- Russia professional Tennis player **Daniil Medvedev (25 years)** has won **2021 US Open men's singles Tennis Title,** after beating **Novak Djokovic (Serbia)** by 6-4, 6-4, 6-4.
- Justice M. Venugopal has been appointed as the new Acting Chairperson of National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT) with effect from September 11, 2021.
- Agrarian festival of Western Odisha, named as **Nuakhai Juhar** has been celebrated with religious fervour and tradition .
- Veteran Rajya Sabha MP and former Union minister Oscar Fernandes (80 years) passed away due to age related ailments at Yenepoya hospital in Mangalore.
- Haryana has been ranked as the first state of India in installation of off-grid solar pumps under **Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha Evam Utthan Mahaabhiyaan (PMKUSUM),** as per Ministry of New and Renewable Energy data
- Chhattisgarh Chief Minister **Bhupesh Baghel** has announced to launch 'Millet Mission' to provide proper price rate to farmers for minor cereal crops
- Hyderabad-based Space technology startup, **Skyroot Aerospace** has become the first private company to formally enter into an agreement with **ISRO** to get access of their facilities and expertise for the development and testing of subsystems and systems of space launch vehicles.
