- The Forum Business Program includes a number of business interactions with leading partner countries in the Asia-Pacific region and with ASEAN.

### **Singapore-India Maritime Bilateral Exercise (SIMBEX) 2021**

- The 28th edition of the Singapore-India Maritime Bilateral Exercise (SIMBEX) was held from 02 to 04 September 2021.
- Due to the ongoing epidemic-related difficulties, this year's Symbex was planned without any physical interaction in the form of a 'sea only' exercise organized by the Republic of Singapore Navy (RSN) on the south coast of the South China Sea.

#### **Key points**

The Indian Navy was represented by guided missile destroyer INS Ranvijay with a helicopter from the ship, an ASW Corvette INS Kiltan and a guided missile Corvette INS Kora and a P8I long range maritime patrol aircraft.

#### **About Singapore-India Maritime Bilateral Exercise (SIMBEX):**

- Simbex is an annual bilateral naval exercise organized by the Indian Navy and the Republic of Singapore Navy (RSN).
- This exercise has been held annually since 1994.
- The two navies are represented in each other's marine information fusion centers and have recently signed an agreement on mutual submarine rescue support and coordination.

### **Tokyo Paralympics 2020: India ranks 24th with a record 19 medals**

- India completed its campaign at the Tokyo Paralympics 2020 with 19 medals, including five gold, eight silver and six bronze.
- This is the best number of medals for India in the Paralympic Games.
- Out of 162 nations, India is ranked 24th in the overall medal tally.

#### **Indian flag carriers:**

- Javelin thrower Chand was the flag bearer at the opening ceremony of the Tokyo Paralympics.
- At the closing ceremony, shooter Avni Lekhra was the flag bearer of India.

#### **India in Paralympics 2020:**

- India sent the largest contingent of 54 para-athletes to the Tokyo Paralympics to participate in as many as 9 sports events.
- Earlier, India had won a total of 12 Paralympic medals till Rio in 2016 after first appearing in the Paralympics in 1968.

- Paralympic 2020 Indian theme song "Kar De Kamal Tu". The composer and singer of the song is Sanjeev Singh, a Divyang cricketer from Lucknow.

- The award is named after Ramon Magsaysay, the third president of the Republic of the Philippines after World War II.
