1. India ranked fourth most powerful military in world: Military Direct's study



• China has the strongest military force in the world while India stands at number four, according to a study "Ultimate Military Strength Index" released by defence website Military Direct.

1st Rank- China (Score- 82/100)

2nd Rank- USA (Score- 74/100)

3rd Rank- Russia (Score- 69/100)


4th Rank- India (Score- 61/100)

- The world's biggest military spender is the USA (USD 732 billion per year) followed by China (USD 261 billion) and India (USD 71 billion).
- Note: "Ultimate Military Strength Index" was calculated after taking into consideration various factors including budgets, number of inactive and active military personnel, total air, sea, land and nuclear resources, average salaries, and weight of equipment.
- 2. UNOPS partners with Government of Denmark to support Jal Jeevan Mission in Bundelkhand & Vindhya region of UP





• United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS) entered into a partnership with the Government of Denmark to support the Union Government's flagship programme, Jal Jeevan Mission in Uttar Pradesh.



The purpose of partnership between the Government of Denmark and UNOPS is to provide strategic technical support to Jal Jeevan Mission (Water program).

- UNOPS shall be focusing on instituting scalable delivery models in focused 11 water-scare districts of Uttar Pradesh in Bundelkhand and Vindhya regions.
- Note: The Jal JeevanMission aims to provide functional household tap connection to every rural household by 2024. This coincides with the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goal-6.

3. 'Mission Gramodaya' launched in Madhya Pradesh



- In Madhya Pradesh, Union Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar and Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan have launched the 'Mission Gramodaya'.
- Under the 'Mission Gramodaya', besides providing housing facilities in rural areas, fundamental infrastructure will also be expanded.
- Yojana, construction of 3 lakh houses was completed under the adverse circumstances of the Corona period.
- About 1 lakh 25 thousand beneficiary families of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana were given houses during the Mission Gramodaya programme.

4. POWERGRID launches Certified e-Tendering Portal 'PRANIT'



- Power Grid Corporation of India Limited (POWERGRID) has established an e-Tendering Portal 'PRANIT' which will lead to less paperwork and ease of operation, making the tendering process more transparent.
- It has been certified by Standardisation, Testing and Quality Certification Directorate (STQC), Government of

India.

- With this, POWERGRID is now the only organization in India to have an eProcurement solution on SAP Supplier Relationship Management (SRM).
- **About Power Grid Corporation of India Limited:** It is an Indian central public sector unit and a **Maharatna company** owned by the Ministry of Power,



Government of India which is headquartered in Gurugram, India and engaged mainly in Transmission of Power.

5. RBI sets up external advisory committee for evaluating banking applications



• The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) set up a Standing External Advisory



Committee (**SEAC**) which will evaluate applications for universal banks and small finance banks (SFBs).

- The committee has five members, with former **RBI deputy governor Shyamala Gopinath as the chairperson.** The panel will have tenure of three years.

6. Arindam Bagchi assumes charge as new Spokesperson of MEA



- A 1995 batch Indian Foreign Service officer, Arindam Bagchi assumed charge as the new Spokesperson of Ministry of External Affairs (MEA).
- Earlier, he was serving as the Joint Secretary (North) in the Ministry.
- He has replaced incumbent Anurag Srivastava.
- 7. Road Safety World Series T20 tournament: India Legends beat Sri Lanka Legends





- Sachin Tendulkar-led India Legends defeated Tillakaratne Dilshan's Sri Lanka Legends and emerged champions in the inaugural season of the Road Safety World Series T20 tournament in Raipur, Chhattisgarh.
- Player of the series: Tillakaratne Dilshan
- **Note:** The Road Safety World Series is a T20 cricket competition featuring retired cricketers and is organised by the Road Safety Cell of Maharashtra to raise awareness about road safety.
