- PM Narendra Modi inaugurated the Kushinagar International Airport.
- NPCI launched the NPCI Tokenization System to support tokenisation of cards as an alternate to storing card details with merchants.
- The Kung Fu Nuns of the Drukpa order of Buddhism has won the prestigious Martial Arts Education Prize 2021 from the UNESCO International Centre.
- A Balasubramanian, CEO of Aditya Birla Sun Life Asset Management, has been elected as the Chairman of Association of Mutual Funds in India (AMFI).
- Former US president **Donald Trump** announced to launch his own social networking platform called **"TRUTH Social,"**.
- According to the Lancet Countdown report, India is one of the five countries in the
 world whose vulnerable populations had the most exposure to extreme heat over the
 past five years.
- The center extended the **Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package (PMGKP)**, the insurance scheme for healthcare workers fighting covid-19 for another **six months**.
- Sri Lanka has received the first consignment of 3.1 million litres high quality non-harmful Nano Nitrogen liquid fertiliser from India.
- Imprisoned Russian opposition leader Alexei Navalny was awarded the EU's Sakharov Prize 2021

- The Reserve Bank of India has imposed a penalty of 1 crore on Paytm Payments Bank for violating provisions of Payment and Settlement Systems Act 2007.
