Madhya Pradesh to be developed as Textile Hub

- There is a huge potential for investment in the textile sector of Madhya Pradesh, there is a plan to make textile hub in the state, this will increase employment opportunities in the state.
- 1000 crores has been invested by Sagar Group in the field of textiles, in which about 4000 people have got direct employment.
- This group is working in the field of textile sector, food processing sector, real estate and education in the state.

International airline started in Madhya Pradesh

- Indore to Dubai airline was started, Gwalior to Delhi and Indore were also started.
- Five airlines have been started from Indore and four from Gwalior.
- Assistance will be provided by the state government in making Indore an international airport and expanding the airport.
- A new grand airport will be established in Gwalior in the name of Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia at a cost of Rs 500 crore. Same as the railway station of Gwalior will be given a grand look at a cost of Rs 250 crore.

27 percent reservation for other backward classes in Madhya Pradesh

- Under the Madhya Pradesh Public Service Amendment Act, 2019, the reservation for other backward classes in the order of direct heavy in public services and posts has been increased from 14 percent to 27 percent.
- It is effective from 8th March 2019.

Avani of Madhya Pradesh and gold medal in Para Olympics

- Avani Lakhera won the gold medal by securing first position in 10m air rifle shooting On August 30.
- Avani has got a bronze medal in 50m rifle shooting.
- Avni has become the first Indian woman to win two medals simultaneously in an Olympics or Paralympics.
- Mr. Praveen Kumar has won silver medal in high jump in Tokyo Para Olympics.

The Amrit Mahotsav of Independence organized in Jabalpur

- on 18th September on the Amrit Mahotsav of Independence a multi-faceted function was organized in Jabalpur. Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah was present in this program.
- In this ceremony which is held in Jabalpur, the sacrifices of Adivasi Jannayak Shankar Shah and Raghunath Shah were remembered. A lyric-musical presentation of the saga of his sacrifice was given.
- Exhibition, book launch, film screening and e-album release in this pride celebration of tribal heroes in the 75th Amrit Mahotsav of Independence
- A film centred on Amar Shaheed Raja Shankar Shah and Raghunath Shah was screened at the ceremony.
- The book 'Jange-e-Azadi Mein Jabalpur' was released, an e-album focusing on the freedom fighters, Jannayaks and fighters of the freedom struggle was also released.

1 year increase in backlog and special recruitment drive for disabled people

- The time limit to increase of the special recruitment drive by one year from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 to fill the backlog / carry forward posts of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes and vacancies of disabled people. The decision has taken by Madhya Pradesh government

Amendment in the Rules of Madhya Pradesh Higher Judicial Service (Recruitment & Conditions of Service)

- It has been decided to add 14 (a) after rule-14 of the Madhya Pradesh Higher Judicial Service (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2017.
- Under this rule, a bond of Rs 5 lakh will be executed from the candidate at the time of regular appointment to the effect that it will be mandatory for him to provide services for a minimum period of 3 years after assuming office, otherwise the above amount will be paid by resigning for any reason. or an amount equal to 3 months salary and allowances, whichever is higher.
- In case of breach of the above conditions, the entire amount of the bond may be forfeited.
- If the applicant resigns for government service of the Central or Madhya Pradesh state with prior permission, then he is not required to pay the amount of the bond.

Financial Assistance Scheme for Promotion of Production of Ethanol and Biofuels

- It was decided to issue financial assistance scheme for promotion of production of ethanol and bio-fuels.
- Financial assistance of Rs 1.50 per liter will be provided to petroleum oil producing companies for supplying ethanol produced by the unit for 7 years from the date of commercial production.
- Stamp duty and registration fee will be reimbursed 100% on purchase of land for the units.
- Reimbursement of 50 percent of the project expenditure for water/electricity/road infrastructure development on private/undeveloped government land allotted to industry, subject to a maximum of Rs.1 crore for each item.

- The implementation of this policy MPIDC, Bhopal will be the nodal agency .

Prithvipur of Niwari district will be made assembly constituency

- An announcement has been made by Chief Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan to make Prithvipur Vidhan Sabha constituency of Niwadi district a model.
- A new market will be started in Prithvipur for the farmers. Along with this, efforts will also be made to set up processing plants.

Pucca housing for every poor in the state

- Survey of the poor left in the survey list of the year 2011 will be done, in which the names of eligible beneficiaries will be added and an amount of one lakh 20 thousand will be given to them for construction of houses.
- Under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, pucca houses are being given to the beneficiaries.
- CM Rise School will be opened in every 20-25 km area of the state. It will have all the facilities including library, laboratory.

Other facts of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana :-

- This scheme was started in the year 2014, in which it was announced to provide a pucca house to every family by the year 2022 (completed 75 years of independence).
- Under this, availability of pucca house, water and electricity will be made available to each beneficiary family.

National Highway Project launched

- National Highway project was started in Indore on 16 September, in which the cost of about 11 thousand crores has been estimated.

- The Delhi-Mumbai Expressway is the most ambitious project under the Bharat Mala Project which connecting the country's capital Delhi to the country's commercial capital Mumbai.
- This national highway will pass through five states of the country which are including Madhya Pradesh, Delhi, Haryana, Rajasthan, Gujarat and Maharashtra.
- The state of Gujarat near the Anas river, passing through Mandsaur, Ratlam, Jhabua districts, entering Madhya Pradesh from Ramganj Mandi in Rajasthan. The 245 km area of the project will covered .
- Along with Jhabua, Ratlam, Mandsaur, the border districts of the state, Ujjain, Indore will also be able to connect directly to Delhi and Mumbai. This expressway will be beneficial in the development of Madhya Pradesh.

Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana started Second phase

- The second phase of Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana has been started, under which free gas connections are being distributed to 5 lakh mothers in Madhya Pradesh.
- The schemes made for the welfare of the poor are being implemented since the first term of the year 2014 of the Central Government.
- With the slogan "Clean Fuel, Better Life", the Central Government on 1 May 2016 launched a social welfare scheme - "Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana" by the Central Government.

State rewarded for developing health institutions (according to National Quality Assurance criteria)

- The state was rewarded for developing primary health institutions according to the National Quality Assurance Norms (N Q A S). The state was awarded the Runner-up Award in the country.

- Awards are given on the basis of meeting the quality standards of Maternity OT at the national level in the targeted program “World Patient Safety Week”.
- The main objective of this program is to provide proper care as per all standards at an excellent level during delivery in the delivery room and obstetric operation theatre.
- It aims to reduce maternal and neonatal mortality to zero and ensure proper mother-child care.

Madhya Pradesh included in Prime Minister swamityav yojna

- Pradhan Mantri Swamitva Yojana has paved the way for the development and progress of rural society of India directly.
- Madhya Pradesh is also in the 6 states that have been selected as a trial in the scheme.
- We are working continuously with co-ordination and administrative strength to ensure that the farmers of the entire state get maximum benefit from this scheme.
- The objective of this scheme is to strengthen the infrastructure in the agriculture sector, so that farmers can be ensured access to the big markets of the country.

Digital Agriculture in Madhya Pradesh

- Madhya Pradesh has continuously increased the use of modern technology and services to increase the yield of crops and make agriculture efficient and profitable.
- Continuous work is being done under Digital Agriculture in Madhya Pradesh to increase the productivity in agriculture and reduce the cost of production.
- Using information technology (IT) to make agriculture socially, economically and environmentally beneficial and sustainable is called digital agriculture.

“One District One Product” Scheme

- 1 November M.P. “One District – One Product” scheme will be started on the foundation day, in which each district should demonstrate its productive achievement.
- Every district of Madhya Pradesh has some special produce. In some district by the wood craftsmen, in whom by the weavers in the district, and in some district the work related to agriculture and food processing is done on a large scale.
- under the “One District-One Product” scheme 64 products from all the districts have been selected.
- In addition to the main product of the district, the work of promoting other products should also be included in this scheme.

Beginning of Bijgram to benefit farmers

- Seed villages of Agriculture Department will be launched in Madhya Pradesh. Under this, special programs will be organized in the villages dominated by Scheduled Castes and Tribes.
- In this, certified and improved seeds of new varieties of food grains, pulses and oilseeds crops will be made available to 50 beneficiary farmers in each seed village.
- The seed minikit will contain seeds of high yielding varieties. This will motivate the farmers to adopt new varieties. Certified seeds of new varieties will reach the farmers directly, which will benefit the farmers more.

District as Export Hub started to increase exports in the state

- State Export Promotion Council will be constituted in each district for export related work in every district of the state.
- Export Promotion Council will work to encourage exports in the state.
- MP in the state Trade Portal and Export Helpline launched.
- for industrial units and exporters to understand export related techniques and to connect exporters with major importers of the world Madhya Pradesh Trade Portal will act as a bridge.
- Problems of exporters can be resolved immediately through export helpline.
- Utkarsh value chain will be developed on the basis of international market survey for export prospects and production demand and keeping in mind the quality of the product.

Fortified rice will be made available at the rate of Re 1 per kg in the public distribution system.

- It will remove anemia and micronutrient deficiencies.
- This scheme was started in Singrauli as a pilot project, in which fortified rice will be made available at the rate of Re 1 per kg at ration shops under Public Distribution System.
- Food fortification has been nationally recognized as a low cost effective intervention to reduce anemia through Anemia Mukh Bharat program and Poshan Abhiyaan.

Related facts:-

- fortification means increasing the content of essential micronutrients in food. So that the nutritional quality of food is improved, the body can get the nutrients which remove malnutrition. To understand it in simple words, the nutrients are mixed from above by grinding the grains in it. Along the same lines, rice fortification is a process of adding micronutrients to regular rice. These nutrients are added keeping in mind the dietary requirements.

- In the fortification of rice, the help of many techniques such as coating and dusting is used. As micronutrients are added from above by grinding grains. The same is done with rice. In this, micronutrients are added to the rice by grinding it into a powder. This fortified rice mixture can then be reshaped into a rice shape called a 'fortified rice kernel'.
- Under this project, fortified rice kernels are mixed with normal rice in the ratio and then it will be distributed among the people under public distribution system and mid day meal.

New dimensions of tourism development in Madhya Pradesh

- 'Tourism Circuits' are being developed by connecting other important tourist and historical sites near the major tourist destinations of the state.
- Under the rural tourism program, villages in 6 major cultural areas of Madhya Pradesh are being developed as heritage villages. More than 1500 homestays will be developed in it.
- Recently, Ladpura Khas village of Orchha has been nominated in the category of 'Best Tourism Village' in the United Nations World Tourism Organization Award by the Union Ministry of Tourism.
- Under 'Wellness Tourism', wellness centers are being set up at 7 important tourist destinations of the state.

Responsibility to nurture women self help groups

- 7 THR plants were set up by the Madhya Pradesh Government in the year 2018 to provide THR for pregnant / midwives, children from 6 months to 3 years and adolescent girls in the Anganwadis of the state.
- Plants were set up at Dewas, Dhar, Hoshangabad, Mandla, Sagar, Shivpuri and Rewa.
- Ready to Eat Take Home Ration (THR) is being given in all other districts of the state (except the districts of Bhopal division) through all these plants.

The sand rule was amended

- Amended Madhya Pradesh Sand (Mining, Transport, Storage and Trade) Rules 2019 by the Council of Ministers.
- Under this, the product of Rs. 250 and tendered sand quantity will be determined as initial base price (upset price).

Construction of sports village in Satgarhi will be done with public private participation

- International level “Sports Village” at village Satgarhi Bhopal will be constructed through public private participation.

250 crore bank loan distribution to 20 thousand women self-help groups

- Bank loans of Rs.250 crore will be disbursed to self-help groups under credit linkage.
- Diet allowance of Rs 22 crore 77 lakh will be distributed to 2 lakh 27 thousand 687 women of Sahariya, Baiga and Bhabaria tribes and Rs 163 crore 28 lakh will be distributed to the flood victims as relief.
- Aahar anudaan yojna has been started for special backward tribes. in 14 districts Sheopur, Morena, Gwalior, Shivpuri, Guna, Ashoknagar, Datia, Shahdol, Umaria, Anuppur, Chhindwara, Mandla, Balaghat and Dindori the families of these tribes reside. One thousand rupees are being received per month in the account of these families.
