Subject: Reopening of the Window for Submission of Online Applications for the various non teaching posts, in Compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court's Decision (Civil Appeal No. 1007 with 1008 of 2021) in University of Delhi Vs Delhi University Contract Employees Union & Ors. dated 25.03.2021

In compliance of the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court referred above, the window for inviting online applications for the various posts is again opened herewith. The last date for receipt of online applications will be **28.04.2021**. Details regarding the online application, educational qualification experience (wherever applicable) and other eligibility criteria, etc., are provided in the Information Brochure accessible at: <https://recruitment.nta.nic.in> / www.du.ac.in.

It is further notified that Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court is only for the post of Junior Assistant. However, the window for inviting applications is being opened for all advertised posts.

Eligible and interested candidates are required to apply online up to **28.04.2021 (upto 23:50 Hrs)** on the above mentioned websites, by paying prescribed application fee mentioned therein by **29.04.2021 (upto 23:50 Hrs.)**.

Further, in compliance of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court following credits shall be added in the final score (in terms of Para 13 (b) of the said decision) obtained by those applicants who are working on contract / daily wages / adhoc basis in the University or its colleges provided that they have put in atleast one year of service, for their placement in the respective merit list for the written examination as per the notified scheme (Para 13 (b) of the said decision is reproduced as below):

"13.

(b).....those employees who were engaged in the year 2011 be given the benefit of 10 marks in the ensuing selection process while for every additional year that a contract employee had put in, benefit of one more mark subject to the ceiling of 8 additional marks be given. In other words, if a contract employee was engaged for the first time in the year 2010, he shall be entitled to the benefit of 11 marks, while one engaged since 2003 shall be given 18 marks, as against the appointee of 2011 who will have the advantage of only 10 marks. The contract appointees of 2012 and 2013 will have the advantage of 9 and 8 marks respectively."

Note: Since the Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court is only for the post of Junior Assistant, this clause would be made applicable for the post of Junior Assistant. For the remaining posts the criteria defined in the Information Brochure already available on the website under reference shall apply.

Further, it is brought to the notice of all the interested applicants that the facility for correction in their data (wherever necessary), will be operational on the website: <https://recruitment.nta.nic.in> and www.du.ac.in from **30.04.2021 to 02.05.2021** only with respect to the additional application received for the various advertised posts during the period between **31.03.2021 to 28.04.2021**.
