Now, central government is also giving the facility of Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana under the aegis of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao for girls of the country. This scheme is for the girls till the age of 10 yrs. Now girls of the country can also avail the advantage of Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana along with Beti Bachao Beti Padhao.

Under this scheme, every month Rs. 1000 will be deposited in bank account of girl child, which in 14 years will become Rs. 1,68,000. This money in 21 years will mature to the tune of Rs. 6,07,128 which will be subsequently handed over. When your daughter attains the age of 18 years, you can withdraw 50% of the amount and balance amount can be withdrawn during marriage time.

4 reservoir will be built in Western Rajasthan by investing 1275 crore

Jodhpur, Jaisalmer and Bikaner will be provided with extra 1100 cusec water. Central water power ministry has given its approval in Jal Jeevan Mission. This project will supply drinking water till 2054.

On the other hand, under the aegis of Indira canal project 42 projects for 6707 villages have been approved. This will provide drinking water to 20.87 lakh houses.

On Delhi-Mumbai expressway 4 lane will be only for electric vehicle

1350 km. long greenfield expressway from Delhi to Mumbai will not only save time, but also cut down heavily on pollution. Some 350 km work on this expressway has already been completed which is built by Rs. 1 lakh crore. Right now only 8 lanes are being built. Apart from this 4 lanes can be added later on. 2 are meant for going and 2 for coming. These four lanes will be only for electric vehicles. This expressway will save some 32 crore litres of fuel. Rajasthan-374 km, Madhya Pradesh-245 km, Gujarat-423 km, Maharashtra 171 km. When completed, this expressway will cut short 150 kms. while travelling between Delhi and Mumbai. This travel will be completed in mere 13 hours.

Jaipur roads will become dust free, 82.5 crore will be spent

Under this, city roads will become dust free as well as greenery will be developed. Heritage and Greater Nagar Nigam is going to spend some 82 crore 50 lakh on these works.

Order to resume work on 25 thousand solar pumps under Kusum Yojana by 30 September

Principal secretary of Agriculture and Park department Bhaskar A. Sawant has given order to start work on 25 thousand solar pumps under Kusum yojana by 30 September.

Under Kusum yojana, Centre and state government both convert some 3 crore agriculture pumps run by diesel and petrol into solar pumps. Because solar pumps will be run by energy received from sun. Rajasthan Kusum yojana is very important for farmers of Rajasthan. Under this yojana, government will motivate farmers to install solar pumps in their farms. For this yojana, in the beginning government declared fund of Rs. 50 crore, Rajasthan government has taken decision that in the coming 10 years some 3 crore pumps and 17.5 lakh diesel run pumps which are being used in farming are to be converted into solar pumps.

Asian development bank approves Rs. 22.12 billion loan

In Rajasthan for development of basic infrastructure for sanitation and services a loan of 300 million dollar (Rs. 22.12 billion) has been approved.

Asian development Bank (ADB): Asian development Bank is a regional development bank. It was established on 19 December, 1966. ADB has total of 68 members. India is one founding member. Out of total member, 49 belongs to Asia-Pacific zone, while 19 members are from other regions. Its objective is to stimulate social and economic development in Asia.

- Till 31 December 2019, five biggest shareholders of ADB include United States of America (total share 15.6%), People's Republic of China (6.4%), India (6.3%), and Australia (5.8%).
- Headquarter of ADB is situated in Manila, Philippines.

Rajasthan tourism business (amendment) Bill 2021 passed

After this amendment now those people who misbehaves with tourist will be severely punished. Now it has been included in cognizant crime. The state minister for tourism Govind Singh Dotasara while presenting the bill on the floor of the house said that article 27 A has been added in this amendment.

Ranking and Index

Udaypur ranks 2nd among 25 excellent cities of the world in terms of hospitality

In terms of hospitality, Udaypur has been ranked 2nd and Jaipur has been ranked 17th among excellent 25 global cities. In the readership survey of world famous magazine

travel and laser this rank was given. In this survey questions were related to landmark, culture, food, options of shopping and friendliness. Last year, Udaypur was on 7th place. This year, Jaipur slipped 14 notches to earn 17th place.

3 Institutes of Rajasthan included in top 100 educational institutes of the country

Among top 100 institutes of the country, 3 institutes (BITS, Vansthali, MMIT) could secure place in overall category. This situation is when our most of the institutes are good on most of the parameters. But in peer perception i.e. perception developed among friends and employers, we have lagged behind in ranking.

Unemployment rate in August remained 8.32% and for Rajasthan it is 26.7%

According to private institution- Central for monitoring Indian Economy (CMIE) which keeps an eye upon unemployment rate in the country, National unemployment rate in the country increased by 1.37% to become 8.32%.

It is lowest in Sikkim with 0, highest in Haryana with 35.7%, and Rajasthan is on the second place.

RGHS Yojana begins on the pattern of CGHS

The chief minister of Rajasthan, Ashok Gehlot has started a new yojana for giving better facilities of medical treatment to MLAs of state, state government with ex-MLAs, employees and pensioners of bodies, board and corporations. Under this, first stage of Rajasthan Government Health Scheme (RGHS) has been approved.

Under this scheme, 13 lakh beneficiary families will get cashless medical facility of Indoor, outdoor and tests in all state hospitals, approved private hospitals and private test centres. Those employees and pensioners who were appointed before 1 January, 2004 will get unlimited amount of outdoor facility. Employees who have been appointed after 1 January, 2004 will get cashless OPD treatment facility till Rs. 5 lakh. They will also get additional medical facility of Rs. 5 lakh for critical illnesses and at the same time they can also avail outdoor medical facility of Rs. 20 thousand as yearly limit.

Combined District Ranking issued by Education Department for August month

Churu district came first in the state and Jaipur and Chittorgarh secured second and third rank respectively.

Ba-Bapu plantation campaign in schools also

In all government schools of the state, this monsoon plantation campaign will be run. Secondary Education Directorate has given direction to all chief district education officials to run Ba-Bapu plantation campaign till 11 September in all districts which fall under them.

Number of Black bucks cross 3500 mark in Talchhapar

In this sanctuary which is spread over an area of 719 hectares, there are more than 3500 black bucks. According to last animal population census here deer population grew by 148.

Talchhapar: Talchhapar is ideal for sighting of black buck who are found here in abundance. Apart from this, in this sanctuary one can see many desert animals and reptile species. In this sanctuary, there are total 122 species of birds belonging to migrants and local species. Talchhapar sanctuary is situated in Chhapar village which falls in Churu district of Rajasthan.

Avani Lakhera of Rajasthan secures first gold in Paralympic

Woman para rifle shooter of India Avani Lakhera. Indian woman para shooter Avani Lakhera currently became first Indian woman to get gold medal in 10 meter air rifle standing in Tokyo Olympics. He had already in 10 meter air rifle shooting range in sh1 category secured fifth place in the world.

Avani Lakhera was born in Jaipur, Rajasthan. She became handicapped during an accident. She was born on 8 November 2001 in Jaipur, Rajasthan.

Paralympic -

First Paralympic games were held in Rome in 1960, in which some 400 players of 23 countries participated. Indian players first time participated in Paralympics in 1968 Mexico.

But India first time participated in Tel Aviv (1968) Paralympic, from 1984 paralympic India is its regular participant.

Devendra Jhajharia wins silver medal in paralympic

Devendra Jhajharia secured silver medal in javelin sports in Tokyo Paralympic 2020. Devendra Jhajharia in Tokyo Paralympic 2020 in F46 final threw javelin to a distance of 64.35 mt. and won silver medal. He brought laurels for the country. Devendra secured F46 category world record in his name. He is the first and only double gold medalist of India in Paralympic games.

Devendra Jhajharia is from Churu district. He also won gold medal in para athletics championship held in Dubai in 2019. He was awarded with Arjun award in the year 2019. He also won silver and bronze medal in Asian para games. He was conferred with Maharana Pratap award in 2018.

Sundar Singh Gurjar wins bronze medal in paralympic

In Javelin sports of Paralympic 2020, Sundar Singh Gurjar secured bronze medal in his name. Paralympic player Sundar Gurjar who belongs to Devlen of Todabheem of Karauli district, threw javelin 64.01 meter to secure bronze medal.

In senior shootingball championship Rajasthan women team secures silver medal and men team secures bronze medal

Senior Shootingball championship which was held in Bhadara, Hanumangarh, women team of Rajasthan secured silver medal while men team secured bronze medal. In men category Punjab came first and Uttar Pradesh came second. In women category, Delhi came first.

Women team got defeated at the hands of Delhi by 9-15, 14-16. Men team in a hard fought battle defeated Uttarakhand by 15-8, 15-11.

In Under-12 Tennis Jahnvi of Jaipur in Pakistan

India's Under-12 tennis players are on the tour of Pakistan for Asian ATF regional qualifying event. This also includes Jahnvi Kajala of Jaipur. This is first time that Junior national team has gone to Pakistan for multi-national tournament.

Third biggest cricket stadium of the world will be built

Third biggest world cricket stadium which will be constructed in Jaipur, will be built by DV project limited of Chhattisgarh.

28th Mathuradas Mathur award declared

In year 2020-21, Ravi Vishnoi in senior category and in junior category Aman Singh Sekhawat selected as best cricketer.

Jahnavi wins Under-14 IETA doubles title
