### 5. RBI expands BBPS scope by August 31, 2021




- The RBI has expanded the scope of the Bharat Bill Payment System (BBPS) by 31st August 2021.




- India exported Geographical Indications (GI) certified Jardalu mangoes from Bhagalpur to London.

## 7. ADB, India sign \$ 484 mn loan to upgrade road network in TN industrial corr




### 9. World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought 2021: 17th June




