- > The global economy shrank by 4.3 per cent last year, over two-and-a-half times more than during the global financial crisis of 2009. The modest recovery of 4.7 per cent expected in 2021 would barely offset the losses of 2020.
- 7. Global financial services major HSBC has inaugurated its International Banking Unit (IBU) branch in which state Guiarat.

- > HSBC is one of the earliest global financial institutions setting up a branch at India's GIFT City and was the first bank to get a licence from the newly set up International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA), said a release by the company.
- > HSBC's IBU branch at Gujarat International Finance Tec City (GIFT City) will be operational for customer transactions with effect from January 27.
- 8. With which entity the government of India has signed a strategic partnership agreement to strengthen cooperation in global energy security, stability and sustainability _____ International Energy Agency (IEA).

Note:

- > This partnership will lead to an extensive exchange of knowledge and would be a stepping stone towards India becoming a full member of IEA.
- The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed by Power Secretary Sanjiy Nandan Sahai and IEA Executive Director Fatih Birol.
- 9. Which company has ranked first most-valued IT services brand globally, according to a report by Brand Finance _____ Accenture.

Note:

- According to a report by Brand Finance, Accenture retained the title of world's most valuable and strongest IT services brand with a record brand value of \$26 billion, while IBM continued at the second place with brand value
- **10.** According to a report by Brand Finance, Indian IT firm Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) ranked at what place _____ Third.

Note:

- Four Indian IT services companies -- TCS, Infosys, HCL and Wipro -- secured spots in the top-10 global tally.
- > TCS has celebrated strong revenue growth as demand grows for its core transformation services and through winning deals - worth over \$6.8 billion in the fourth quarter of 2020 alone.
- 11. What amount India has pledged UN peacebuilding as a token of engagement _____ USD 1,50,000.

Note:

- On India's peacebuilding efforts at UN, ambassador Tirumurti said, "As the world's largest democracy, we are conscious of the need to prioritize the building of governance structure to strengthen democracy and the rule of
- India also recognizes the critical role played by women and youth in peacebuilding activities. Strengthening security structures go hand in hand with strengthening civilian structures of good governance."
- 12. In accordance with the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) data, overseas investment by domestic firms fell by over _____42%.

Note:

- > Of the total FDI investment, USD 775.41 million was in the form of equity infusion, USD 382.91 million was in the form of loan, and USD 287.63 million was in the form of issuance of guarantee.
- > In November 2020, the total outward foreign direct investment (OFDI) was also trimmed by 27% to USD 1.06 billion as compared to October 2020.
- 13. Which general insurance company has launched Krishi Sakha App, a one-stop-shop for Indian farmers that offers them relevant information to cater their daily farming needs _____Bharti AXA General Insurance.

Note:

- > The farmers through this app will also have access to the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) portal for crop insurance related information.

The Scooters India brand name shall be sold separately as the company holds famous brands such as Lambretta, Vijai Super, Vikram and Lambro. 16. According to the report titled "World Economic Situation and Prospects 2021" by the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN-DESA), the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of India in FY 2020-21 is estimated to contract 9.6 per cent. Note: This projection is highest among major economies of the world. \triangleright On the global front, the economy is contracted by 4.3%(-4.3%) in 2020 but it projected a recovery of 4.7% in 2021. Earlier, International Labour Organization (ILO) also released its 7th edition of report title "ILO Monitor: COVID-19 and the world of work" which states that in 2020, the world faced a job loss of 255 million jobs where South Asia accounted for 80 million. 17. According to the Futures Industry Association (FIA), which stock exchange remained the world's largest derivatives exchange for the second consecutive year in 2020 in terms of number of contracts traded _____ National Stock Exchange of India. Note: In addition, the bourse has been ranked fourth in the world in cash equities by number of trades by the World Federation of Exchanges (WFE) for calendar year 2020. In the capital market segment, NSE has listed T-bills (Treasury Bills) and SDLs (State Development Loans) facilitating investors to transact in these securities, in addition to the existing dated Government Securities (G-sec) available for trading. **Obituaries** 1. Note: > The actor, who had charmed viewers with his benevolent grandfather roles, died a day after it was reported that he had recovered from COVID-19. The actor had started his career in the 1990s when he was well over 70 years of age. But his performances have seeped into the psyche of cinema lovers. Some of his notable works are Kaliyattam, Kalyana Raman, Madhuranombarakattu, Pokkiri Raja and Rappakal. 2. Renowned personality Cloris Leachman passed away recently, she was a veteran Actor. Note: A character actor of extraordinary range, Leachman defied typecasting. In her early television career, she appeared as Timmy's mother on the "Lassie" series. She played a frontier prostitute in "Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid," a crime spree family member in "Crazy Mama," and Blucher in Mel Brooks' "Young Frankenstein," in which the very mention of her name drew equine commentary. 3. Larry King, iconic radio and television host, who passed away hailed from which country ______ USA. Note: The company he co-founded, Ora Media, did not state a cause of death but media reports said King had been battling Covid-19 for weeks and had suffered several health problems in recent years.

 - > He sang a Bollywood song Beshak Mandir Masjid for the 1973 film Bobby and won Filmfare Best Male Playback Award.
 - Some of his ever-popular bhajans include Chalo Bulawa Aaya Hai, Tune Mujhe Bulaya Sherawaliye, Ambe Tu Hai Jagadambe Kali, Hanuman Chalisa, Sankat Mochan Naam Tiharo, Ram Se Bada Ram Ka Naam among others.

Important Days

1. National Girl Child Day in India is celebrated every year on _____ 24th January.

Note:

- National Girl Child day 2021 is being celebrated across the country with the objective of raising awareness on the issue of declining Child Sex Ratio (CSR).
- ➤ The celebrations will also mark the anniversary of Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme.
- 2. International Day of Education is observed every year on which date _____ 24th January.

Note:

- ➤ Every year, International Education Day is celebrated with a unique theme. Considering the COVID-19 pandemic, this year's theme for International Education Day is "Recover and Revitalize Education for the COVID-19 Generation."
- **3.** The National Voters Day is observed every year on which date _____**25th January**.

Note:

- ➤ The Election Commission was founded in 1950 on this day. The occasion was first celebrated in 2011.
- This year's theme is "Making Our Voters Empowered, Vigilant, Safe and Informed". One focus this year is highlighting the EC's feat of running elections safely during the pandemic.
- **4.** National Tourism Day is observed every year on which date in India ______**25th January.**

Note:

- ➤ It is not known when exactly this day came about. However, in 1948, a Tourist Traffic Committee was formed to promote tourism. The first regional offices of the same were established in Delhi and Mumbai. Three years later, in 1951, more offices were added in Kolkata and Chennai.
- **5.** International Customs Day (ICD) is celebrated every year on which date ______ **26**th **January**.

Note:

- > It is the day designated to honour the custom officials and agencies for their function in taking care of the flow of goods across the world borders.
- ➤ 2021 will witness the theme of "Customs bolstering recovery, renewal and resilience" which will focus on the endeavours of customs to emerge from the pandemic crisis and help people.
- 6. 'Data Privacy Day' is observed every year on which date to create awareness and promote privacy and data protection **28th January.**

Note:

- The main motto is to enhance awareness among businesses and users about protecting the privacy of their personal information online.
- Recently there has been a hue and cry from different sections of people when WhatsApp has announced data transfer of its users to it' parent organisation the Facebook.
- 7. Every year, Martyrs' Day is observed on _____30th January.

Note:

- The day is marked the death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, known as the father of the nation, across the country.
- Martyrs' Day or 'Shaheed Diwas' aims to pay tribute to the freedom fighters who lost their lives fighting for the freedom, welfare and progress of our nation.

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1.	Who has been appointed as the new Chairman & Managing Director (CMD) of Telecommunications Consultants India Limited (TCIL)Sanjeev Kumar. Note:
	According to an order from the Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT), Kumar has been appointed to the post for a period of five years from the date of assumption of the charge of the post, or till the age of superannuation, or until further orders, whichever is earlier.
2.	➢ He is currently serving as Director (Technical) in Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited (MTNL). Who has been appointed as the Managing Director (MD) of India's largest insurer Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) Siddhartha Mohanty.
	Note: Currently, he is serving as the managing director (MD) and chief executive officer (CEO) of LIC Housing Finance. He will serve as the MD of LIC till his superannuation on June 30, 2023.
	Mohanty will be replacing TC Suseel Kumar, who is set to retire on January 31, 2021.
3.	Who has been appointed to the 20-members High-Level Advisory Board of United Nations that will provide recommendations for the U.N. Secretary-General to respond to the current and future socio-economic challenges in the post-COVID-19 world Jayati Ghosh. Note:
	> Ghosh, 65, is a professor of economics at University of Massachusetts Amherst. She has taught economics at Jawaharlal Nehru University for nearly 35 years and has authored several books.
	➤ The UN Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UNDESA) announced that the 20 "prominent personalities, globally renowned for their intellectual leadership in economic and social fields, will form the second United Nations High-level Advisory Board (HLAB) on Economic and Social Affairs."
4.	Who has been appointed as the new chairperson of Broadcasting Content Complaints Council (BCCC) Justice Git Mittal.
	Note: Justice Mittal succeeds former Supreme Court Judge, Justice Vikramajit Sen, whose tenure as BCCC chairperson has
	ended.
	Having served as the first woman Chief Justice of Jammu & Kashmir High Court, she is also the first woman chairperson of BCCC.
	J K Shivan has been appointed as the Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer (MD & CEO) of which bank Dhanlaxmi Bank. Note:
	 It may be recalled that the shareholders of the Kerala-based had voted against MD & CEO Sunil Gurbaxani On September 30, 2020. Then, in December that year, the lender appointed Shivan as the new MD & CEO. However, the banking regulator, Reserve Bank of India (RBI), had asked the Dhanlaxmi Bank Board to get
	shareholders' approval before appointing J K Shivan as the next chief of the bank.
6.	Whose appointment as treasury secretary has been confirmed by the US Senate Janet Yellen. Note:
	Yellen steps into the role with some advantages: She is well known and well respected among lawmakers of both parties, and she has experience with enormous economic challenges.
	➤ The 74-year-old previously broke barriers as the first female Fed chief.
7.	Who has been sworn in as the new U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken. Note:
	Blinken will become America's top diplomat as the world confronts a confluence of threats: the COVID-19 pandemic, climate change and a great-power competition that increasingly pits the United States against China on trade, technology and other issues.
	Blinken will be charged with unraveling much of President Donald Trump's foreign policy, which made even some of his most ardent Republican supporters squeamish.
8.	Marcelo Rebelo de Sousa has been re-elected as the president of which country Portugal. Note:
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- ➤ He belongs to Social Democratic Party (Partido Social Democrata-PSD)
- ➤ He was elected as the president for 1st term in 2016.
- ➤ He was one of the founders of the People's Democratic Party, later the Social Democratic Party, and was party leader from 31 March 1996 to 27 May 1999.
- 9. Who has been appointed as the new Managing Director of State Bank of India (SBI) for a period of 3 years _______ Swaminathan Janakiraman.

- Swaminathan Janakiraman was serving as the deputy MD(finance) of SBI.
- Ashwini Kumar Tewari was serving as MD and Chief Executive Officer(CEO) of SBI Card, a subsidiary of SBI.
- ➤ The Banks Board Bureau (BBB) in October 2020 recommended their names for post of MD at SBI.
- **10.** Kaja Kallas has been appointed as the first female Prime Minister which country _____ **Estonia.**

Note:

- ➤ She succeeds Jüri Ratas. She is the leader of the Reform party.
- ➤ The 15-member Cabinet of Prime Minister Kaja Kallas is a coalition of 2 parties namely, Reform Party & Centre Party.
- **11.** Thomas Bach re-elected second term as President of which International Organisation until 2025 _____ **International Olympic Committee.**

Note:

- ➤ Bach, a 66-year-old German lawyer, is set to be confirmed for a second and final four-year term at an IOC session in March in Athens.
- ➤ Bach was initially elected for an eight-year term as Olympic chief in September 2013, taking over from Belgian Jacques Rogge. If re-elected, Bach's term will end in 2025, a year after the Paris Olympics.

Important News - India

1. The Union Cabinet has given its approval to the new Joint Venture Company (JVC) for an investment of Rs.5281.94 crore in Ratle Hydro Electric Project (850 MW). It is located in which river _____ Chenab.

Note:

- ➤ The project is located on river Chenab, in Kishtwar district of Union Territory (UT) of Jammu and Kashmir (J&K)
- ➤ It will be commissioned within 60 months.
- The life cycle of the project will be 40 years.
- 2. Power Grid Corporation of India Limited (POWERGRID) has signed an agreement with which state to improve telecom connectivity in the remote & hilly areas of the state _____ Himachal Pradesh.

Note:

- ➤ POWERGRID has created about 67, 500 kms of Optical Fiber Communication (OFC) network which connects over 1000 plus locations across India
- POWERGRID's OFC network covers all major towns & cities of India including the hilly & difficult terrains of Jammu & Kashmir (J&K) & North Eastern Region.
- **3.** According to the Global Climate Risk Index 2021, India is at what position among the most-affected countries by the devastating impact of climate change globally in 2019 ______ **Seventh.**

Note:

- As per the the report by Germanwatch, a Bonn-based environmental organization, India was preceded by Mozambique, Zimbabwe, Bahamas, Japan, Malawi and Afghanistan in the list of countries most affected by the impacts of extreme weather events in 2019.
- ➤ Between 2000 and 2019, over 475,000 people lost their lives as a direct result of more than 11,000 extreme weather events globally and losses amounted to around US \$2.56 trillion (in purchasing power parities).
- **4.** Who inaugurated the 'Bharat Parv 2021', a virtual national festival showcasing the country's diverse culture, cuisines and handicrafts ______ **Om Birla.**

Note:

Minister of State (Independent charge) for Tourism and Culture Shri Prahlad Singh Patel was also present on this occasion.



- The Ministry of Tourism in collaboration with other central Ministries is organizing this year a virtual 'Bharat Parv' event from 26th to 31st January 2021, showcasing the spirit of 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat'.
- **5.** For the first time, a 122-member tri-service contingent of which country participated in Republic Day Parade 2021 ______ **Bangladesh.**

- The 122-member contingent of the Bangladesh Armed Forces comprising soldiers of the Bangladesh Army, sailors of the Bangladesh Navy, and air warriors of the Bangladesh Air Force was led by the contingent Commander Lieutenant Colonel Abu Mohammed Shahnoor Shawon and his deputies, Lieutenant Farhan Ishraq and Flight Lieutenant Sibat Rahman.
- All the three services of the Bangladesh Armed Forces had played a key role in securing independence for their country in the Bangladesh Liberation War of 1971
- 6. Who has launched the mobile action game Fearless and United Guards (FAU-G) on the occasion of the 72nd Republic Day _____Akshay Kumar.

Note:

- Akshay unveiled the game with an animated trailer. He wrote, "FAU-G: Fearless And United Guards. Face the enemy. Fight for your country. Protect our Flag. India's most anticipated action game, Fearless and United Guards: FAU-G takes you to the frontlines and beyond!
- ➤ The game has been developed by Bangalore based studio nCore Games, with a concept by Akshay himself.
- 7. The Textiles Committee of the Ministry of Textiles has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Nissenken Quality Evaluation Centre of which country to boost export of Textile and Apparel in that country _____ Japan.

 Note:
 - The MoU signing ceremony was held through video conferencing which was presided over by Minister of Textiles Smriti Irani and State Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry of Japan Yasumasa Nagasaka.
 - The main objective of the MoU is to provide required support to textile's trade and industry for ensuring quality as per the requirement of Japanese buyers.
- **8.** What is India's rank out of 98 countries in the COVID-19 performance index published by the Australian think-tank, Lowy Institute ______ **86th**.

Note:

- > In the index India ranked 86 out of 98 countries, while the United States placed 94 and Brazil at the bottom of the index
- > Sri Lanka was the best faring nation in South Asia, ranking 10, while the Maldives was at 25, Pakistan at 69, Nepal at 70, and Bangladesh at 84.
- > The think-tank said China was not included "due to a lack of publicly available data on testing".
- 9. For the conservation of which of the following species the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has released 'National Marine Action Plan' _____ Marine Turtle.

Note:

- > Speaking at the virtual launch event the Union Environment Minister said that both floral and faunal diversity including the marine biodiversity is the beauty of India and we need to conserve it with best possible action and interventions.
- India has rich marine biodiversity along a vast coastline of over 7,500 km. From colorful fish, sharks, including Whale Sharks, turtles and big mammals like whales, dolphins and dugongs to bright corals, marine habitats not only harbor diverse species but also provide resources essential for human wellbeing.
- **10.** What is India's rank among 180 countries in the Corruption Perception Index (CPI) 2020 released by the Transparency International _______**86**th.

Note:

- ➤ India's ranking on the Corruption Perception Index (CPI) 2020, has slipped from 80 to 86, even as its score has decreased only slightly by one point from 41 in 2019, to now stand at 40.
- > The index released annually by Transparency International, which is a global civil society, ranks 180 countries by their perceived levels of public sector corruption according to experts and business people.
- **11.** Which state has launched 'PANKH Abhiyan' for girl child on the occasion of National Girl Child Day 2021 _____ **Madhya Pradesh.**

Note:


