- The developer will hand over the ownership of the project to the government of Nepal after 20 years of commercial operation.

- This compares with the 4% decline recorded during the 2009 global economic crisis.
- According to the latest UNWTO World Tourism Barometer, the collapse in international travel represents an estimated loss of USD 1.3 trillion in export revenues more than 11 times the loss recorded during the 2009 global economic crisis.
- The crisis has put between 100 and 120 million direct tourism jobs at risk, many of them in small and medium-sized enterprises.

- Shahtoot dam will provide clean drinking water to two million citizens of Kabul and will also be used for irrigation.
