- Padmaja Chunduru has been appointed as the Managing Director and Chief executive officer (MD & CEO) of National Securities Depositories (NSDL).
- Rebecca Vanessa Suchiang (1989 batch IAS officer) has taken over as the State Chief Secretary of Meghalaya.
- Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs has launched 7th consecutive edition of Swachh Survekshan (SS) at New Delhi.
- Reliance Industries Chairman Mukesh Ambani has topped IIFL Wealth Hurun India Rich List for the 10th consecutive year with total net worth of Rs 7,18,000 crore.
- Novel titled 'Chronicles from the Land of the Happiest People on Earth' has been released.
- Government has extended the timeline of Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) till
 31st March 2022 or till guarantees for an amount of Rs 4.5 lakh crore are issued under scheme,
 whichever is earlier.
- International Financial Services Centers Authority (IFSCA) has constituted an Expert Committee to recommend approach towards Sustainable Finance Hub at IFSC
- Govt has approved capital infusion of Rs. 4,400 crores to ECGC Ltd for a period of five years, i.e. from FY 2021-2022 to FY 2025- 2026.
- Indian Overseas Bank (IOB) is taken out of PCA (Prompt Corrective Action) by RBI
- Piramal Enterprises has acquired Dewan Housing Finance Limited (DHFL) by paying an amount of Rs 34,250 crore.
