- The 8th edition of joint military exercise 'Mitra Shakti 21' begun today
- The India Today Healthgiri Awards 2021 were presented on Gandhi Jayanti by Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister for Health & Family Welfare and Aroon Purie, Chairman and Editor-in-Chief, India Today Group.
- The Uttar Pradesh government named actor Kangana Ranaut as the brand ambassador of its ambitious 'one district-one product' programme.
- Kadhenu Deepawali 2021 campaign was launched to manufacture and market more than 100 Crore Cow dung based Deepak lamps and Laxmi-Ganesh Idols.

- Tanzanian novelist, Abdulrazak Gurnah has been awarded 2021 Nobel
 Prize in Literature for his uncompromising and compassionate
 penetration of the effects of colonialism and the fate of the refugees in
 the gulf between cultures and continents.
- P L Haranadh (1994 batch Indian Railway Traffic Service (IRTS) officer) has been appointed as the new Chairman of Paradip Port Trust (PPT).







- Rice variety widely grown in Palghar district in Maharashtra, Wada Kolam has received the 'Geographical Indication' (GI) tag, which means the product now gets unique identity as well as wider market base.
- Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) Chairman Mukesh Ambani has topped Forbes India Rich list for 2021, that ranks India's 100 richest Indians with net worth of \$92.7 billion.
- Kotak Mahindra Bank has received approval from the Government for collection of direct and indirect taxes, such as income tax, Goods and Services Tax (GST), etc, through its banking network.
- POWERGRID Khetri Transmission System Ltd. (PKTSL) has commissioned Transmission System associated with Rajasthan Solar Energy Zone (SEZ).
- World Investor Week (WIW) is a global initiative promoted by International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO) to raise awareness about the importance of investor education and protection and highlight the various initiatives of securities regulators in these two critical areas.
- Indian Entrepreneur and writer Jaithirth Rao has come out with a book Mahatma Gandhi titled as 'Economist Gandhi: The Roots and the Relevance of the Political Economy of the Mahatma'
- PM Modi has dedicated 35 Pressure Swing Adsorption (PSA) Oxygen Plants to the nation, established under PM CARES, across 35 States and Union Territories.
- Mansukh Mandaviya has launched ICMR's Drone Response and Outreach in North East (i-Drone) to ensure last-mile delivery of vaccines.

- Maria Ressa and Dmitry Muratov has won 2021 Nobel Peace Prize for their efforts to safeguard freedom of expression, which is a precondition for democracy, peace
- India has been ranked at 90th position in Henley Passport Index, released for Q4 of 2021, among 116 countries as its passport holders are allowed to travel visa-free to 58 countries







- Anshu Malik became the 1st Indian women finalist at World Championship, and also the first female player from India to claim silver medal at 2021 World Wrestling Championships
- Maharashtra govt has launched a special Covid-19 vaccination drive titled as 'Mission Kavach Kundal', with the target of inoculating 15 lakh people everyday.
- Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Sarbanand Sonowal has launched mobile application titled as MyPortApp to promote transparency and easy access of port related information.
- DRDO has organized All India Official Language, Scientific and Technical Seminar for promoting use of Hindi in official activities including scientific and technical works
- Bollywood actor Ranveer Singh has been roped in as the brand ambassador of Crypto platform CoinSwitch Kuber.

- Mercedes racer Valtteri Bottas (Finland) has won Formula 1 Turkish Grand Prix 2021, held at Istanbul Park in Tuzla, Istanbul.
- International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA) has launched Global FinTech virtual Hackathon Series 'I-Sprint'21'.
- National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) has declared combined areas of Guru Ghasidas National Park (Surajpur district) and Tamor Pingla Wildlife Sanctuary (Koriya district) in Chhattisgarh as Tiger Reserve
- Union Minister of Civil Aviation, Jyotiraditya M. Scindia has virtually inaugurated Greenfield Sindhudurg airport in Maharashtra under RCS-UDAN (Regional Connectivity Scheme – Ude Desh Ka Aam Naagrik) scheme.
- The 6th edition of annual Joint Military Exercise 'AJEYA WARRIOR' has been kick-started at Chaubatia, Uttarakhand from 8th October 2021.
- India has officially joined High Ambition Coalition (HAC) for Nature and People, becoming the first country from BRICS bloc (Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa) to join the HAC.
- RBI has announced the theme for Fourth Cohort under Regulatory Sandbox as 'Prevention and Mitigation of Financial Frauds'.
- Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in its Monetary Policy Report released in October 2021 has projected India's GDP growth rate for 2022-23 (FY23) at 7.8%.

- World Animal Welfare Day is celebrated on 4 October to raise awareness among people about taking actions worldwide for the rights of animals as well as welfare. It is necessary to improve welfare standards worldwide.
- World Teachers' Day (International Teachers Day) is being observed every year
 on October 5 to focus on appreciating, assessing, and improving the educators
 of the world and to provide an opportunity to consider issues related to teachers
 and teaching.
- Ganga River Dolphin Day is observed every year on October 5 in India to raise awareness and encourage conservation of Ganga River Dolphins.
- World Cotton Day (WCD) is observed every year on October 7 to celebrate international cotton industry and its contribution to communities and the global economy.
- Air Force Day in India is observed every year on 8th October to mark the official foundation day of the Indian Air force
- World Egg Day is celebrated every year on the 'Second Friday of October'
 month to raise awareness of the benefits of eggs and their importance in
 human nutrition.
- World Post Day is celebrated every year on October 9 globally to celebrate the anniversary of Universal Postal Union establishment in 1874 in the Swiss Capital, Bern.
- World Migratory Bird Day (WMBD) is officially celebrated twice in a year to spread awareness for the need to conserve migratory birds and their habitats.
