As per the IMF WEO, in 2021 global growth is projected at 5.4 per cent, which will be about 6.5 percentage points lower than the pre-Covid projections of January 2020.
