

Madhya Pradesh self-reliant in production of medical oxygen

- The government of Madhya Pradesh has issued efforts to make Madhya Pradesh self-sufficient in the production of medical oxygen.
- Presentation has been given by the Group of Ministers on the facts related to self-sufficiency in medical oxygen production on July 2, 2021, Under which arrangements are being made for oxygen manufacturing units and storage tanks in Madhya Pradesh.
- for storage of oxygen tanks will be constructed at Govindpura in Bhopal, Polo Ground in Indore and Sidhgaon in Sagar.
- The Madhya Pradesh government will be provided training for the operation and maintenance of oxygen plants.

Madhya Pradesh is the first state in giving identity cards to the differently abled

- The Government of India is being constructed National Institute of Mental Health and Research at Sehore and Sports Complex for Divyangjan in Gwalior.
- Identity cards have been provided to about 6 lakh Divyangjan in the state. Madhya Pradesh ranks first in providing identity cards to Divyangjan.
- Identity cards the Government of India have been issued 5 lakh 97 thousand 170 to Divyangjan.

Organizing "Better Rebuilding Than Co-Operation" Program On International Co-operative Day

On Cooperative Day, 3 July 2021, a program 'Better Reconstruction through Cooperatives' was organized.

Chief Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan inaugurated 55 godowns approved by Marketing Cooperative Federation and Housing Cooperative Federation and digitized the foundation stone of 114 godowns.

Other facts

- The first cooperative bank in Madhya Pradesh was established in 1904 in Sehora, Jabalpur.
- Primary Co-operative Societies are very helpful for farmers for fertilizers and seeds, NABARD provides financial assistance for agricultural development and assistance.

Various cooperative brands and their identities

- Sanchi brand of Madhya Pradesh which comes under Amul Institute, has its own special identity.

- There are many possibilities in the forest produce of the state including Neemuch's garlic, Burhanpur's banana, Amarkantak's Gul Bakawali, Dindori's Kodo-Kutki with Malwa Fresh brand for oranges.
- At present, the online registration of cooperatives has started within 45 days.

"Balsakha Yojana" at the national level for wildlife conservation

- 'Balsakha Abhinav Yojana' is being implemented in different states of India including Madhya Pradesh with the aim of creating awareness among the wild lovers and common citizens about tiger and wildlife conservation.
- This competition of Balsakha was organized in Ujjain, Damoh, Bikaner and Ajmer city of Rajasthan, in which the participants were rewarded.
- This competition of Balsakha will be organized in Rewa, Shahdol, Satna, Chhindwara, Indore, Ratlam, Bhopal city and also in states like Bihar, Tripura, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh etc.

Statue of Oneness will be 108 feet high

- The statue of Acharya Shankar (Statue of Vanvais) is being constructed in Omkareshwar.
- The height of the Statue of Oneness will be 108 feet, which will be installed on a 27 feet high lotus built on a 54 feet high platform.
- A two thousand capacity Amphi Theater will be constructed, in which the show based on the life and thoughts of Acharya Shankar will be conducted in Hindi and English medium through laser light and sound show.
- This construction work has been scheduled to be completed by March 2023.

Other facts

- Acharya Shankar is considered to be the founder of monism, also known as Adi Shankaracharya.
- The statue of Acharya Shankar construction metal was collected by each house .
- This statue will be made of Ashtadhatu, which will be 108 feet.
- Omkareshwar Prakalpa will be developed on both sides of river Narmada, in which statue and museum of Shankaracharya on one side and Gurukulam and International Adiva Vedanta Sansthan on the other side will be constructed.

Operation of pilot scheme of fortified rice distribution



- To overcome anemia and micronutrient deficiency. Under the Targeted Public Distribution System of the Government of India, a pilot scheme for distribution of fortified rice is being operated in Singrauli district.
- Under this, efforts will be made to diagnose serious health problems like anemia and malnutrition by fortifying rice with iron, folic acid and vitamin B-12.
- This scheme will be operational till 2022-23. The rice given to the beneficiaries under this scheme will be distributed by mixing fortified kernels.

Other facts –

- This scheme was started in 2019, aim of branches
- scheme to remove the problem of malnutrition.
- This scheme was first started in these five states of Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Tamil Nadu and Chhattisgarh.

Shri Mangu Chhagan Bhai Patel newly appointed Governor of Madhya Pradesh

- Mr. Mangubhai Patel has been appointed as the new Governor of Madhya Pradesh; Mr. Patel has replaced former Governor Anandiben Patel.
- Mangubhai Patel is the 19th Governor of Madhya Pradesh.
- Shri Patel, who has been a five-time MLA from Navsari assembly constituency of Gujarat, has also been the speaker of Gujarat assembly.
- He has been the Minister of Forest and Environment cabinet.
- He worked for a long time for the upliftment of the tribal society.

- This will benefit government institutions and MoU institutions. This will benefit government institutions and MoU institutions.5
- Through these agreements, lectures, seminars, workshops, panel discussions, webinars and training programs will be organized in relation to public policy, governance and administration in collaboration with institutions.
- There will also be benefit of each other's expertise in teaching, research and other areas.

In the Prime Minister's Matru Vandana Yojana, MP tops the whole country

- Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana is a scheme run by the Government of India to provide financial assistance to women engaged in labor during pregnancy and to provide cash to pregnant women to compensate for the loss of wages.
- Madhya Pradesh becomes the first state in the country consecutive for the third time in the successful implementation of the scheme.
- Under this scheme, five thousand rupees are given on the birth of the first child.
- In this scheme, Himachal Pradesh stood second and Andhra Pradesh stood third.

Other Facts –

- This scheme was started on 1st January 2017, which is applicable in every district of the country.
- The scheme aims to improve the health of pregnant women and lactating women. This scheme is trying to bring down the maternal mortality rate.
- Financial assistance is provided to the beneficiary of this scheme (Rs 5 thousand), which is given in the form of three installments.
- First installment of one thousand rupees is given on registration of pregnancy at Anganwadi center.
- The second installment of two thousand rupees is provided after conducting at least one antenatal check-up and completion of 6 months of pregnancy.
- The third installment of two thousand rupees is given on the registration of the birth of the child and the completion of the first cycle of vaccination of the child.

Ujjain a city of industry and science

- Ujjain will be developed in the field of industry and science. Ujjain is a city related to religion, science, archaeology, scholars.
- In the program organized at Kalidas Academy Ujjain, the auditorium of the newly built observatory located in Dongla was dedicated.

- In the field of astronomy, the observatory established in Dongla will guide the country and the public will also get its benefit.
- The establishment of these industries is being started in Ujjain district.

Construction of Observatory Greenwich at Dongla, Ujjain

- The Dongla Observatory at Ujjain is going to become the Greenwich of the future.
- Time also will be calculated from Dongla of Ujjain.
- All the resources related to the observatory have been made available at Dongla. A state-of-the-art auditorium has been built.
- This observatory will become the focal point of Physics and Mathematics. Ujjain will be developed as Science City.
- The constellations will be calculated through 3D in Dongla Observatory.

Madhya Pradesh will get the cheapest solar power

- The New and Renewable Energy Department started with a base tariff of Rs 2.73 per unit for two units of Agar's 550 MW Solar Power Plant.
- This will be the cheapest solar power for Madhya Pradesh state.
- The Rewa Solar Project, one of the world's largest solar projects, received the minimum solar tariff of Rs 2.97.
- Two units of 550 MW will be set up in Agar on one thousand hectares of land at a cost of about Rs 1950 crore from the private sector.
- The target of power generation under this project has been set in March 2023.

An ambitious scheme to reach water to the Jan- Jal Jeevan Mission

- Under the Jal Jeevan Mission, one crore 23 lakh rural families of the state are to be supplied water from taps. Of these.
- Ensuring the source of water before laying the pipeline under the mission and providing water from tap to every house is included in this scheme.
- Rs.500 from normal families and Rs.100 for BPL for tap connection. The amount is to be taken from the family. At the same time, the monthly fee for water supply has been fixed at Rs 60 per month.

Other facts-

- Jal Jeevan Mission is an ambitious scheme to reach water to the people.
- This scheme started at 15 August 2019 , to implement this scheme water facility in the village for all.

Madhya Pradesh is the first in the country to develop water storage capacity of reservoirs

- There will be a tender to remove the silt from the reservoir, Madhya Pradesh will be the first state in the country to do so, in the first phase, silt will be removed from four reservoirs.
- With this, 5 lakh hectare irrigation potential will be developed and this also will increase the productivity of the land.
- The life span of dams will increase. Sand can be utilised. Local people will get employment.

Planning to set up textile project in Burhanpur

- In the context of Burhanpur Textile Project, talks were held between Chief Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan and representatives of the Burhanpur based textile manufacturing company M/s Burhanpur Textile Private Limited Company.
- The investment proposal for setting up a textile project in Burhanpur Madhya Pradesh with an investment of about Rs 300 crore was submitted to Chief Minister Shri Chouhan.
- M/s Burhanpur Textile Limited, located in Burhanpur, Madhya Pradesh was established in the year 1956. The company has nine units working in Burhanpur.
- Madhya Pradesh is included in the leading states of the country in 'Ease of Doing Business'.
