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Q.1 Kanha Tiger Reserve is situated in Mandla district of _____. **Solution:**

• Kanha Tiger Reserve also called Kanha National Park is one of the tiger reserves of India and the largest national park of Madhya Pradesh state in India.

• Note: Kanha national park cum Tiger reserve extends over an area of over 1,940-sq-kms.

Q. 2 What is the currency of Tanzania?

Solution:

• Dodoma is the capital and Shilling is the currency of Tanzania.

• Tanzania is a large country in Eastern Africa within the African Great Lakes region.

• Note: Tanzania is diverse, composed of several ethnic, linguistic and religious groups.

Q.3 The Salim Ali Bird Sanctuary is located in which state of India?

Solution:

• Salim Ali Bird Sanctuary is an estuarine mangrove habitat located on western tip of the Island of Chorao along the Mandovi River, **Goa**, in India.

• Note:-The sanctuary is named after Salim Ali, the eminent Indian ornithologist.

Q.4 Inle Lake, is the first UNESCO Biosphere Reserve of which of the following countries? **Solution:**

• Myanmar has launched its first **UNESCO Biosphere Reserve–Inle Lake** in Shan state. The Inle Lake was designated as UNESCO Biosphere reserve in Paris in June 2015.

• Note: With this, Myanmar fulfilled its commitment to bio-diversity and eco-system conservation under the UNESCO's Man and Biosphere Programme.

Q.5 Which among the following city is not the route of Yamuna River?

Solution:

• Yamuna river does not flow in Rajasthan, thus kota is not the route of Yamuna River.

Q.6 The "Vijay Hazare trophy" is associated with the game of_____. Solution:

• Vijay Hazare trophy is associated with the game of "cricket".

• This trophy, also known as the Ranji One Day Trophy, as a limited-over cricket domestic competition involving state teams from the Ranji Trophy plates.

• Note: It is named on the famous Indian cricketer Vijay Hazare.

Q.7 The headquarters of the World Economic Forum (WEF) is located in ______. **Solution:**

• The World Economic Forum (WEF), based in Cologny-Geneva, Switzerland, was founded in 1971 as a not-for-profit organization.

• Cologny is a municipality in the Canton of Geneva, Switzerland.

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• It was granted "other international body" status in January 2015 by the Swiss Federal Government under the Swiss Host-State Act (International Organization status requires multiple governments).

• The WEF's mission is cited as "committed to improving the state of the world by engaging business, political, academic, and other leaders of society to shape global, regional, and industry agendas"

Q.8 Which of the following states is a member of the 'Seven sisters' ?

Solution:

• The **Seven Sister states** are the contiguous states of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Mizoram, Nagaland and **Tripura** in northeastern India.

Q.9 Which monument was a symbol of the "power and majesty" of the British Empire? **Solution:**

• The gateway of India was a symbol of the "power and majesty" of the British Empire.

• The Gateway of India is an arch monument built during the 20th century in Mumbai, India.

• The monument was erected to commemorate the landing of King-Emperor George V and Queen-Empress Mary at Apollo Bunder on their visit to India in 1911.

• Built in Indo-Saracenic style, the foundation stone for the Gateway of India was laid on 31 March 1911.

• The monument has also been referred to as the Taj Mahal of Mumbai, and is the city's top tourist attraction.

Q.10 Nashik city is situated along which of the following rivers?

Solution:

• Nashik city is located on Godavari river in Maharashtra.

• The river **Godavari** originates from the Brahmagiri Mountain, **Trimbakeshwar** about 24 km (15 mi) from Nashik and flows through the old residential settlement.

• The river that flows through nashik is **Godavari**. It is the largest river in Maharashtra and often called as Ganga of the south.

Q.11 What is the name of the autobiography of the veteran cricketer VVS Laxman?

Solution:

• Veteran cricketer VVS Laxman has penned down his autobiography titled, '281 and Beyond'.

• The title of the book has been borrowed from the "Hyderabad stylist's" fabulous series-turning innings of 281 against Australia at the Eden Gardens in 2001.

• The Moortidevi Award is an annual literary award in India presented by the Bharatiya Jnanpith organization for a work which emphasizes Indian philosophy and culture.

• The prize includes an amount of Rupees Four Lac, a plaque, a statue of Saraswati, and a shawl.

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Q.13 With which of the following states can the Gambhira dance be associated? **Solution:**

• Gambhira dance is associated with West Bengal.

• This dance was originated among the Hindu community in West Bengal. With time, Muslims also became custodian of this dance.

• Bratislava is the capital of Slovakia. Bratislava is in southwestern Slovakia, occupying both banks of the River Danube and the left bank of the River Morava.
