G C Murmu appointed as CAG

- Former J&K lieutenant governor G C Murmu a 1985 batch IAS officer, appointed as the Comptroller and Auditor General. He will succeed Rajiv Mehrishi, who is retiring.
- The **President** had **appointed Murmu to be the CAG** from the date he took charge of the office.
- **Murmu** served in the **home department of Gujarat** when Modi was chief minister. Later, he also as **principal secretary in the state**.
- He worked in the finance ministry and handled the Goods and Services
 Tax regime as additional secretary and was involved in the implementation of indirect tax reforms.

<u>Maharashtra set to introduce Digital education tools in partnership with Google</u>

- The Maharashtra government has announced a partnership with Google for introducing digital education tools in schools across the state.
- It will enable 2.3 crore students and teachers to access the technology giant's blended learning programmes that combine classroom approach with online learning.
- Google will deploy free tools like G Suite for Education, Google Classroom and Google Meet to facilitate remote learning.

Cladonotus bhaskari, pygmy grasshopper

- A new species of pygmy grasshopper, discovered after 116 years by a group of foreign researchers in Sri Lanka, has been named after a 28-year-old Indian orthopterist (one who studies grasshoppers) and conservation biologist Dhaneesh Bhaskar of Kerala.
- Cladonotus bhaskari, teh first new twighopper species found in 116 years.
- It was identified in the Sinharaja rainforest in Sri Lanka by teh researchers from Germany and Croatia.

India plans to set up Japanese industrial township in Assam

- India is planning to set up teh 13th Japanese industrial township in Assam, a move aimed at promoting economic ties between teh two countries.
- Secretary in the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Guruprasad Mohapatra informed.
- Presently, the work is on for Geographic Information System-enabled database of industrial areas and clusters across the country.

Kisan Special Parcel Train

• India's first Kisan Special Parcel Train or Kisan Rail to be operation from 7th Aug 2020.

- It will transport material between Maharashtra's Devlali and Bihar's Danapur Railway station.
- The Kisan Rail will carry fruits and vegetables and will make stoppages at several stations and pick-up and deliver them.
- The train will halt at Nasik Road, Manmad, Jalgaon, Bhusaval, Burhanpur, Khandwa, Itarsi, Jabalpur, Satna, Katni, Manikpur, Prayagraj Chheoki, Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay Nagar and Buxar.

National Handloom Day

- The **National Handloom Day** is organised on 7th Aug 2020 by the Ministry of Textiles on a virtual platform.
- 7th August was chosen as the National Handloom Day to commemorate the Swadeshi Movement which was launched on the same date in the year 1905.
- The objective is to **generate awareness** about the **Handloom Industry** among the public and its **contribution to socio-economic development**.
- Textiles Minister Smriti Irani attended as the Chief Guest on the occasion.

<u>India granted \$15.46 million to India-UN Development Partnership Fund</u>

- India has contributed \$15.46 million to India-UN Development Partnership Fund under its commitment to support developing nations across all the Sustainable Development Goals.
- The fund is managed by **United Nations Office for South-South Cooperation (UNOSSC) and** implemented under UN system since 2017.
- Out of the \$15.46 million, \$6 million will go to the overall fund for all developing countries and \$9.46 million is dedicated to Commonwealth countries.

Social Security Scheme for tendu leave collectors launched in Chhattisgarh

- Chhattisgarh CM Bhupesh Baghel has launched Shaheed Mahendra Karma Tendupatta Sangrahak Samajik Suraksha Yojana for tendu leaves collectors.
- It is a social security scheme launched in the memory of political leader **Mahendra Karma.** It will benefit over **12.50 lakh** tribals and forest dwellers families
- Tendu leaves are used for making bidis. The scheme will provide financial aid of Rs 2 lakh to nominee, heir in case of normal death, accidental death and accidental disability

Former Union Home Secretary Ram D. Pradhan passes away

• Former Union Home Secretary **Ram D. Pradhan (92 years)** passes away in Mumbai due to age-related ailments.

- He was an IAS officer of Maharashtra Cadre. He served as the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh (1987-1990)
- He also headed 2-member committee to investigate 26/11 Mumbai terror attack.
- He was honoured with **Padma Bhushan in 1987.**
- He played a significant role in the signing of the Assam Accord and Mizoram Peace Accord.

Former Real Madrid goalkeeper Iker Casillas announces retirement

- Legendary Real Madrid & Spanish footballer **Iker Casillas (39 years)** has announced his retirement from professional football.
- He played as a goalkeeper for Real Madrid. He made 725 appearances for Real Madrid, during which he won three Champions League titles and five La Liga titles.
- He also helped **Spain in winning the 2010 World Cup** and two successive European Championships in 2008 and 2012.
