Banking & Financial Awareness

- The Ministry of Finance is set to provide what additional amount to State Governments as Interest free 50-year loan under Scheme of Financial Assistance to States for Capital Expenditure' _____ **Rs. 15,000 Crore.**

Note:

- The loan will be provided to the States under 'Scheme of Financial Assistance to States for Capital Expenditure'. The Scheme was launched in 2020.
- It aims to nudge States to spend more on infrastructure and incentivize disinvestment of State Public Sector Enterprises (SPSEs).
- The Guidelines for the scheme were released by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance.

- What target has been set up by the central government for the food grain production in the crop year 2021-22 starting from July 2021 _____ **307.31 MT.**

Note:

- The target of total food grains production for 2021-22 is set at a record 307.31 MT, comprising 151.43 MT in kharif season and 155.88 MT during rabi.
- In 2020-21, production was 303.34 MT, against the target of 301 MT.
- For 2021-22, the target for rice production has been fixed at 121.1 MT, wheat at 110 MT, pulses at 25MT, coarse cereals at 51.21 MT and oilseeds at 37.5MT.

- Which company has partnered with Cryptocurrency exchange, Gemini & WebBank to launch a 1st of its kind, Cryptocurrency rewards credit card _____ **Mastercard.**

Note:

- Using this card, Clients will earn up to 3% in cryptocurrencies depending on their purchase.
- The rewards will be automatically deposited in the cardholder's Gemini account in real time.
- There will be no annual fee for the card and there is a 24/7 live customer support
- This is a small metal card with only the cardholder's name on it.

- Which bank has launched the "Immune India Deposit Scheme" a special deposit scheme to provide an additional interest rate of 25 basis points in addition to the applicable card rate for the vaccinated people _____ **Central Bank of India.**

- The Immune India Deposit Scheme has a maturity of 1111 days.
- The senior citizens are also eligible for the extra interest as applicable.

- According to a report by Brand Finance Insurance 100 2021 what is the position of LIC as the most valuable insurance brand globally _____ **tenth.**

Note:

- As per the report, the total value of the world's top 100 most valuable insurance brands declined by 6% from \$462.4 billion in 2020 to \$433.0 billion in 2021.
- However, LIC's brand value increased by almost 7% to \$8.65 billion
- Brand Finance is a London-based brand valuation consultancy.

- Which becomes the 3rd largest Indian IT services company by market capitalization of Rs 2.65 trillion _____ **Wipro.**

Note:

- TCS remains at the top of the list with a market cap of Rs. 11.51 trillion followed by Infosys.
- Wipro has also announced its commitment to achieving net-zero greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 2040, in line with the objective of the Paris Agreement to cap temperature rise to 1.5 degree Celsius.
- The country's third-largest largest software services company has set an intermediate target of 55 per cent reduction in GHG emissions by 2030 in absolute emission levels compared to its base year of 2016-17 (April-March).

7. Motilal Oswal Private Equity (MOPE) has acquired a minority stake in which small finance bank for \$ 25 million through a secondary acquisition _____ **Fincare Small Finance Bank**.
- Note:**
- The key investor in Fincare SFB, True North Fund V LLP got a partial exit from the firm after the deal of MOPE with Fincare SFB.
 - The deal was done by one of the growth capital funds of MOPE called India Business Excellence Fund–III (it was managed and advised by MOPE).
 - Secondary Acquisition – It means the acquisition of existing shares of the company by the trust on the platform of a recognised stock exchange for cash consideration.
8. Which public sector company has entered into the league of top 100 most valued companies in terms of market capitalization globally _____ **SAIL**.
- Note:**
- It regained market capitalisation (m-cap) of Rs 50,000 crore, after its stock climbed over 80 per cent in the past one and half month.
 - SAIL stood at 78th position in the overall m-cap ranking with a market cap of Rs 55,529 crore.
 - SAIL is one of the leading steel producers in India, which has 5 large integrated steel plants (Bhilai steel plant, Rourkela steel plant, Durgapur steel plant, Bokaro steel plant and IISCO) spread across 4 states in eastern India (Chattisgarh, Odisha, West Bengal and Jharkhand).
9. Which wind energy company has signed a Power Purchase Agreement with Solar Energy Corporation of India for supplying 540MW out of the total awarded capacity of 810 MW of blended wind power capacity _____ **JSW Renew Energy**.
- Note:**
- It is the single largest PPA for wind/blended wind power capacity awarded to a company.
 - JSW Renew Energy won the contract for 810 MW of blended Wind Power Project in a competitive bidding done by SECI in September, 2020.
 - India has set a target to raise the capacity of installed Renewable Energy (RE) generation plants to 450 GW by 2030.
10. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed a Rs 3 crore monetary penalty on which bank for contravention of certain directions issued by the RBI on 'Prudential Norms for Classification, Valuation and Operation of Investment Portfolio _____ **ICICI Bank**.
- Note:**
- Cause for the Penalty: For shifting of securities in May 2017 from HTM (held to maturity) category to AFS (available for sale) without explicit permission.
 - The penalty is intended only over the ICICI bank's insufficiency in regulatory compliance and not over any agreement by the bank with its customers.
11. World Bank's International Finance Corporation (IFC) has decided to make a debt investment of \$150 million in which Non-Banking Financial Company in India _____ **Bajaj Finance Limited**.
- Note:**
- The loan is sanctioned for five years to essentially support micro, small and medium enterprises (MSME).
 - Bajaj Finance will direct 3 times of its IFC's loan towards the MSME segment thus enabling combined funding of \$600 million/INR 4,530 crore towards MSME.
12. According to a new set of data released by the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), what is the position of India as a recipient of FDI inflows in 2020 _____ **Third**.
- Note:**
- It dropped to USD 846 Billion, which is a 15-year low (lowest since 2005).
 - India became the 3rd Largest Recipient of FDI inflows in 2020 with an inflow of USD 64 Billion.
 - China became the largest Recipient of FDI (USD 212 Billion) overtaking the United States (USD 177 Billion) for the 2nd time in six years, while Luxembourg finished 4th.
13. According to a new set of data released by the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), which country is the largest sources of FDI outflows in 2020 _____ **Luxembourg**.
- Note:**
- It dropped to USD 846 Billion, which is a 15-year low (lowest since 2005).

14. Which steel company has been selected by the Andhra Pradesh government as Joint Venture partner to set up a steel plant in the Kadapa district _____ **Essar Steel**.
- Note:**
- The AP government has previously selected Liberty Steel India Limited as the JV partner for construction and development of the YSR Steel Plant.
 - But that was cancelled based on the recommendation of SBICAP as Liberty steel India Limited was facing some financial issues.
 - The steel plant will be set up with a capacity of 3 million tonne per annum for producing high grade Steel products.
15. What amount will be provided by the Reserve Bank of India for three years at the repo rate to small finance banks (SFBs) to lend individuals, small and medium enterprises (SMEs) _____ **10,000 crores**.
- Note:**
- The RBI incentivised SFBs to lend microfinance institutions (MFIs) by granting priority sector lending status to such exposures.
 - Credit will be up to 10 per cent of a bank's priority-sector portfolio as of March 31, 2021.
 - While the facility is there until March 31, 2022, loans disbursed will continue to be classified as priority-sector lending till the date of repayment/maturity, whichever is earlier.
16. The Micro-Finance Institutions (MFIs) of what asset size will be eligible for Small Finance Banks' priority sector lending (PSL) _____ **Rs. 500 crores**.
- Note:**
- Currently, the SFB's PSL is not permitted for MFIs for on-lending.
 - This facility is made to be available up to March 31, 2022.
17. Which bank has been selected as the digital payments partner by the National Agriculture Market (eNAM) to facilitate online transactions for all stakeholders on the eNAM platform _____ **Kotak Mahindra Bank**.
- Note:**
- Under this partnership, the bank will provide payment, clearing and settlement services by integrating its payment system and portal directly with the payment interface of the eNAM platform to enable a trade facility between a buyer and seller (of agri produce).
 - The eNAM online ecosystem will enable farmers with more power over pricing decisions, greater transparency and availability of financial support.
18. According to UN Study, Online share of retail sales jumps to how much percent amid lockdowns _____ **19%**.
- Note:**
- Online sales accounted for 19% of overall retail sales in 2020, up from 16% a year earlier, according to estimates from the UN Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) based on national statistical offices in major economies.
 - South Korea reported the highest share at 25.9%, up from 20.8% the year before. China had a 24.9% share, Britain 23.3% and the United States 14.0%.
19. The Reserve Bank of India has joined the Central Banks and Supervisors Network for Greening the Financial System (NGFS) as a member. Where is the network located _____ **Paris, France**.
- Note:**
- The Network for Greening the Financial System (NGFS) is a network of 83 central banks and financial supervisors that aims to accelerate the scaling up of green finance and develop recommendations for central banks' role for climate change.
 - The NGFS was created in 2017 and its secretariat is hosted by the Banque de France. Its current chair is Dutch central banker Frank Elderson.
 - The NGFS has been awarded best green initiative of the year 2020 by Centralbanking.com.
20. Which company got the CCI nod to acquire 64.3% stake in BigBasket's B2B arm Supermarket Grocery Supplies _____ **Tata Digital**.
- Note:**
- The commission said Supermarket Grocery Supplies may acquire sole control of Innovative Retail Concepts that operates BigBasket's online retail unit.

Obituaries

1. Renowned personality Soli J Sorabjee passed away recently, he was former _____ **Attorney General**.

Note:

- Sorabjee was awarded Padma Vibhushan in 2002 for his defence of the freedom of expression and the protection of human rights.
- He was known for his contribution to the field of constitutional law.
- He had also helped India win in the International Court of Justice against Pakistan in the Atlantique downing case of 1999.

2. Renowned personality Pandit Debu Chaudhuri has passed away following COVID-19 related complications, he was a prominent _____ **sitar maestro**.

Note:

- Pandit Debu Chaudhuri had been awarded the Padma Bhushan in 1992 for his contribution to arts.
- He has also won the Padma Shri and Sangeet Natak Akademi Award
- He was also a teacher and writer, who penned six books. Apart from being an artist he was a disciple of Mushtaq Ali Khan.

3. National Awardee Karimanal Venkatesan Anand passed away at the age of 54 due to COVID-19 related complications, he was a veteran _____ **cinematographer**.

Note:

- KV Anand started his career as a photojournalist and later joined as an assistant of award-winning cinematographer PC Sreeram.
- He was the founding member of the Indian Society of Cinematographers (ISC).
- In 1994, He debuted as the cinematographer for the Malayalam film "Thenmavin Kombath" and won the National Film Award for Best Cinematography.

4. Renowned personality Amit Mistry passed away recently, he was a veteran _____ **Film Actor**.

Note:

- Actor Amit Mistry worked in TV shows like Tenali Rama, Madam Sir and played roles in many films like Yamla Pagla Deewana, Shor In The City.
- He was also actively involved in the theatre circuit especially in Gujarati shows. He had also acted in Gujarati films.
- Besides acting, he was also a dialogue writer and director. He was most recently seen playing the role of the protagonist's uncle in the web series Bandish Bandits.

5. Renowned personality Manas Bihari Verma passed away recently, he was a veteran _____ **Aeronautical Scientist**.

Note:

- He worked as a scientist at the Defence Research Development Organization (DRDO) for 35 years in the aeronautical stream.
- He was given the responsibility for the design of the Tejas aircraft mechanical system, where he led the team responsible for the full-scale engineering development of the Tejas aircraft in the Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA).

6. Former Union minister Jagmohan Malhotra passed away recently he also served as governor of which state _____ **Jammu and Kashmir**.

Note:

- Jagmohan served two terms as the governor of Jammu and Kashmir.
- He had also served as the lieutenant governor of Delhi and governor of Goa.
- He belonged to BJP and served as the Union Minister for Urban Development and Tourism in Atal Bihari Vajpayee-led government.

7. Oscar-winning 'Moonstruck' actress Olympia Dukakis passed away, she held from which country _____ **USA**.

Note:

- Olympia Dukakis was an American actress, director, producer, teacher and activist who performed in over 130 stage productions, over 60 films and in 50 television series.
- She won an Oscar award in 1987 and won an Academy Award and a Golden Globe for her performance in Moonstruck.
- She has also won an Obie Award for Best Actress in 1963 for her performance in Bertolt Brecht's Man Equals Man.

8. Renowned personality Abhilasha Patil passed away recently, she was veteran _____ **Actor**.

Note:

- Actress Abhilasha Patil, who featured in films like 'Good Newwz', 'Badrinath Ki Dulhania' and 'Chhichhore', passed away due to Covid-19 complications.
 - Apart from Bollywood movies, Patil also appeared in Marathi films such as 'Te Aath Diwas', 'Bayko Deta Ka Bayko', 'Prawaas', 'Pipsi' and 'Tujha Majha Arrange Marriage'.
9. Former Union Minister Ajit Singh has passed away recently belong to which political party _____ **Rashtriya Lok Dal.**
Note:
- He was the son of former Prime Minister of India, Chaudhary Charan Singh.
 - Ajit Singh had served as Minister of Commerce & Industry under Prime Minister V. P. Singh; Minister of Food Processing Industries in P. V. Narasimha Rao's cabinet; Minister of Agriculture in Atal Bihari Vajpayee's government and Minister of Civil Aviation in Manmohan Singh's cabinet.
10. Renowned personality V Kalyanam passed away recently, he was former personal secretary of _____ **Mahatma Gandhi.**
Note:
- Kalyanam was preserving letters written by Gandhiji, a cheque bearing his sign and other literature associated with him.
 - He was proficient in Bengali, Gujarati, Hindi, Tamil and English.
 - A staunch follower of Mahatma Gandhi, he was also associated with Rajaji in the 1960s.

Important Days

1. International Labour Day or International Workers' Day or May Day observed every year on which date _____ **1st May.**
Note:
- The day, dedicated to workers and labourers across the world.
 - Labour Day has its origins in the labour union movement in the United States in the 19th Century when they demanded 8 hours working in a day.
 - The first Labour Day in India was hosted by the Labour Kisan Party in Madras in 1923.
2. World Tuna Day is observed every year on which date _____ **2nd May.**
Note:
- Its aim was to spotlight the importance of conservation management and make sure that a system is required in place to prevent tuna stocks from crashing.
3. World Press Freedom Day is observed globally every year on which date _____ **3rd May.**
Note:
- The day also pays tribute to journalists who have lost their lives.
 - They risk their lives at times or may even have to face tough situations in order to bring the news from different corners of the world in front of the public.
 - This year's World Press Freedom Day theme "Information as a Public Good".
4. The International Firefighters' Day (IFFD) is observed every year on which date _____ **4th May.**
Note:
- The day is celebrated to recognise and honour the sacrifices that firefighters make to ensure that their communities and environment are as safe as possible.
 - The day was instituted, after the deaths of five firefighters in tragic circumstances in a bushfire in Australia on 2 December 1998.
5. The World Hand Hygiene Day is observed every year on which date _____ **5th May.**
Note:
- The day is organised by the World Health Organization (WHO) to raise awareness among people across the globe about the importance of hand hygiene in warding off many serious infections.
 - The theme for 2021 is "'Achieving hand hygiene at the point of care'.
6. International Day of the Midwife is observed globally every year on which date _____ **5th May.**
Note:
- This day is celebrated to recognise the work of midwives and raise awareness about the status of midwives for the essential care they provide to mothers and their newborns.
 - The theme for 2021 International Day of the Midwife is "Follow the Data: Invest in Midwives."

7. World Asthma Day is observed every year on which date _____ **5th May**.

Note:

- The day is celebrated to raise awareness about the chronic disease and how it can be controlled with proper treatment.
- This year's theme is 'Uncovering Asthma Misconceptions', which aims at clearing misconceptions related to the complications of asthma.

8. International No Diet Day is observed globally every year on which date _____ **6th May**.

Note:

- International No Diet Day is observed on May 6, and its symbol is a light blue ribbon. It is an annual celebration of body acceptance, including fat acceptance and body shape diversity.
- It means recognising that your body is beautiful exactly as it is and worry less about your weight, body shape and more about being healthy and active.

New Appointments

1. Who has been appointed as the Managing Director (MD) Kotak Mahindra Life Insurance Company Limited (KLI) for a period of 3 years starting from 1st May 2021 _____ **Mahesh Balasubramanian**.

Note:

- He has been appointed for a period of 3 years starting from 1st May 2021.
- He has been appointed following the retirement of G Murlidhar.
- KLI is in receipt of approval from the Insurance Regulatory Development Authority of India (IRDAI) for the appointment of Balasubramanian.

2. Vaishali S Hiwase held from which state who became the first woman officer to be appointed as officer commanding in the Border Roads Organisation (BRO) _____ **Maharashtra**.

Note:

- She will be responsible for providing connectivity through an Indo-China border road.
- She is from Maharashtra is M Tech and after successfully completing a demanding tenure in Kargil the Women Officer has taken over the command to undertake this challenge of cutting through the rocks.

3. Who has been appointed as the 4th Deputy Governor of the Reserve Bank of India _____ **T Rabi Sankar**.

Note:

- ACC has cleared his appointment for a period of 3 years or till his date of superannuation.
- He succeeds B P Kanungo, who retired on 2nd April 2021 after serving one year extension period.
- RBI cannot hold more than 4 deputy governors. The other 3 Deputy Governors of RBI are Mahesh Kumar Jain, Michael D Patra and Rajeshwar Rao.

4. Who has been appointed as Acting Chairperson of National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) with effect from April 25, 2021 _____ **Justice Prafulla Chandra Pant**.

Note:

- He Succeeds Justice H.L. Dattu, whose tenure ended on December 2, 2020.
- His appointment was authorized by President of India, Ram Nath Kovind.
- The term of office of the NHRC Chairperson and members of the NHRC is for five years or till the age of 70 years, whichever is earlier.

5. Who has been appointed as the chief minister of Tamil Nadu _____ **MK Stalin**.

Note:

- The 68-year-old is the son of the former five-term Tamil Nadu chief minister, the late M Karunanidhi.
- The DMK-led alliance won 159 seats, well ahead of the majority mark of 118 seats. The party alone won 133 seats in the election.

6. Who has been appointed as the Director of the Indian Institute of Rice Research (IIRR) _____ **Raman Meenakshi Sundaram**.

Note:

- Prior to this elevation, he was working as Principal Scientist (Biotechnology) at the institute crop Improvement Section.

- He is a scientist of global repute working in the area of rice biotechnology, molecular breeding, and genomics and has over 160 research papers in national and international journals of repute and has published several books, book chapters and popular articles.

Important News – India

1. Union Finance Minister, Nirmala Sitharaman virtually inaugurated India's first 3D printed house at which IIT ____ **IIT Madras.**

Note:

- The single-storey home has been built in just five days over an area of about 600 sq. ft using 'Concrete 3D Printing'
- TVASTA Manufacturing Solutions, a start-up founded by IIT-M alumni in association with Habitat for Humanity's Terwilliger Centre for Innovation in Shelter built the 3D Printed House.
- The 3D Printed House would help to meet the deadline of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of the 'housing for all' scheme by 2022.

2. Which foundation has partnered with the not-for-profit organisation, Sustainable Environment and Ecological Development Society (SEEDS) to launch a community COVID-19 vaccination drive and set up COVID care centres _____ **PepsiCo Foundation.**

Note:

- As part of the partnership, SEEDS will drive Covid-19 vaccinations for the community at large, set up Covid care centres equipped with beds and medical facilities, including oxygen cylinders.
- SEEDS is a not-for-profit organization.

3. With Which country India has adopted 'Roadmap 2030' which aims to elevate bilateral ties to 'Comprehensive Strategic Partnership' _____ **United Kingdom.**

Note:

- During the summit, the two leaders adopted 'Roadmap 2030' which aims to elevate bilateral ties to 'Comprehensive Strategic Partnership'.
- The UK finalised new deals/trade worth 1 Billion British Pound Sterling (GBP) to create 6,500 jobs in the UK.
- They also agreed/announced 9 Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs)/Declarations during the summit.

4. Recently, the first-ever electric tractor in India has been tested at the Central Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute which is located in _____ **Madhya Pradesh.**

Note:

- This new electric tractor will be more environmentally friendly than other types of tractors.
- The Central Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute at Budni is a premier institute under the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. It is located in the state of Madhya Pradesh.

5. On the sidelines of the G7 Foreign Ministers' Meeting, the first-ever India-France-Australia Trilateral Foreign Ministerial Dialogue was held in _____ **London.**

Note:

- The first-ever India-France-Australia Trilateral Foreign Ministerial Dialogue was held in London, UK, on the sidelines of the G7 Foreign Ministers' Meeting.
- The meeting was attended by External Affairs Minister, Dr S. Jaishankar from India, France's Minister for Europe and Foreign Affairs, Mr Jean-Yves Le Drian and Australia's Minister for Foreign Affairs, Senator Marise Payne.

6. The Nation's first 'Drive in Vaccination Center' was inaugurated by MP Rahul Shewale in _____ **Mumbai.**

Note:

- This center has been set up in the parking lot of Kohinoor Square Tower at Dadar.
- This first of its kind 'Drive-in Vaccination Center' facility has been made available to the citizens at a time when people with disabilities are facing difficulties in getting to the vaccination center.

7. With which entity the National Dairy Development Board signed an MoU to promote efficient renewable technologies in the dairy industry _____ **Energy Efficiency Services Ltd.**

Note:

- NDDDB and EESL will work to design and develop innovative energy-efficient business solutions (innovative business models) for dairy cooperative institutions.
- They collaborate with different agencies for adopting non-conventional energy-generating facilities for the disposal of crop residues/agricultural waste and bio waste in an environment-friendly manner.

8. 2021 G20 Tourism Ministers' Meeting was held in which country that was attended by the Union Minister of State for Tourism & Culture (I/c) Shri Prahlad Singh Patel virtually _____ **Italy**.

Note:

- Mr Massimo Garavaglia, Minister of Tourism, Government of Italy Chaired the meeting.
- India will support the Principles for the transition to a green travel and tourism economy submitted by United Nation World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) as a further contribution to the policy area "Green Transformation" to embrace sustainability in tourism.

9. The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting announced a year-long celebrations to Mark birth centenary of which filmmaker _____ **Satyajit Ray**.

Note:

- Satyajit Ray (May 2, 1921-April 23, 1992) was a renowned filmmaker, writer, illustrator, graphic designer and music composer.
- He started his career in advertising and found inspiration for his first film, Pather Panchali, while illustrating the children's version of the novel by Bibhutibhusan Bandopadhyay.

10. What amount has been released by the central govt for State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) to all the States for COVID-19 containment measures _____ **Rs 8,873 crore**.

Note:

- The States can use up to 50 percent of the released amount for COVID-19 containment measures.
- It includes meeting the cost of oxygen generation and storage plants in hospitals, ventilators, strengthening ambulance services, COVID-19 hospitals, thermal scanners, personal protective equipment, testing laboratories and testing kits.

11. What additional amount has been decided to provide to states as an interest free 50 year loan for spending on capital projects _____ **Rs 15,000 crores**.

Note:

- The Department of Expenditure has issued fresh guidelines in this regard on the Scheme of Financial Assistance to States for Capital Expenditure for the financial year 2021-22.
- This helped to sustain state level capital expenditure in the pandemic year. In view of the positive response to the scheme and considering the requests of the State Governments, the Government has decided to continue the scheme in the year 2021-22.

12. The Union Cabinet has approved the signing of an MoU on Migration and Mobility Partnership between India and which country _____ **UK**.

Note:

- The MoU will benefit Indian students, academics, and researchers, migrants for professional and economic reasons and those willing to contribute through various projects to the economic development of both countries.
- It can support the innovation ecosystem in both countries by facilitating free flow of talent.

Important News – State
