- Mr Istevan Szabo and Martin Scorsese will be conferred the Satyajit Ray Lifetime
 Achievement Award at the 52nd International Film Festival of India in Goa.
- In a historic first, Russian film director **Klim Shipenko** and actress **Yulia Peresild** are back on Earth after wrapping up scenes for the first movie shot in space.
- A total of 152 Centres (across 77 districts of 13 states) for Financial Literacy and Service Delivery (SAKSHAM Centres) have been launched under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural Livelihoods Mission in a week as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi virtually addressed the national level Conclave of the Indian Air Force (IAF).
- Centre in consultation with RBI has decided to issue four tranches of **Sovereign Gold Bonds** from October 2021 to March 2022.
- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved PM GatiShakti
 National Master Plan including the institutional framework for rolling out,
 implementation, monitoring and support mechanism for providing multi-modal
 connectivity.
- Madhya Pradesh government has announced the implementation of Mukhyamantri Ration Aapke Dwar Yojana in the state from next month.
- Smartphone maker OnePlus has elevated Navnit Nakra as its India CEO and Head of OnePlus India region operations.
- China beat defending champions Japan 3-1 in a thrilling Uber Cup final in Aarhus, Denmark, to reclaim the Uber Cup title.
- South Korea has launched its first homegrown rocket, stepping up the country's ambitions in space
- India Internet Governance Forum to be conducted in November 2021 to bring all stakeholders of internet governance on a single platform.
- Union Minister Dr Jitendra Singh has launched an improved Air Quality Early Warning System for NCR.
