# **Banking & Financial Awareness**

1.	Which private sector bank in India has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with MUFG Bank of Japa	an for
	collaboration towards catering to the banking requirements of Japanese corporates present in India ICIO	CI Bank.
	Note:	

- The MoU establishes a framework of partnership between the banks across various domains including trade, investment, treasury, corporate and retail banking.
- It also paves way for the two banks to combine their individual strengths and cater holistically to the banking requirements of Japanese corporations operating in India.
- 2. The Reserve Bank of India in its 5th Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) review projected India's gross domestic Product (GDP) growth at what per cent for the FY2021-22 \_\_\_\_\_ 10.5%.

#### Note:

- The projection of Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation has been revised to 5.2% for the Q4FY21, 5.2 % to 5.0 % in H1FY22 and declined to 4.3% by Q3FY22.
- ➤ The MPC has given the mandate to maintain annual inflation at 4% until March 31, 2021 with an upper tolerance of 6% and lower tolerance of 2% i.e. within a band of +/- 2 %.
- 3. What is total amount to be provided to various sectors and banks under Targeted Long Term Repo Operations (TLTRO) scheme \_\_\_\_\_ Rs 1 lakh crore.

# Note:

- The sectors which could benefit from this move include construction, real estate, and microfinance. RBI will provide these funds under on-tap targeted long-term repo operations (TLTRO) at a floating rate linked to the policy rate for up to three years. At present, the repo rate is 4 percent.
- LTRO lets banks borrow one to three-year funds from the central bank at the repo rate, by providing government securities with similar or higher tenure as collateral.

- The scheme is a flagship programme launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi to facilitate bank loans between Rs 10 lakh and Rs 1 crore to at least one SC or ST borrower and at least one woman borrower per bank branch.
- **8.** US-based Triton Electric Vehicle has signed an MoU with which Indian company for developing electric vehicles and energy storage systems \_\_\_\_\_\_ Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL).

- As per the MoU, BEL will be the exclusive manufacturing partner to Triton in India for identified products, while Triton will provide the know-how and technical documentation required for manufacturing of these products.
- For requirements of Energy Storage System (ESS) in India, BEL will address the requirements as a prime contractor and Triton will provide the support as technology partner as per Make in India requirements.

- > IMD Director-General Dr. Mrutyunjay Mohapatra, while speaking with a private television channel, also revealed that a first-of-its-kind monsoon testbed is also being planned near Bhopal.
- **12.** What is India's rank in the 'Asia-Pacific Personalised Health Index' released by the Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU) \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ **10**<sup>th</sup>.

- Singapore ranked first in the index followed by Taiwan (2nd), Japan (3rd) and Australia (4th). Indonesia ranked 11th in the index.

- > The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) implemented this important initiative with the support of nodal agencies from all ten ASEAN countries, which included their Education Ministries and prominent universities.
- The Hackathon was inaugurated by Minister of Education Dr. Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' along with other dignitaries from ASEAN and India on 1 February.
- **16.** Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for the Discovery Campus of which IIT \_\_\_\_\_ **IIT Madras. Note:** 
  - > The campus will be built at Thaiyur near Chennai at an estimated cost of Rs 1,000 crores in the first phase, over an area of 2 lakh square metres.
  - > PM Modi also inaugurated the Chennai Metro Rail Phase-I extension project, which has been completed at a cost of Rs 3,770 crores.


