- Tsang Yin-Hung from Hong Kong broke the record and became the fastest female climber to reach the peak of Mount Everest, she scaled the peak in 25 hours 50 minutes, (the shortest time taken by any woman).
- She beat the record set by Nepali woman Phunjo Jhangmu Lama in 2017, who climbed Everest in 39 hours and 6 minutes. In 2017, Tsang became the 1st Hong Kong woman to reach the peak.
- Arthur Muir, 75, became the oldest American to climb the Mount Everest at 8,848.86-metres (29,031 feet).
- Muir beat the record set by Bill Burke, who became the oldest American to climb the mountain at the age of 67 in 2009.
- Nepal has issued a record 408 Everest permits for the 2021 climbing season as 2020's season was cancelled due to COVID-19.

- The Belgrade Open part of the Association of Tennis Professionals (ATP) Tour 250 Tennis Tournament.
- 2021 Belgrade open is an outdoor clay courts tournament.
- Belgrade Open 2021 is the first edition of the event created due to the one-week delay of the 2021 French Open.
- Belgrade Open was established in 2021 and organised with a single year licence in 2021.

- Ms. Kochhar, who served in various senior positions during her three decades at the IMF, will retire on July 30, and will join as Director of Development Policy and Finance, at the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

Dr. Sodhi had completed his Post-Graduation in Rural Management from Institute of Rural Management Anand (IRMA) in its first batch and joined GCMMF (Amul) in the year 1982 and took over as Managing Director of GCMMF (Amul) in the year 2010.
- * He headed GCMMF's widely acclaimed marketing campaigns such as (1) Promoting milk as 'world's original energy drink' & (2) 'Eat Milk' campaign motivating Indian youth in include dairy products in every meal and (3) Amul Doodh Peeta Hai India.

- * Veteran politician Isaac Herzog has been elected Israel's 11th president in a secret ballot in the Knesset (parliament).
- * The 60-year-old former Labor leader will be the first Israeli President who is the son of a former president. His father Chaim Herzog served as Israel's Head of State between 1983 and 1993.
- * Herzog won the support of an overwhelming 87 lawmakers in the 120-member house defeating his rival Miriam Peretz with a comfortable margin.

- * Mr Amoth replaces Union Health Minister, Government of India, and Dr Harsh Vardhan, who completed his tenure as Chairman of WHO Executive Board on June 02, 2021.
- * Dr Vardhan will continue to be a member of the Executive Board of WHO till 2023. The chairman's post is held on a rotation basis for one year among regional groups.

- Microsoft has launched first ever "Asia Pacific Public Sector Cyber Security Executive Council".
- It was launched with the aim of building strong communications channel to address cyber threats and to share best practices among participating countries.
- Cybersecurity Council comprises of policy makers and influencers from countries like Indonesia, Korea, Brunei, Malaysia, Singapore, Philippines, and Thailand.
- It is supported by cybersecurity professionals. Council was set up with the aim of accelerating public-private partnerships in cybersecurity, and share threat intelligence.

- In 2020, the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) in its 50th meeting of the general body had approved the extension of the TET certificate validity from 7 years to a lifetime.
- The respective state governments/UTs will take necessary action to revalidate/issue fresh TET certificates to those candidates whose period of 7 years has already elapsed.
- The guidelines dated February 11, 2011, of the NCTE, laid down that TET would be conducted by the state governments and the validity of the TET certificate was 7 years from the date of passing TET.
