Air Marshal Vivek Ram Chaudhari appointed Vice Chief of Air Staff

- Ace fighter pilot Air Marshal Vivek Ram Chaudhari has been appointed as the next Vice Chief of the Air Staff by Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC)
- He will succeed incumbent Air Marshal **HS Arora** who will superannuate on June 30, 2021.
- He presently commands Western Air Command, which is also known as the sword arm of the force, as it handles the sensitive borders with both Pakistan and China in sensitive areas.
- Air Chief Marshal: Rakesh Kumar Singh Bhadauria.

PM Modi launches E-100 Ethanol Dispensing Stations in Pune

- PM Narendra Modi has virtually launched **Pilot Project of E 100 ethanol dispensing stations** at three locations in Pune, for the production and distribution of ethanol.
- Govt has reset the target to achieve **20% ethanol blending in petrol by 2025**, which was earlier set by 2030.
- Govt has released **E-20 notification**, directing Oil Companies to sell ethanol blended petrol with ethanol up to 20% from April 1, 2023; and BIS Specifications for higher ethanol blends E12 & E15

India launches 'Mission Innovation 2.0' initiative

- India along with 23 nations have collectively launched **Mission Innovation 2.0**, alongside the Paris Agreement at the 2015 COP21 conference
- This new initiative was launched at **Innovating to Net Zero Summit**, hosted by Chile
- **Purpose:** To make clean energy affordable, attractive and accessible throughout this decade; To accelerate action towards the Paris Agreement, and Net zero pathways.
- It will be supported by new global Innovation Platform to strengthen confidence.



Govt approves release of PGI 2019-20 for States and UT

- Union Education Minister, Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' has approved release of Performance Grading Index (PGI) 2019-20 for States and Union Territories of India
- The Index has 70 parameters to catalyse transformational change to ensure that the school education system is robust at every level.
- Punjab, Chandigarh, Tamil Nadu, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Kerala occupy the highest grade (Grade A++) for 2019-20
- It was first published in **2019** with reference year 2017-18

Report on ethanol blending in India 2020 to 2025 released

- PM Modi has released 'Report of the Expert Committee on Road Map for ethanol blending in India 2020-2025' on World Environment Day event
- The theme of the report is 'promotion of biofuels for better environment'
- Report has been prepared by NITI Aayog in collaboration with Ministry of Petroleum and Natural
 Gas.
- Key recommendations have been made in this report to increase and augment the production capacity and utilization of ethanol blended petrol.

CBSE ties-up with Microsoft to introduce Coding as new subject

- Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has partnered with Microsoft to introduce Coding as a new subject for students of Class 6 to 8 and Data Science as new subject for Class 8 to 12 in the academic session 2021-2022.
- Both these new subjects are being launched in line with National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.
- **Coding and Data Science curriculum** will focus on building critical thinking, computational skills, problem-solving skills, creativity among students.

NCSM ties-up with London Science Museum for 'Hunt for the Vaccine'

- National Council of Science Museums (NCSM) has tied-up with Science Museum Group, London for an international travelling exhibition 'Hunt for the Vaccine'.
- This exhibition will depicts the story of the global effort to find new ways to develop vaccines and look at vaccinations more broadly with a historical and contemporary view.
- NCSM:
 - o It is an autonomous organization under the **Ministry of Culture**
 - o HQs: Kolkata.
 - o It was established in **1978.**

NTPC Ltd. joins UN's CEO Water Mandate for Water Conservation

- NTPC Ltd, under Ministry of Power has become a signatory to UN Global Compact's CEO Water Mandate, that focus on efficient water management.
- **CEO Water Mandate:** It is an initiative by UN Global Compact to assist companies in the development, implementation, and disclosure of comprehensive water strategies and policies, as part of long term Sustainable Development Goals.
- It also provides a platform for companies to partner.

DBT-NII receives trademark for India's First Indigenous Tumour Antigen

- National Institute of Immunology (NII), DBT has receives ASPAGNIITM Trademark for India's First Indigenous Tumour Antigen SPAG9, discovered by Anil Suri in 1998
- Anil Suri is heading Cancer Research Program at NII, DBT
- **ASPAGNITM** is being used in dendritic cell (DC) based immunotherapy in cervical, ovarian cancer and will also be used in breast cancer.
- **Immunotherapy** is a new approach that exploits the body's inner capability to put up a fight against cancer

Govt eases pension norms for families of deceased staff

- Govt has relaxed the norms for disbursing pension to families of deceased employees considering their urgent need of funds for their livelihood during COVID-19
- All the ministries have been told to disburse the provisional family pension immediately after receiving the claim with a death certificate under Rule 80-A of the Central Civil Service (Pension) Rules, 1972.
- This rule provided for payment of provisional family pension and also provisional death gratuity.

India and UK launch new workstream to promote industrial energy efficiency

- India and UK has launched new workstream to promote industrial energy efficiency under Clean Energy Ministerial's (CEM)-Industrial Deep Decarbonization Initiative (IDDI) at 12th Chief Energy Ministerial (CEM)
- 12th CEM will start from May 31 to 6 June 2021
- **CEM-IDDI** is a global coalition of public and private organisations for low carbon industrial materials
- It is coordinated by **UN Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO)**
- Additional members: **Germany and Canada.**

World Oceans Day: 8 June

- **World Oceans Day (WOD)** is observed every year on **8 June** to celebrate the role of the oceans in our everyday life and inspiring action to protect the ocean and marine resources
- Theme 2021: 'The Ocean: Life & Livelihoods'
- WOD was originally proposed in 1992 by International Centre for Ocean Development and Ocean Institute of Canada at Earth Summit, Brazil
- It was officially recognized by UN in 2008.
- UN Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development: 2021 to 2030

Abdulla Shahid elected as President of United Nation General Assembly

• Maldives Foreign Minister Abdullah Shahid has been elected as the President of 76th United Nation General Assembly (UNGA).



- He received **143 votes out of 191 ballots cast**, while his opponent Afghanistan's former Foreign minister **Zalmai Rassoul** got 48 votes.
- Maldives will occupy the office of UNGA's President for the first time.
- He will succeed **Volkan Bozkır.**
- UNGA is the main deliberative, policy-making, and representative organ of the UN.
- UN HQs: New York

UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration to be observed from 2021 to 2030

- United Nations Decade on Ecosystem Restoration has been officially launched to run from 2021 to 2030
- UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration will be co-led by UN Environment Programme (UNEP) and UN Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO)
- It was proclaimed by UN General Assembly in a 2019 resolution.
- Aim: Protection and revival of ecosystems all around the world
- **Multi-Partner Trust Fund** has also been launched and Germany is the first country to provide funding to this fund.

Sergio Perez wins 2021 Azerbaijan Grand Prix

- Red Bull's racer **Sergio Perez** (Mexico) has won **Formula 1 Azerbaijan Grand Prix 2021**, that was held on 6 June 2021 at the Baku City Circuit in Azerbaijan
- **Sebastian Vettel (Aston Martin Germany)** held the 2nd position, followed by **Pierre Gasly Scuderia** (AlphaTauri -France)
- It was the 6th round of 2021 Formula One World Championship.
- Lewis Hamilton made a severe error at the resultant restart and Max Verstappen retired due to a high-speed tyre blowout.

Interpol launches 'I-Familia' database to identify missing persons

- International Police Organisation (Interpol) has launched new global database named 'I-Familia'
- It will identify missing persons or unidentified human remains around the world through DNA of relatives
- It is an **international organization facilitating international police cooperation** against cross-border terrorism, trafficking, and other crime
- INTERPOL has 194-member countries
- It is not a unit or part of united nation system
- HQs: Lyon, France
- Interpol was founded in 1923.

Haryana Govt launches Pran Vayu Devta Pension Scheme

- Haryana Govt has launched unique and first of its kind initiative 'Pran Vayu Devta Pension Scheme' (PVDPS)
- PVDPS initiative will honour all those trees which are of the age of 75 years and above and have served humanity throughout their life by producing oxygen & shade, reducing pollution and so on.
- Oxy Van (Oxygen Forest): Oxy Van are identified pieces of land, on which as many as 3 crore trees would be planted on land ranging from 5 acres to 100 acres.



India slips two spots to rank 117 on 17 SDGs adopted as 2030 agenda

- India's rank has slipped by 2 places to 117 with SDG score of 61.9 out of 100 on the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) as per State of India's Environment Report 2021
- SDGs was adopted as a part of 2030 agenda by all United Nations member states in 2015
- The report also revealed that India's rank was 115 in 2020 and dropped by two places due to challenges like hunger, food security, gender equality, etc
- India ranks below Bhutan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh

World Bank approves \$ 500 million program to boost MSME sector in India

- Board of Executive Directors of World Bank has approved \$500 million program to support India
 in its nationwide initiative of revitalising the MSME sector, which has been heavily impacted by
 COVID-19 crisis
- The support has been extended by World Bank through its Raising and Accelerating Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) Performance (RAMP) Program.
- This is the second phase of support by World Bank to India in this sector through RAMP program.

Report on Bio-medical Waste released

- Centre for Science and Environment has released report that shows 2,03,000 kg of COVID-19 biomedical waste was produced daily in May 2021 and it was roughly 33% of India's non-COVID biomedical waste.
- As per Bio-medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, Bio-medical waste is required to be segregated in 4 colour coded waste categories, and the same is treated and disposed as per the methods prescribed under Schedule I of the Rules.

CRISIL projects India's GDP Growth for FY22 to 9.5%

- Domestic credit ratings agency **CRISIL** has revised **GDP growth estimate for India to 9.5% in FY22 (2021-22),** from the earlier estimate of 11%.
- As per CRISIL, economy had contracted by 7.3% in FY21.
- The downward revision is basically due to the hit to private consumption and investments following the second wave of COVID-19.
- CEO of CRISIL: **Ashu Suyash.**
- CRISIL's Headquarters: Mumbai.

Anup Chandra Pandey appointed as Election Commissioner

- Anup Chandra Pandey (retired IAS officer of 1984 batch, UP cadre) has been appointed as the Election Commissioner of India by the Union Government
- He has been appointed to fill the place left vacant by Sunil Arora
- Election Commission consists of Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) and 2 Election Commissioners
- Presently, Sushil Chandra is CEC and Rajiv Kumar is the other Election Commissioner
- They will now oversee the elections in UP, Punjab, Goa, Manipur and Uttarakhand



India elected to UN Economic and Social Council for 2022-24 term

- India has been elected as the member of **54-member United Nations Economic and Social**Council (ECOSOC) for 3-year terms from **2022 to 2024**
- It has been selected by UN General Assembly in Asia-Pacific States category, along with Afghanistan, Kazakhstan and Oman
- ECOSOC
 - o It is one of the six main organs of UN
 - o It serves as the central platform for discussing international economic, social and environmental issues and formulating policy recommendations
 - o HQs: New York, Geneva

Sanjeev Sahai selected as new Chairman of PNGRB

- Former power secretary Sanjeev Nandan Sahai (1986 batch IAS officer) has been named as the new Chairman of oil regulator Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB).
- He retired as **Secretary in Ministry of Power** on January 31, 2021.
- His appointment is subject to approval by Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC).
- He succeeded **Dinesh K Sarraf**, who completed his three-year term in December 4, 2020.
- PNGRB is a **statutory body in India** under **PNGRB Act, 2006.**

Raimona Reserve Forest declared as Sixth National Park of Assam

- Assam CM Himanta Biswa Sarma has declared Raimona Reserve Forest in Assam as the National Park
- It will now be the 6th National Park in Assam
- Raimona National Park:
 - o It is in **Kokrajhar district under Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR)**, spread over 422 sgkm.
 - o It also shares its boundary with Phipsoo Wildlife Sanctuary and Jigme Singye Wangchuk National Park in Bhutan
- Other five national parks of Assam: Kaziranga, Manas, Nameri, Dibru-Saikhowa and Orang National Park.

Indian Navy to receive MH-60 'Romeo' Multi-role Helicopters from US

- Indian Navy is set to receive three MH-60 Romeo helicopters from USA in July 2022
- India and US had signed **Rs 15,157 crore (\$2.13 billion)** deal to buy 24 **MH-60 Romeo helicopters** from Lockheed Martin in Feb 2020
- Currently, the first batch of Indian pilots are in US for training on these helicopters.
- **MH-60 Romeos** are equipped with multi-mode radars and night-vision devices, Hellfire missiles, torpedoes and precision-guided weaponry.

Govt issues guidelines for e-Content development for disabled Children



- Union Govt has issued guidelines for the development of e-Content for Children with disabilities based on four principles of robust, perceivable, operable, and understandable.
- These guidelines will initiate creation of high-quality content for digital education to children with special needs.
- **Dept of School Education and Literacy** under **Ministry of Education** had constituted experts committee for recommending guidelines for developing e-content for disabled children.

World Accreditation Day: 9th June

- **World Accreditation Day (WAD)** is observed every year on **9 June** to promote the role of accreditation in trade & economy.
- Theme for WAD 2021: Accreditation: Supporting the Implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- WAD is a global initiative, jointly established by the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and the International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation (ILAC), to raise awareness of the importance of accreditation.

NITI Aayog recommends privatisation of Central Bank & Indian Overseas Bank

- NITI Aayog has recommended privatization of Central Bank of India and Indian Overseas Bank in the current fiscal (2021-22), as part of the disinvestment process announced in Union Budget 2021-22.
- Under the privatisation initiative, NITI Aayog was entrusted to suggest names of PSUs in strategic sectors to be merged, privatised, or made subsidiaries of other PSUs
- Dept of Investment and Public Asset Management and Dept of Financial Services will now examine this proposal

Oman preferred over India to host inaugural FIH Hockey World Cup

- Executive Board of FIH has decided that Oman will be hosting the Inaugural FIH Hockey World Cup in January 2024
- Capital city of Oman, **Muscat** has been picked as the host city for the inaugural Hockey5s World Cups (Men and Women) by International Hockey Federation (FIH).
- FIH Hockey World Cup will take place in January 2024.
- 16 teams per gender (3 per continent + Oman as hosts) will take part in the first edition of Hockey World Cup.

IISc, Bengaluru ranked Best Indian University in Times University Rankings

- Three Indian Universities have made it to the top 100 list of Times Higher Education (THE) Asia University Rankings 2021.
- Apart from it, 63 Indian universities found place in 2021 list, however, none of them could make to top 10.
- IISc, Bengaluru has been ranked 37th for the seventh year in a row.
- The other two universities in top 100: IIT, Ropar (55) and IIT, Indore (78)
- India is ranked 3rd in representation of universities
- Japan was ranked first, followed by China



RBI imposes penalty on Bank of India & PNB for Violation of Norms

- RBI has imposed monetary penalty on Bank of India and Punjab National Bank (PNB) for contravention of norms related to Frauds Classification and Reporting
- Penalty imposed on Bank of India is of Rs 4 crore and Rs 2 crore on Punjab National Bank.
- They has been fined for non-compliance with RBI directions, breach of stipulated transaction limits; delay in transfer of unclaimed balances to DEA Fund; delay in reporting a fraud to RBI, sale of a fraudulent asset.

CESL signs MoU with Ladakh to make Ladakh carbon neutral

- Convergence Energy Services Limited (CESL) has signed MoU with Ladakh to make it a clean and green UT.
- Under the MoU, various clean energy and energy efficiency programmes will be implemented like solar mini and micro grid solutions, energy efficient lighting, energy storage-based solutions, efficient cooking stoves and electric mobility solutions in the UT.
- CESL will build the EV ecosystem for the UT.
- Ladakh's Lieutenant Governor: R K Mathur.

Chandra Shekhar Ghosh re-appointed as MD & CEO of Bandhan Bank

- RBI has granted approval for the re-appointment of Chandra Shekhar Ghosh as the Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of Bandhan Bank
- His term will be of **3 years**, with effect from 10 July 2021.
- His re-appointment is subject to the approval of shareholders at the ensuing annual general meeting of the bank.
- Bandhan Bank operates as a commercial bank since 2001
- Headquarters: Kolkata

LIC Chairman's tenure extended to March 2022

- The **Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC)** has extended the term of **Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) Chairman MR Kumar** till March 13, 2022.
- His currently notified term was to end on June 30 this year.
- Kumar was appointed as **LIC Chairman** on March 13, 2019.
- Kumar had joined LIC in 1983 as a direct recruit officer.
- Recently, in the disinvestment plan the Centre which owns 100% of LIC, is looking for dismantle for up to 10% stake via IPO.
- LIC Headquarter: Mumabi

M K Jain re-appointed as RBI Deputy Governor for a period of two years

- The government has extended the tenure of deputy governor **Mahesh Kumar Jain** for two years.
- Jain was appointed as deputy governor for three years in June 2018.
- Before joining the Reserve Bank of India, he was managing director of IDBI Bank.



 The other three serving deputy governors are Michael Patra, M Rajeshwar Rao, and T Rabi Sankar.

El Salvador declares bitcoin as legal tender

- **El Salvador** has become the world's first country to grant legal tender status to **bitcoin**.
- Bitcoin use as legal tender will become law in **90 days.**
- Its economy heavily relies on remittances and so those who are working abroad can send money back home in bitcoins too
- It will bring financial inclusion, investment, tourism, innovation, and economic development to the country.
- El Salvador Capital: San Salvador
- Currency: United States Dollar

Indo-Thai CORPAT exercise begins in Andaman Sea

- The **31st edition** of **3day India-Thailand Coordinated Patrol (CORPAT)** started in the Andaman Sea.
- It is being conducted from 9 to 11 June 2021.
- Naval Offshore Patrol Vessel, Indian Naval Ship (INS) Saryu, is participating in India and HTMS Krabi, is participating from Thailand Navy in CORPAT.
- The CORPAT exercise is being conducted between the two navies bi-annually since 2005, along their **International Maritime Boundary Line (IMBL).**

IISc Bangalore is the top Research University in QS World Ranking 2021

- Global higher ed analysts Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) released the 18th QS World University Rankings 2022.
- IISc, Bengaluru (186th), IIT Bombay (177th), and IIT Delhi (185th) are among the top-200 universities.
- IISc is the world's top research university as per the citations per faculty indicator.
- IISc has got a perfect score of 100 out of 100 for the citations per faculty (CPF) metric.
- The IIT, the Bombay, is India's top-ranked institution for the 4th consecutive year.

AP Launches Jagananna Thodu Scheme to help vendors, small traders

- AP launched interest-free loans under the Jagananna Thodu scheme to help small & petty vendors and artisans
- Under the scheme, the state govt credited Rs 370 crore to 3.7 lakh small traders as an interest-
- Although 9.05 lakh beneficiaries were identified from the scheme, in phase-1, only Rs 535 crore was disbursed by the banks to 5.35 lakh beneficiaries.
- Governor: Biswabhusan Harichandan
- Capital: Visakhapatnam, Amaravati, Kurnool

All jobs in Ladakh reserved for Residents

• All jobs in the UT of **Ladakh** have been reserved for the residents of the region.



- The new recruitment rules are mentioned in Clause 11 of the Union Territory of Ladakh Employment (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021.
- The move has met a long-pending demand of the people of Ladakh, after it was carved out as a UT on Aug 5, 2019.
- The order by the L-G was issued by exercising the powers conferred by S.O 282 (E) dated 21.01.2020.

Govt hikes kharif MSP of kharif crops by an average 3.7 per cent

- The govt increased the MSP of Kharif crops for the 2021-21 crop season by an average of 3.7%
- The max hike reserved for pulses and oilseeds to encourage farmers to shift from paddy.
- The MSP of tur and urad has been increased by Rs 300 per quintal in absolute terms to Rs 6300.
- While the MSP of groundnut seed has been increased by Rs 275 per quintal to Rs 5550.
- MSP of paddy has been raised by Rs 72 per quintal to Rs 1940.
- MSP Recommended by: CACP
- Announced by: CCEA

Auckland has become the world's most liveable city

- Auckland placed at the top in The Economist Intelligence Unit's Global Liveability Index of 140 cities around the world.
- **Austria's Vienna,** number one in both **2018 and 2019**, dropped out of the top 10 after being heavily affected by Covid (now in 12th)
- New Zealand's capital **Wellington** was 4th on this year's list, tying with **Tokyo**.
- Adelaide, Perth, and Brisbane came in 3d, 6th, and 10th place respectively, while Melbourne tied with Switzerland's Geneva at number eight. IAMAI appoints AK Sikri as

Chairman of OTT grievance redressal board

- Former Judge of SC **Arjan Kumar Sikri** appointed as chairman of the **Grievance Redressal Board** (RRB) of the recently formed **Digital Publisher Content Grievances Council (DPCGC)**.

- It will act as the **2nd-tier** within the 3-tier grievance redressal mechanism.

All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) 2019-20 released

- Union Education Minister Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' released the report of All India Survey on Higher Education 2019-20.
- 1. There has been a growth of **11.4%** in student enrolment in five years.
- 2. The rise in female enrolment in higher education during the period is 18.2%.
- 3. The number of institutions of national importance has increased to 135 in 2020 from 75 in 2015.
- 4. **AISHE report** is published by the **Ministry of Education** since **2010-11**.

Asian Games Gold Medallist Boxer, Dingko Singh passes away



- Asian Games gold medal-winning former boxer Dingko Singh (42) passed away.
- The **Manipur-based** former boxer endured a long battle with cancer and even fought **COVID-19** last year.
- Dingko won the **Asian Games gold in 1998** and was bestowed the **Arjuna award** the same year.
- In 2013, he was honoured with the **Padma Shri** for his contribution to the sport.
- Dingko, who was employed with Navy, had taken to coaching after hanging up his gloves.

India's agriculture exports increase 17.34% in 2020-21

- India's export of Agri and allied products in 2020-21 grew by 17.34% to & 41.25 bn.
- The largest markets for India's Agri prod are the US, China, Bangladesh, UAE, Vietnam, Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, Nepal, Iran & Malaysia.
- Maharashtra, Kerala, Nagaland, TN, Assam, Punjab, and Karnataka -- have finalized their specific action plan to implement the Agri export policy.
- As part of it, **46 unique** product-district clusters have been identified for export promotion.

RBI Increases ATM Interchange Fee From Rs 15 To Rs 17

- The **Reserve Bank of India** raised the interchange fee on each financial transaction at **ATM from Rs 15 to Rs 17** for financial transactions and from **Rs 5 to Rs 6** for non-financial transactions.
- Banks will be able to raise ATM transaction charges from August 1, 2021.
- Customers are still eligible for **five free transactions** inclusive of financial and non-financial transactions every month from their own bank ATMs and **three** transactions from other bank ATMs.

UNGA president-elect Abdulla Shahid appoints K. Nagaraj as Chef de Cabinet
