## 1. India ranks 40th on International Intellectual Property Index 2021

The function of the formation of the for

- India ranked 40 among 53 global economies in the 9th International Intellectual Property (IP) Index.
- The overall global IP environment improved in 2020, with positive score increasing in 32 of the 53 economies measured by the IP Index.
- The USA topped the Index.
- About International Intellectual Property Index: Released annually by the US Chamber of Commerce Global Innovation Policy Centre (GIPC), USA, the Index evaluates Intellectual Property rights in 53 global economies from patent and copyright policies to commercialisation of IP assets and ratification of international treaties.
- 2. Parliament passes the National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Bill, 2021



- Rajya Sabha on March 24, 2021, passed the National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Bill, 2021. The bill was earlier passed in the Lok Sabha on March 22, 2021.
- The latest bill amends the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi Act, 1991 which provides a framework for the functioning of the Government of Delhi and the Legislative Assembly.
- The Bill provides that the term 'government' referred to in any law made by the Legislative Assembly of Delhi will imply Lieutenant Governor, LG.

3. 'Vajra' commissioned to the Indian Coast Guard

- Indian Coast Guard Ship 'Vajra' was commissioned by General Bipin Rawat, Chief of Defence Staff at Kattupalli in Chennai.
- This is the **sixth in the series of seven Offshore Patrol Vessels** constructed by M/s Larsen & Toubro Ltd.
- Vajra will be based under the Operational and Administrative Control of Coast Guard District (Tuticorin) and will be deployed extensively for surveillance in exclusive economic zones in the Indian Coastal region.
- 4. Asia's largest Tulip Garden in Srinagar opens



• In the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, Asia's largest Tulip Garden in Srinagar has been opened for the general public and tourists.

• About Tulip Garden (Indira Gandhi Memorial Tulip garden): It is the

largest tulip garden in Asia spread over an area of about 30 hectares.

- It is situated in the valley of the Jabarawan Hills on the banks of Dal Lake.
- The garden was opened in 2007 with the aim to boost floriculture and tourism in Kashmir Valley.
- Note: The Tulip festival, organised at the onset of spring season in the Valley, is an annual celebration that aims to showcase the range of flowers in the garden as part of tourism efforts by the government of Jammu and Kashmir.
- 5. Shri Sanjay Dhotre releases Commemorative Postage Stamp on 100 years of first visit of Mahatma Gandhi to Odisha





- Shri Sanjay Dhotre, Minister of State for Education, Communications and Electronics & Information Technology digitally released a Commemorative Postage Stamp on 100 years of first visit of Mahatma Gandhi to Odisha.
- This Commemorative Postage Stamp celebrates an important event of Indian History which is the first visit of Mahatma Gandhi to Odisha on 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 1921.
- It energized the Non-Cooperation movement and strengthened the cause of the freedom struggle.
- 6. Andhra Pradesh to launch India's first "Government-run Ambulance Network" for animals



- The Andhra Pradesh government has decided to set up mobile ambulance services "Government-run Ambulance Network" for animals to boost the animal husbandry and veterinary sector in the state.
- The Animal Husbandry Department has been further directed to set up one Mobile Ambulance Veterinary Clinic at every assembly constituency.
- These mobile ambulances shall provide veterinary first aid services along with spot diagnosis and attending to emergency cases.

- 7. Russia launches 38 foreign satellites from 18 countries





- **Russian space agency 'Roscosmos'** successfully launched 38 foreign satellites from a Soyuz 2.1a carrier rocket from Baikonur cosmodrome, Kazakhstan.
- The rocket will place in orbit 38 satellites from 18 countries, including South Korea, Japan, Canada, Saudi Arabia, Germany, Italy and Brazil.
- Among them is the **Challenge-1**, the first satellite made completely in **Tunisia**, which was created by the Telnet telecommunications group.
- Note: Recently, India's PSLV-C51 launched Brazil's Amazonia-1, 18 other satellites.

## 8. Justice N.V. Ramana to be next Chief Justice of India



• Chief Justice of India S A Bobde has recommended the Union Government to appoint the senior most Supreme Court Judge Justice N V Ramanna as the 48th Chief Justice of India.

• Chief Justice Bobde is set to retire on 23rd April, 2021.

Note: Justice Ramana

was elevated as the Chief Justice of Delhi High Court on September 2, 2013 and was elevated as a Supreme Court Judge on February 17, 2014.

9. US Senate confirms Indian-American Dr Vivek Murthy as Surgeon General
