Banking & Financial Awareness

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has increased the daily limit of Immediate Payment Service (IMPS) transactions to what amount from earlier ₹2 lakh ______ ₹5 lakh.
 - Note:
 - "Immediate Payment Service (IMPS) offers instant domestic funds transfer facility 24x7 through various channels.
 - With RTGS now operational round the clock, there has been a corresponding increase in settlement cycles of IMPS, thereby reducing the credit and settlement risks.
- 2. Which fintech company has announced its foray into the 'Buy Now Pay Later' (BNPL) segment, with the launch of 'postpe' _____ BharatPe.

Note:

- > Using Postpe platform, customers can avail interest-free credit limit of up to Rs 10 lakh.
- > It is not only limited to big-ticket purchases but can also be used for micro-purchases.
- With this, BharatPe aims to facilitate a loan book of \$300 million in the first 12 months for its lending partners.

Note:

- With this, the bank becomes the first scheduled private sector bank to receive approval after the announcement by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman allowing all banks to participate in governmentrelated business.
- Ministry of Finance had announced to allow all private sector banks to participate in govt-related business-like collection of taxes, pension payments and small savings schemes in February 2021.
- 4. In association with which organization the International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA) and GIFT City launched I-Sprint'21, the global FinTech Hackathon Series "Sprint01: BankTech", focussed on fintech for the banking sector ______ NITI Aayog.

Note:

- First Sprint of the series is 'Sprint01: BankTech', which focuses on FinTechs for the Banking sector.
- > It has been launches in collaboration with GIFT city and NITI Aayog.
- > Partners for the Hackathon: ICICI Bank, HSBC Bank, iCreate, Zone Startups and Invest-India.
- **5.** What is the theme of the Fourth Cohort under Regulatory Sandbox as announced by the Reserve Bank of India recently _______ 'Prevention and Mitigation of Financial Frauds'.

Note:

- > Before this, RBI has already launched three cohorts under Regulatory Sandbox.
- Focus of 4th cohort will be to use technology to reduce the lag between occurrence and detection of frauds, strengthening the fraud governance structure, and minimising response time to frauds
- > RBI has also decided to facilitate on-tap applications for themes of all cohorts
- According to the Reserve Bank of India's Monetary Policy Report released in October 2021, what will India's GDP growth rate for 2022-23 (FY23) _____7.8%.

- ▶ RBI releases Monetary Policy Report on a half-yearly basis.
- ▶ RBI has projected India's GDP growth at 9.5% for 2021-22 in the MPC meet of October 2021
- 7. Which company has taken over the responsibilities of Jaipur International Airport from Airports Authority of India (AAI) ______ Adani Group.



- Gautam Adani-led Adani Group took over the responsibilities of Jaipur International Airport from Airports Authority of India (AAI) for a period of 50 years.
- Adani Airports will work on the operations, management and development of the Jaipur airport through PPP mode.
- 8. Power Finance Corporation Ltd (PFC) was incorporated in which year that was accorded 'Maharatna' status recently ______1986.

Note:

- ➢ It will enable PFC to offer competitive financing for the power sector, which will go a long way in making available affordable & reliable 'Power For All 24x7'.
- PFC was incorporated in 1986 and is the largest Infrastructure Finance Company exclusively dedicated to Power Sector under the administrative control of Ministry of Power.
- **9.** Which cooperative bank has partnered with which Axis Securities to offer its customers investing services through a 3-in-1 account ______ **Saraswat Cooperative Bank Ltd.**

Note:

- The facility will integrate savings bank account maintained by the co-operative bank with the demat and trading account offered by Axis Securities, which is a subsidiary of Axis Bank.
- This facility will make it easier for customers to transfer funds quickly, reduce paperwork and most importantly, provide a comprehensive platform to invest in various investment instruments like equities, derivatives, currency, commodities, MF, IPO, etc.
- **10.** Which becomes the 12th Small Finance Bank (SFB) of India ______ Unity Small Finance Bank.

Note:

- RBI has issued a new bank license after a gap of nearly 6 years.
- > The new SFB, has been incorporated as 'Unity Small Finance Bank'.
- > It is the first time ever that two partners are uniting equally to build a Bank.
- > Centrum's MSME and Micro Finance businesses shall be merged into Unity Small Finance Bank.
- Which small finance bank has partnered with Go Digit General Insurance to offer instant, easy-to-understand insurance products through the bank's network of branches across India digitally _____ Shivalik Small Finance Bank Limited.

Note:

- > The insurance products include health insurance plans, motor insurance, home and shop insurance.
- The Shivalik bank's current customers are generally classified into different segments such as retail, manufacturing and services, housing and real estate, and microfinance.
- ➢ Go Digit General Insurance will support the bank in making the process of buying cover, submitting and receiving claims easier for its customers.
- 12. The National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has sanctioned an assistance of Rs 303 crore to which state government for the construction of 24 bridges in the state _____ Odisha. Note:
 - The rural infrastructure projects will improve connectivity for 24.13 lakh people in 823 villages across 13 districts.
- **13.** Which bank has tied up with CredAvenue for portfolio management of its securitisation book and implemented CredPool, an institutional debt platform of CredAvenue _____ Federal Bank.

Note:

- This arrangement, will help the bank digitally monitor its asset-backed securities (ABS) and mortgage-backed securities (MBS) pool assets more efficiently through the technology platform.

- ➢ So far, the bank has enrolled (cumulative) 2,30,432 accounts under APY. During 2020-2021, the bank has enrolled 68,961 accounts against the target of 38,160.
- ➤ The bank with jurisdiction over nine district has a business turnover of ₹28,410 crore with a clientele base of nearly 90 lakh.

- International E-Waste Day (IEWD) is observed every year on which date to promote the correct disposal of e-waste throughout the world, increasing re-use, recovery and recycling rates _____14th October.
 Note:
 - > Theme for 2021 IEWD: Consumer is the key to Circular Economy!
 - > 2021 is the 4th edition of the International E-Waste Day.
- **11.** What is the theme of the World Standards Day 2021 _____ **Standards for sustainable development goals –** shared vision for a better world.

Note:

- 2. Where was the "National Mission on Edible Oil- Oil Palm Business Summit" was held recently _____ Guwahati. Note:
 - > Keeping in view the vision of the Prime minister for holistic and balanced progress of North East.
 - > The conference began under the chairmanship of the Union Agriculture Minister Shri Narendra Singh Tomar.
 - The National Mission on Edible Oil Oil Palm is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme worth Rs.11000 crores which aims to add 6.5 lakh hectares for palm oil by 2025-26.

- NITI Aayog United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) Handbook on Sustainable Urban Plastic Waste Management is especially launched for ______ Urban local bodies. Note:

Note:

- It is based on six pillars:

Note:

- > 2021 RECAI 2021 ranked top 40 global markets (nations) of the world on the attractiveness of their renewable energy investment and deployment opportunities.
- > Top performer: United States, followed by China
- **15.** Which state's transport department planning to equipped driving licences and vehicle registration certificates with QR codes _____ **Delhi**.

Note:

- New driving license will have an advanced microchip with features like Quick Response (QR) code and Near Field Communication (NFC).
- It will have the owner's name printed on the front while the microchip and QR code will be embedded at the back of the card.
- It will also enable unification in linking and validating one's information to smart cards with Sarathi and Vahan, the two web-based databases of all driving licenses and vehicle registrations.
- 16. What is India's rank in the Henley Passport Index 2021, which lists the world's most travel-friendly passports _______90th.

Note:

- The index ranks the passports of countries according to the number of destinations their holders can visit without a prior visa. The rankings are based on the analysis of data provided by the International Air Transport Association (IATA).
- India, which held the 84th rank last year, fell down to the 90th position, with its passport holders allowed to travel visa-free to 58 countries.
- > India shares the rank with Tajikistan and Burkina Faso.
- **17.** Government has set a target to increase the number of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras to ten

thousand by _____ March 2024.

- Chemicals and Fertilizers Ministry said, the number of Janaushadhi stores has increased to eight thousand 366 and all the 736 districts have been covered.
- Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana, PMBJP was launched in November, 2008, with an objective of making quality generic medicines available at affordable prices to all.

- **1.** Which state /UT has approved its ambitious Health Information Management System (HIMS) project under which each citizen will have a health card, which will be a repository of their medical information _____ Delhi. Note:
 - > The government said doctors will be able to see a patient's medical history using the card and the patients will be able to make appointments from home.
 - > The health card will act as a unique health identifier for each individual through which everything from their medical history to appointment dates can be accessed.
 - All citizens between 1 and 18 years would be issued a health card linked to their parent's health card.
- 2. Wada Kolam Rice (Zini Rice) belongs to which state that has been accorded 'Geographical Indication' (GI) tag recently Maharashtra.

Note:

- Wada Kolam rice is also known as Zini or Ihini rice
- Grain is off white in colour, with small granules and a peculiar aroma after cooking. It can completely absorb daal and is in demand for these qualities
- > Its price is between Rs 60-70 per kg in domestic markets
- They are short, soft and easily digestible.
- 3. `In which state the Union Minister of Civil Aviation, Jyotiraditya M. Scindia has virtually inaugurated Greenfield Sindhudurg airport under RCS-UDAN (Regional Connectivity Scheme – Ude Desh Ka Aam Naagrik) scheme ______ Maharashtra.

- Karuppur Kalamkari painting is done on pure cotton cloth.
- > The 'Kallakurichi Wood Carving' is a unique form of wood carving where the craftsmen are specialized in carving temple related products and furniture.
- Kanyakumari Cloves is known for its rich aromatic oil content, with volatile oil content of 21% (normal 18%) resulting in 86% of eugenol.

- > Delhi govt has launched mentorship programme 'Desh Ke Mentor' for children studying in Classes IX to XII of government schools.

 - Note:
 - > It is the latest project in the oil-rich federation's ambitious space programme.
 - The project targets a 2028 launch with a landing in 2033, a five-year journey in which the spacecraft will travel some 3.6 billion kilometres (2.2 billion miles).
 - The project comes after the Emirates successfully put its Amal, or "Hope", probe in orbit around Mars in February.
 - > The Emirates plans to send an unmanned spacecraft to the moon in 2024.

Note:


