3. IIT Ropar develops power free CPAP device "Jivan Vayu"



- **IIT Ropar** has developed a device "**Jivan Vayu**" which can be used as a substitute for a **CPAP machine**.
- This device can function even without electricity
- It is adapted to both kinds of **oxygen generation** units like **CO2 cylinders** and **oxygen pipelines**.
- The device is designed to maintain a **FiO2** (the concentration of oxygen in the gas mixture) of above 40% with a PEEP of 5-20 cm H2O.
- The device houses a viral filter at the air entrainment end with a viral efficacy of **99.99%**

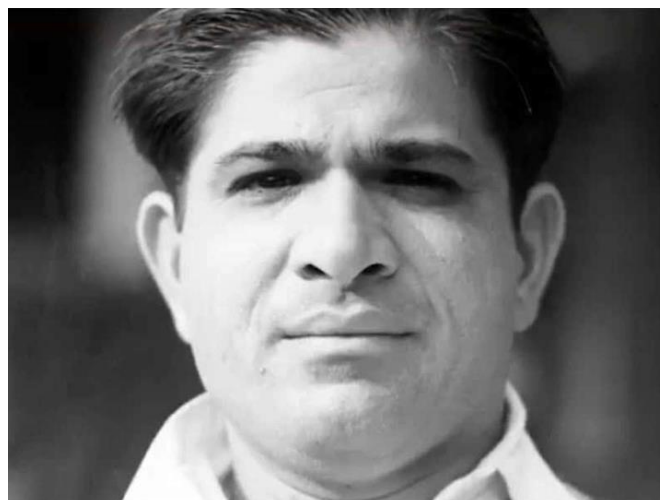

5. Financial wealth in India jumps 11% in 2020 to \$3.4 trillion: BCG Report

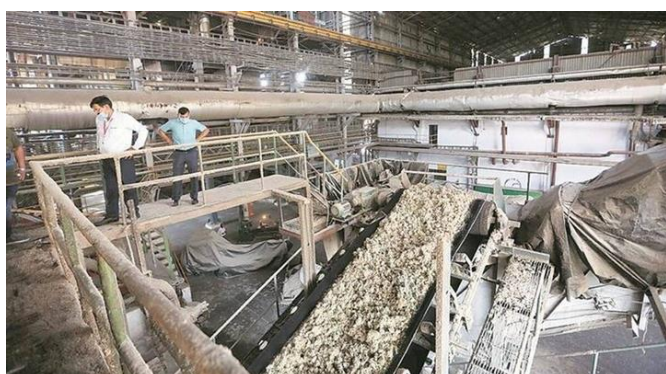


- As per the **BCG report**, financial wealth in India grew **11%** to \$ 3.4 tr. in **2020**.
