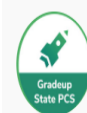


One-Liners (9 August 2021)

- **International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples (World Tribal Day)** is observed every year on **9 August** to protect the rights of the world's indigenous population and recognize the achievements.
