## Bracing for a threat: On dangers of emerging coronavirus variants

The article talks about an emerging form of delta variant that has become a global concern. India too has its five laboratories dedicated to the GISAID. The UK has revealed that out of 63 genomes in its repository, six are from India and they have delta variant mutation characteristics in them.

The delta variant is the most prevalent in India and is found in those who have no travel history and is associated with resistance to monoclonal antibody treatment.

The scientists claim that AY.1 is the evolution of the Delta variant and has increased the overall infectivity. Such mutations are beneficial for viruses in infecting humans rapidly. Till this battle against the virus is on, the mutation study is necessary to improve upon the vaccines and develop patches to limit the threats from the evolving variants.

India has restricted 10 labs to continue with genome sequencing research. Despite having the capability and expertise, the private labs have not been chosen for the mission. It is highly crucial now for the country to work on preparedness.
