- PM Narendra Modi has launched the Indian Space Association (ISpA). ISpA is a private industry body to help boost space technology in India.
- India and Denmark signed two MoUs on research in climate change, and setting up a "green hydrogen" electrolyser plant.
- The govt has appointed M. Ravichandran as Secretary, Ministry of Earth Sciences.
- The Union Minister Parshottam Rupala, launched the River Ranching Programme in Uttar Pradesh.
- In a landmark decision, the Department of Food and Public Distribution has imposed stock limits on Edible Oils and Oilseeds for a period upto 31st March, 2022.
- Telecom secretary and Chairman of Digital Communications
 Commission inaugurated its Quantum Communication Lab and unveiled the indigenously developed Quantum Key Distribution (QKD) solution at C-DOT,

- The Indian Railways has launched 2 long haul freight trains 'Trishul' and 'Garuda' in South Central Railways (SCR).
