- Abiy Ahmed has been sworn in as the Prime Minister of Ethiopia for a second five-year term.
- American scientists David Julius and Ardem Patapoutian has won 2021 Nobel
 Prize for Medicine for discoveries of receptors for temperature, which can pave
 way for new pain-killers for chronic diseases.
- World Expo 2020 has been organized at Dubai in United Arab Emirates from 1 October 2021 to 31 March 2022.
- Colonel Mamady Doumbouya (41 years) has been sworn in as the Interim
 President of Guinea
- Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh felicitated winners of 'Dare to Dream 2.0' Contest of Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO) in New Delhi
- T Govindaraju from Jawaharlal Nehru Centre for Advanced Scientific Research has received prestigious Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Prize for Science and Technology, 2021 for his ground-breaking concepts and discoveries, which have significant potential for diagnosis and treatment for Alzheimer's, lung cancer.
