1. Lewis Hamilton wins British Grand Prix 2021



- Mercedes's Lewis Hamilton (UK) won the British Grand Prix 2021 (record 8th time).
- The win was the 99th of seven-times world champion Hamilton's Formula One career, fourth of the current campaign.
- The event was held at the Silverstone Circuit in the United Kingdom.
- Monaco-based Ferrari driver Charles
 Leclerc finished at second.
- Hamilton's teammate Valtteri Bottas
 (Finland) finished third after being told to let
 Hamilton through to chase Leclerc.

1. Kambhampati Hari Babu sworn in as new Governor of Mizoram




- Kambhampati Hari Babu has been sworn in as the 22nd Governor of Mizoram at Raj Bhayan in Aizawl

12. Bad Bank launched for stressed assets as a measure to clean up bank books




- Govt has launched Bad Bank with all the regulatory approvals in place for stressed assets as a measure to clean up bank books

13. IIT Madras develops AI-based algorithm to help identify cancer cell




- IIT Madras has developed an Artificial Intelligence-based mathematical model to identify cancer-causing alterations in cells


 Pedro Castillo (51 years) has been declared as the President-elect of Peru, after winning 2021 Presidential election of the country





