Important News: Places

Janta Rasaoi in Jaipur

Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot inaugurated Janta Rasaoi on 3 May. In this scheme food will be delivered on door to door basis to 500 people. Apart from this food for animals and birds will be provided also.

Super Napier Grass in Ajmer

Cow/sheep feed made with Super Napier Grass. Elephant Grass and Pearl Millet were crossed to create Super Napier, a Hybrid Napier Grass. The upgraded fodder grass Napier grass yields a lot of high-protein feed. The protein content of Super Napier grass ranges from 16 to 18 percent, with a high yield. A production center has been started in Ajmer.

Seed Bank in Bundnagar Panchayat

Mukhyamantri Chiranjivi Swasthya Bima Yojana

Chief Minister Chiranjeevi Yojana implemented from May 01, every family will get cashless health insurance up to Rs 5 lakh. The state government of Rajasthan has also extended the last date for registration for this scheme till 31 May



2021 and will be able to take advantage of it from 01 August 2021.

Oxygen Mitra

Prime Minister Narendra Modi praised Bikaner's innovative ideas to save oxygen, which is critical for treating severe Covid-19 cases, and to bring non-Covid healthcare to people's doorsteps through mobile OPDs (outpatient departments), as well as the efforts of 12 other district magistrates (DMs) from across the country.

.CONSENT TO OPERATE(CTO) Date shifted to 31st July

Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board has made clear the last date of comply to be 31st July. It is prior to commencement of operation of any industry, project or activity , the project proponent requires consent to



operate under the provisions of the Water(Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

Normally, the State Board will issue consent to operate for a period of 5, 10 and 15 years in case of red, orange and green category respectively.

“Ak Podha Suposhit Kanya ke Naam”
