

Madhya Pradesh Specific November Monthly Current Affairs

Madhya Pradesh Foundation Ceremony Organization

- The 66th foundation day of Madhya Pradesh was celebrated as a Madhya Pradesh festival on the theme of self-reliant Madhya Pradesh.
- CM rise schools will be run with labs, computers, smart classes.
- 2 new schemes were announced at the function, one of which is Kusum Yojana and Udyam Kranti Yojana.

Kusum yojna

- Under this scheme local bodies will be assisted to set up 2 MW power plants.
- The power generated by these bodies will be procured by the government.

Mukhyamantri Udyam Kranti yojna

- Udyam Kranti Yojana has been started to provide employment to the youth
- Under this scheme, loans up to Rs. 50 lakhs will be given to the youth for employment, which will be guaranteed by the government.
- The age of the applicant should be 18 to 40 years and the educational qualification should be at least 12th class.

Budhni Art Festival

- This festival was organized to promote the wood art of Budhni.

Solar energy campaign

- Under the Solar Energy Campaign in the state, awareness will be created in the energy literacy campaign through awareness, communication of information and demonstration of energy saving methods.
- Kusum Yojana is being conducted under this campaign
- Online training will be given through mobile app and web portal.

The following schemes for tribal welfare are -

Ahar anudaan yojna -

- This scheme is being operated in 15 districts belonging to special backward tribes.
- This includes Rs. An amount of 1000 is deposited.

Akansha Yojna

- Under this scheme, free coaching and hostel is provided to the talented students of 11th and 12th class of Scheduled Tribes for preparation of national competitive examinations like JEE, NEET, CLET.

Pratibha Yojna -

- In this scheme students of tribal class are given incentive for admission in higher government educational institutions.

Coaching and promotion for All India Services -

- Under this scheme financial assistance is provided to such students of Scheduled Tribes who are receiving coaching by private institutions in the civil service examination.

Operation of Ajivika Express by tribal women

- Women of Patelia tribe of village Gagar Kheda of Simrod gram panchayat of Bamori development block of Guna district have taken innovative initiative for livelihood.
- Runs 11 seater Ajivika Express from Bishanwada to Guna

Launch of business center for business promotion of women self help groups

- A 'Business Center' will be opened for the business promotion of women self help groups of the state, which will assist women self help groups in the field of quality, branding, sales etc. of their products.

- It mainly featured Baiga, Pardhoni folk dance and Bundelkhandi martial arts arena.

- National Tulsi Samman for the year 2017 to 2020 and Rashtriya Devi Ahilya Samman for 2019 and 2020 were announced by the Department of Culture.
- Honors of the year 2017 to the eminent painter of Jaipur, Mr. Kailash Chand Sharma, honors of the year 2018 to the eminent flute player of Rajnandgaon, Mr. Vikram Yadav, honors of the year 2019 to the famous Kabir singer of Raipur, Dr. Bharti Bandhu and the year 2020 was given to Mr. Tilakram Pendram
- The honor of the year 2019 was given to Ms. Shanti Bai Maravi, a tribal artist of Mandla and the honor of the year 2020 was given to Ms. Malini Awasthi, a well known folk singer of Awadhi, Bhojpuri and Bundelkhandi style of Lucknow.

40th India International Trade Fair

- In the ongoing India International Fair at Pragati Maidan, Delhi, the Department of Science and Technology has specially displayed Madhya Pradesh's plans for investment and promotion in the field of information technology along with science in order to attract investors.
- Organizing the sixth edition of Jal Mahotsav
- The sixth edition of "Jal Mahotsav" was held at Hanuwantia Island, Khandwa
- The festival will run till January 20, 2022 (two months).
- For the convenience of tourists coming in "Jal Mahotsav", a bus will also be operated daily from Indore to Hanuwantia for two months.

Bhopal -Metro City

- The city of Bhopal can be called Green Bhopal, Clean Bhopal, Hi-Tech Bhopal as well as Metro City Bhopal.
- Recently Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the world class Rani Kamalapati Railway Station (Habibganj station old name) here.

Metro rail project

- Madhya Pradesh Metro Rail Corporation Limited is working on the project in Bhopal and Indore. In Bhopal, two metro corridors are to be constructed between AIIMS to Karond Crossroads and from Bhadbhada Crossroads to Ratnagiri Crossroads.
- A purple corridor in two corridors, the length of which will be 16.74 kilometers. The second red corridor with a length of 14.21 kilometers.
- There will also be an underground and elevated metro purple corridor. The Red Corridor will have 14 stations and the Purple Corridor will have 16 stations. Automatic rent collection will be arranged.

Indore for the fifth consecutive time in Swachh Survey 2021

- In Swachh Survey-2021, Indore has been the first in the country in cleanliness for the fifth consecutive time.
- In the Swachh Amrit Mahotsav held at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi, Indore was given the Safai Mitra Suraksha Challenge and the award for the best Swachh Shahar of the country.
- In the year 2021, 4 cities of Madhya Pradesh are included in the top 20 cities of the country in the category of population of more than 10 lakh,

in the sanitation honor ceremony. Indore got first, Bhopal got seventh, Gwalior got 15th and Jabalpur got 20th.

- The state has got the third place for following the urban bodies and various sanitation procedures.
- 6 cities of the state Indore, Bhopal, Ujjain, Dewas, Hoshangabad and Barwaha and Pachmarhi Kent were awarded for the Outstanding Award category.

Tribal Pride Day

Starting from Bhopal, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi started celebrating Tribal Pride Day on 15th November every year all over the country. Simultaneously, "Ration Your Village" scheme was started in 89 tribal development blocks to distribute fair price ration vehicles in the village itself.

Solution plan for payment of pending electricity bills

- For consumers who are unable to pay their electricity bills due to financial problems in Corona Crisis, Samadhan Yojana was started

Report of National Family Health Survey-5:

- The sex ratio has reached 956 daughters per 1000 sons in the year 2020-21. In the year 2015-16 this number was 927.
- Severe malnutrition decreased by 29.3%
- The state has moved from 30th position to 17th position. In Madhya Pradesh, severe malnutrition has declined by 29.3%.

- In leanness (vesting), the state ranks third among other states in terms of improvement. 26.4% in Madhya Pradesh. In the past, the state was at the 32nd position, which has now come to the 24th position.

Expansion towards solar energy

The Government of Madhya Pradesh is taking initiative in the development of solar energy and continuous efforts are being made for expansion, solar energy parks with a total capacity of 1500 MW will start functioning soon.

Sports Specials:

- International para swimmer Divyang Sri Satyendra Singh Lohia swam across the inaccessible channel of 36 km long Arabian Sea.
- He completed this exciting journey in 10 hours 3 minutes. Mr. Lohia is a native of village Gata in Bhind district.
- Earlier, he became the first Asian paralyzed swimmer to cross the Katrina Channel in the US in just 11 hours and 34 minutes.
- 64 The 64th National Shooting (Rifle) Championship was organized at Madhya Pradesh State Shooting Academy, Bisankhedi (Goragaon), Bhopal under the joint auspices of Sports and Youth Welfare Department and Indian National Rifle Association.
- M.P. State Shooting Academy has been set up on 37.16 acres of land in Gora village Bhopal. It is a world class shooting range and has been developed as a High Performance Center.

Construction of 6 medical colleges

- 6 new medical colleges will be constructed in the state.
- New medical colleges will be established in Mandla, Singrauli, Sheopur, Rajgarh, Neemuch and Mandsaur.

SIEMAT will be made an independent unit

- **SIEMAT** (Madhya Pradesh State Institute of Educational Management and Training) will be separated from the Academy of Administration and established as an independent unit.
- Training will be given to the officers of the Department of School Education and the Department of Tribal Affairs, the Department of Scheduled Caste Welfare and the Department of Labor related to school management in the **SIEMAT**.

Decision to withdraw the Penal Code (Madhya Pradesh Amendment) Bill 2017

With regard to the Penal Code (Madhya Pradesh Amendment) Bill 2017 (No. 26 year 2017), the Central Act, as a result of the Penal Law (Amendment) Act, 2018 (No. 22 of 2018) being enacted, a proposal was made to withdraw the said protected Bill.

Promotion of rice quality improvement

- Madhya Pradesh Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Development Policy 2021 has been amended to set up Sortex plant for the units engaged in paddy milling under technical upgrade in paddy mills for quality improvement and value addition of agricultural products.
- This will achieve high quality of rice and fulfill the objective of value addition of agricultural products.

New initiatives in energy literacy

- The Department of New and Renewable Energy (Madhya Pradesh) has taken the initiative to spread awareness among the people in the form of Energy Literacy Campaign (Usha) to prevent global warming, climate change and power wastage.
- The target is to make 50 lakh citizens energy literate in 6 months.

- Students of school and college including general public will be given detailed information about the importance of energy, carbon emissions from conventional energy, benefits of green energy like solar, wind, biomass etc. and economy etc.
