22 August

- Ismail Sabri Yaakob (61 years) has been appointed as the new Prime Minister of Malaysia by Malaysia's King Sultan Abdullah Sultan Ahmad Shah. Capital of Malaysia: Kuala Lumpur.
- **Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd (BPCL)** has launched an AI-enabled chatbot, named as **'URJA'** to provide a platform for seamless self-service experience and faster resolution of queries/issues to its customers
- National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) Ltd has commissioned largest floating solar PV project of 25MW on the reservoir of its Simhadri thermal station in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh
- Tokyo Paralympics is scheduled to be held from 24 August to 5 September 2021. India will be represented by 54 athletes and compete in 9 sports disciplines including Archery, Athletics Track and Field, Badminton, Swimming, Weightlifting at Tokyo Paralympics.
- Govt of India has identified two Autonomous Institutes of Dept of Biotechnology (DBT), named as National Institute of Animal Biotechnology (NIAB), Hyderabad and National Centre for Cell Science (NCCS), Pune, for upgradation as Central Drug Laboratories (CDLs).

- Muhyiddin Yassin has stepped down as Prime Minister of Malaysia after months of political turmoil culminated in the loss of his majority.

- World Sanskrit Day (Sanskrit Diwas) is observed every year on Shraavanapoornima, that is the Poornima day of the Shraavana month in the Hindu calendar, which is also marked as Raksha Bandhan. This year, it is being observed on August 22, 2021.
- International Day Commemorating the Victims of Acts of Violence Based on Religion or Belief is observed every year on August 22.
- World Senior Citizen Day is observed every year on August 21 globally to raise awareness about issues affecting older people, such as deterioration with age and the abuse of the elderly and support, honour and show appreciation to seniors and to recognize their achievements.







- International Day of Remembrance and Tribute to the Victims of Terrorism is observed every year August 21 to pay tribute to the individuals across the globe who have been attacked, injured, traumatized or lost their lives because of terrorist attacks.
- World Mosquito Day is observed every year on 20 August to raise awareness about the causes of malaria and how it can be prevented. Theme 2021: Reaching the zero-malaria target
- Akshay Urja Diwas (Renewable Energy Day) is observed every year on 20 August to raise awareness about the developments and adoption of renewable energy in India.
- World Humanitarian Day (WHD) is observed on 19 August every year to pay tribute to humanitarian personnel and those workers who lost or risked their lives while doing humanitarian service. Theme for 2021 WHD: #TheHumanRace: a global challenge for climate action in solidarity with people who need it the most.
- World Photography Day is observed on 19 August every year to promote photography as a hobby and also inspire photographers around the globe to share a single photo with the rest of the world.
