The Reserve Bank of India has decided to permit banks to offer interest rates on FCNR (B) deposits using widelyaccepted overnight 'ARR' for the respective currency' with an upward revision in the interest rates ceiling by 50 basis points (bps). What does 'A' stands for in ARR \_\_\_\_\_\_ Alternative. Note:
  - The Reserve Bank of India has decided to permit banks to offer interest rates on FCNR (B) deposits using widely-accepted 'Overnight Alternative Reference Rate (ARR) for the respective currency' with an upward revision in the interest rates ceiling by 50 basis points (bps).
  - This comes in view of the impending discontinuance of LIBOR (London Inter-Bank Offered Rate) as a benchmark rate.
- 9. Which bank has signed an MoU with the Army Insurance Group (AGI) to offer retail mortgage loans to the Indian

#### Army \_\_\_\_\_ Axis Bank.

Note:

- > The bank will offer best-in-class products and services to defence personnel to cater to their home loan requirements.
- Through this partnership, it will exclusively offer higher loan amounts as well as the facility to transfer the balance of their loans from AGI to Axis Bank.
- **10.** Who launched RBI Integrated Ombudsman Scheme based on "One Nation-One Ombudsman" by integrating which of the following schemes \_\_\_\_\_ Narendra Modi.

Note:

- The Reserve Bank of India will provide a multi-lingual toll-free phone number for all the relevant information on grievance redress.
- > It will also provide assistance for filing complaints.
- Earlier, there were three Ombudsman schemes in India (i) Banking Ombudsman Scheme (ii) Ombudsman Scheme for Non-Banking Financial Companies and (iii) Ombudsman Scheme for Digital Transactions.
- **11.** According to the Reserve Bank of India what will be the Consumer Price Index or CPI inflation for 2021-22

#### Note:

- > The inflation was 7.61% in October last year.
- > The RBI has projected the CPI inflation at 5.3 per cent for 2021-22.
- According to MoSPI data, inflation in the food basket rose to 0.85 per cent in October, compared to 0.68 per cent in the preceding month.
- 12. With which oil company the NTPC Limited signed an MoU to collaborate in the field of Renewable Energy (RE) and mutually explore opportunities for supply of low carbon/RE RTC (round the clock) captive power \_\_\_\_\_ Indian Oil Corporation Limited.

Note:

Note:

- Ramakrishna Rao was a former Chairman of Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education (AP-SCHE).
- He served as the Vice-Chancellor of Andhra University and Chancellor of GITAM (Gandhi Institute of Technology and Management) deemed-to-be university.
- He has also served as President of the US-based Parapsychological Association and as the President of Indian Academy of Applied Psychology.
- 2. Renowned personality and Padma Vibhushan awardee Balwant Moreshwar Purandare (Babasaheb Purandare) passed away recently, he was a noted \_\_\_\_\_ Historian.

Note:

- > Purandare (99), an authority on the Maratha warrior king Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj.
- Raja Shivchhatrapati, Purandare's popular two-part, 900-page magnum opus on Shivaji Maharaj in Marathi, was first published in the late 1950s and has since been a staple in Marathi households, going through numerous reprints over decades.
- **3.** Renowned personality Wilbur Smith (88) passed away at his home in South Africa, he was a noted \_\_\_\_\_ **Author.** Note:
  - Smith was born in today's Zambia in 1933 to a British family.
  - > He grew up experiencing the forest, hills and savannah of Africa on his parents' ranch.
  - > He credited his mother with teaching him to love nature and reading.
  - In 1964, the author published his first novel, "When the Lion Feeds," which narrates the tale of a young man growing up on a South African cattle ranch.

- The celebration of World Urbanism Day is promoted by the International Society of City and Regional Planners (ISOCARP).
- 2. International Day of Radiology is observed globally every year on \_\_\_\_\_ 8th November. Note:



- The day is celebrated to promote the awareness of the value that radiology contributes to safe patient care, and improve public understanding of the vital role radiologists and radiographers play in the healthcare continuum.
- > The theme for 2021 is 'Interventional Radiology Active care for the patient'.
- Radiology is the medical discipline that uses medical imaging to diagnose and treat diseases within the bodies of animals and humans.
- **3.** In India, the "National Legal Services Day" is observed every year on which date by all Legal Services Authorities \_\_\_\_\_09 November.

- The Day is celebrated to make people aware of the various provisions under the Legal Services Authorities Act and the right of the litigants.
- On 11 October 1987, the Legal Services Authorities Act 1987 was enacted, while the act took effect on 9 November 1995.
- World Science Day for Peace and Development is celebrated each year on \_\_\_\_\_ **10<sup>th</sup> November**.

- The World Pneumonia Day is observed every year on which date across the world to raise awareness, promote prevention and treatment and produce action to combat the disease \_\_\_\_\_12th November.
   Note:
  - ➢ It was first celebrated in 2009.
  - > Pneumonia: Any infection causing an inflammatory response in the lung.
- World Diabetes Day (WDD) is observed every year on which date to growing concerns about the escalating health threat posed by diabetes \_\_\_\_\_\_ 14<sup>th</sup> November.

Note:

- > The day also birthday of Sir Frederick Banting, who co-discovered insulin along with Charles Best in 1922.
- The day was launched in 1991 by the IDF and World Health Organization (WHO) and became an official UN Day in 2006.
- Theme for WDD 2021-23: Access to Diabetes Car If Not Now, When?
- 8. On which date, Children's Day is celebrated every year to mark the birth anniversary of India's first Prime Minister Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru \_\_\_\_\_14th November.

Note:

- > Children's Day is popularly known as **'Baal Diwas'** in India.
- > The day aims at increasing the awareness of the rights, care and education of children.
- On this day, many educational and motivational programs are organised across the country, by and for children.

#### **New Appointments**

- 1. Who has been appointed as the next Chief of the Naval Staff (CNS) \_\_\_\_\_ R. Hari Kumar. Note:
  - > Presently, he is Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief (FOC-in-C) Western Naval Command.
  - > He will take over on November 30 when incumbent Admiral Karambir Singh retires from service.
  - Vice Admiral Kumar graduated from J-squadron, 61 Course National Defence Academy in December 1981 and was commissioned into the Executive Branch of the Navy on January 1, 1983.

### Who has been appointed as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Barclays with immediate effect \_\_\_\_\_ CS Venkatakrishnan.

- 4. Who has been appointed as the Director-General of Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) \_\_\_\_\_ Satya Narayan Pradhan.

- Mr Pradhan, a Jharkhand cadre 1988-batch IPS officer, was currently holding additional charge of NCB chief despite holding the responsibility of Director General of National Disaster Response Force (NDRF).
- He was given additional charge of NCB Director-General after Rakesh Asthana was appointed as Delhi Police Commissioner.
- Morinari Watanabe belong to which country who has been re-elected as the President of the International Gymnastics Federation (FIG) for a period of three year \_\_\_\_\_ Japan.

- > He was first elected as the President of FIG in 2016 for a four-year term beginning January 2017.
- ➢ His term was then extended by one year.
- > He will now continue to hold the position till 2024.
- > Headquarters of International Gymnastics Federation: Lausanne, Switzerland
- 6. Who has been appointed as the Director General of National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) \_\_\_\_\_ Atul Karwal. Note:
  - > He is an IPS Officer of 1988-batch Gujarat cadre.
  - He will replace Satya Narayan Pradhan who has been appointed as Director-General of Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB).
- 7. Who has been appointed as the Director General of Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) \_\_\_\_\_ Sheel Vardhan Singh.

Note:

- The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the proposal of the Ministry of Home Affairs for appointments.
- Singh, a 1986 batch Indian Police Service officer of Bihar cadre, is currently Special Director in the Intelligence Bureau. Singh has been appointed as the Director-General, CISF up to 31.08.2023.

- He will support raising awareness for the millions of hungry people and engage his supporters in advocacy for a Zero Hunger world.
- As the goodwill ambassador, he will inform about the main drivers of hunger and showcase the efforts of UN WFP to tackle both immediate needs and root causes of hunger.

- ▶ He will serve a five-year term starting January 1, 2023.
- Prof. Patel has served in various roles such as the Director at the Gujarat National Law University and member of the 21st Law Commission of India.
- > Prof. Patel garnered 163 votes in the UN General Assembly out of 192 members present and voting.

Note:

- Ms. Sinha succeeds Amar Nagaram,

- > Myntra is a major Indian fashion e-commerce company headquartered in Bengaluru, Karnataka, India.
- **12.** Who has been appointed as Team India's T20 International captain \_\_\_\_\_\_**Rohit Sharma**.

#### Note:

- ➢ He has replaced Virat Kohli.
- Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) announced the decision, while also naming India's 16-man squad for the upcoming home series against New Zealand.
- Rohit Sharma was the frontrunner to replace Kohli as the T20I captain ever since Kohli made the announcement.
- **13.** Who has been appointed as the new Secretary General of Rajya Sabha \_\_\_\_\_ **PC Mody.** 
  - Note:
    - ▶ He was formerly working as the chairman of the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT).
    - He replaced P.P.K. Ramacharyulu, who was appointed to the post on 1st September, 2021 and has now been appointed as an adviser to the Rajya Sabha chairman.

 What is India's rank in the inaugural Global Drug Policy Index 2021, released by the Harm Reduction Consortium 18<sup>th</sup>.

#### Note:

- > The five lowest-ranking countries are Brazil, Uganda, Indonesia, Kenya, and Mexico.
- India's rank is 18 out of 30 countries.
- > It is a data-driven global analysis of drug policies and their implementation.
- 2. Which Indian city has been included in the UNESCO Creative Cities Network (UCCN) with a special mention for its craft and folk art \_\_\_\_\_ Srinagar.

Note:

- Srinagar joins Chennai and Varanasi UNESCO Cities of music; Jaipur UNESCO city of crafts and folk arts; Mumbai - UNESCO city of film and Hyderabad - UNESCO City of gastronomy.
- > Worldwide, 49 new cities have joined the UNESCO's Creative Cities Network (UCCN).
- 3. The Central government has launched 'DBT-Star College Mentorship Programme' for \_\_\_\_\_ Young Innovators. Note:
  - The 'DBT-Star College Mentorship Programme' will help towards the concept of networking, hand holding and outreach, said Singh who is the Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science and Technology.
  - The pan India scheme envisages a 'Star College' in every district of the country supported by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), under the science and technology ministry.
- **4.** Who has inaugurated the 14th edition of 'c0c0n', an annual Hacking and Cyber Security Conference \_\_\_\_\_ **Bipin Rawat.**

- The conference, which is being conducted by Kerala Police in association with two non-profit organisations, Society for the Policing of Cyberspace (POLCYB) and Information Security Research Association (ISRA), would be primarily discussing online scams and defenses during the lockdown period
- The conference is being held virtually so that people from across the globe can attend the event as the 13th edition of 'c0c0n' last year saw more than 6,000 attendees from around the world.
- 5. The union minister for Environment, Forest & Climate Change and Labour& Employment, Shri Bhupender Yadav has inaugurated the Ganga Connect exhibition showcased by National Mission for Clean Ganga, c-Ganga, and the High Commission of India at the \_\_\_\_\_ City of Glasgow College. Note:

- This project is important from the point of view preserving and protecting Ganga and its ecosystem and creating widespread awareness about the river basin."
- 6. What is the theme of the 40th edition of India International Trade Fair 2021 \_\_\_\_\_ Atmbirbhar Bharat. Note:
  - 40th edition of IITF is a magnum of India Trade Promotion Organization representing India in totality as an ideal destination for numerous business and investment opportunities.
  - > Bihar is the Partner State, while Uttar Pradesh and Jharkhand are the Focus States.
  - Overseas participation is from Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bahrain, Kyrgyzstan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, UAE, Tunisia, and Turkey.
- What is India's rank in the global Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI) 2022, released by Germanwatch along with Climate Action Network (CAN) and New Climate Institute on the side-lines of the COP26 \_\_\_\_\_10<sup>th</sup>. Note:
  - > It is being released by German-watch along with Climate Action Network (CAN) and New Climate Institute
  - India was at 10th place in 2020 as well
  - The report noted that no country performed well enough in all index categories to achieve an overall very high rating in CCPI. Therefore, once again, the top three places in the overall ranking remain empty.
- 8. Union Cabinet chaired by PM Narendra Modi has declared November 15 as 'Janjatiya Gaurav Divas' to mark the birth anniversary of \_\_\_\_\_\_ Birsa Munda.

- > The day is dedicated to the brave tribal freedom fighters and their sacrificed for the country.

- While Delhi's Air Quality Index (AQI) at 556 made it to the top of the list, Kolkata and Mumbai recorded an AQI of 177 and 169, respectively, at fourth and sixth position.
- > The cities with the worst AQI indices also include Lahore, in Pakistan, and Chengdu, in China.
- A real-time air quality information platform IQAir is also a technology partner of the United Nations Environmental Program (UNEP).

- 1. Which state topped in the third LEADS (Logistics Ease Across Different States) 2021 report \_\_\_\_\_ Gujarat. Note:
  - Gujarat occupied the first spot among 21 states, followed by Haryana, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, and Maharashtra in that order.
  - > The report ranks the states on the basis of their logistics ecosystem, highlights the key logistics-related challenges faced by the stakeholders and includes suggestive recommendations.
- 2. A new Biotechnology Centre for Northeast tribals has been inaugurated in which state of India \_\_\_\_\_ Arunachal Pradesh.

Note:

- Centre for Bio-resources and Sustainable Development will greatly help in improving the socio-economic status of tribal people in the State.
- The Centre aims at conservation and sustainable utilization of the local bio-resources using biotechnological tools and is ably supported by Department of Biotechnology.
- **3.** Which is the partner state of the 40th edition of India International Trade Fair 2021 \_\_\_\_\_ **Bihar**.

Note:

- Theme: Aatmanirbhar Bharat
- 40th edition of IITF is a magnum of India Trade Promotion Organization representing India in totality as an ideal destination for numerous business and investment opportunities.
- Which state government has launched a first of its kind road safety initiative named as 'Rakshak', to train first responders of road accidents \_\_\_\_\_ Odisha.

Note:

- Under Rakshak, 300 master trainers will train 30,000 local people, staying or working at the eateries and different business establishments located near accident-prone spots.
- > These 30,000 volunteers will be trained as First Responders to road accidents.
- > They will be equipped to administer first aid and pre-hospital trauma care to accident victims within the golden hour.

Note:

Central Govt will refund 80% of the sanctioned amount and the state government would bear the remaining 20%.



CM of Assam also flagged off four steel catamaran vessels at Pandu Port recently under World Bank-funded project to integrate high-quality passenger and vehicle ferry services into the state's wider transport network system.

1. Which country ranked first in the inaugural Global Drug Policy Index 2021, released by the Harm Reduction Consortium \_\_\_\_\_ Norway.

Note:

- > The five lowest-ranking countries are Brazil, Uganda, Indonesia, Kenya, and Mexico.
- India's rank is 18 out of 30 countries.
- > It is a data-driven global analysis of drug policies and their implementation.
- 2. Which neighbouring country has issued a Letter of Exchange (LoE) with India to formalize 7 additional Entry exit trade points \_\_\_\_\_\_ Bhutan.

#### Note:

- India and Bhutan will have seven additional entry and exit points for trade as part of measures to increase trade connectivity.
- These include Nagarkata Land Customs Station without commodity restriction; Agartala Land Customs Station; Pandu port (Guwahati Steamerghat), subject to cross border control at Dhubri; Jogighopa port subject to cross border control at Dhubri.
- **3.** With which country India has signed a pact aimed at spurring innovation and speeding up the development of dual use technologies by small and medium sized firms in both countries \_\_\_\_\_ Israel. Note:
  - The pact was signed between India's Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Israel's Directorate of Defence Research and Development (DDR&D).
  - The agreement known as the Bilateral Innovation Agreement will "promote innovation and accelerated R&D in startups and MSMEs of both countries for the development of dual use technologies.
- **4.** Which becomes the 101st member country to join the International Solar Alliance (ISA) \_\_\_\_\_ **USA.** Note:
  - ➢ ISA is an alliance of 124 countries.
  - It was initiated by India.
  - Most of the member countries are sunshine countries, lying either partly or completely between Tropic of Cancer and Tropic of Capricorn.
  - This alliance was launched with the objective of working for efficient consumption of solar energy and reduce dependence on fossil fuels.
- 5. Which country placed as the highest ranked country in Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI) 2022, released by Germanwatch along with Climate Action Network (CAN) and New Climate Institute on the side-lines of the COP26 \_\_\_\_\_ Denmark.

Note:

- The report noted that no country performed well enough in all index categories to achieve an overall very high rating in CCPI.
- Therefore, once again, the top three places in the overall ranking remain empty. Denmark, placed 4th, is the highest ranked country in CCPI 2022.
- India has retained its spot in the top 10 best performing countries for the third year in a row in the global Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI).

- Which IIT has bagged a grant worth \$250,000 from the XPRIZE Foundation, which is part of the Elon Musk Foundation at the COP26 summit in Glasgow \_\_\_\_\_\_ IIT Bombay. Note:
  - Four students and two teachers from IIT Bombay have won a grant of \$250,000 (approximately ₹1.85 crore) for the new-age technology at the Sustainable Innovation Forum at COP-26 in Glasgow.
  - > The grant has come from XPRIZE Foundation in collaboration with Elon Musk Foundation.
- 2. Who became India's seventh woman billionaire and the wealthiest self-made billionaire \_\_\_\_\_ Falguni Nayar. Note:
  - She established Nykaa in 2012.
  - She holds 53.5% stake in Nykaa and has a net worth of USD 7.48 billion.
  - This comes after the IPO of FSN E-Commerce Ventures which is Nykaa's parent entity. This is also the first woman-led unicorn to list on the stock exchange.

- 2. Veteran cricketer Dwayne Bravo is associated with which country who announced his retirement from international cricket \_\_\_\_\_ West Indies.

- > Dwayne Bravo hails from Santa Cruz, Trinidad.
- Dwayne Bravo has played in all seven T20 World Cups and he has been a part of the West Indies team that won the T20 Title in 2012 and 2016.
- > He has scored 1245 runs at an average of 22.23 and a strike rate of 115.38 and he has picked up 78 wickets.

Note:

- Starting from the second row, Verstappen made a brilliant move on the outside going into Turn 1 to take over Mercedes-Benz AMG's Valtteri Bottas and Lewis Hamilton, who started at pole and second place, respectively.
- Verstappen was never unsettled from there and comfortably took the win, with Hamilton eventually crossing the line in second place some 16 seconds behind after managing to hold off local hero Sergio Perez.

   Mitrabha Guha.

Note:

- The 20-year old Guha achieved the GM title after securing the final norm at the ongoing GM Mix 220 tourney in Novi Sad, Serbia.


