- Indian military contingent comprising of an all arms combined force of 200 personnel is participating in Exercise titled as 'Peaceful Mission 2021'.
- President of India, Ram Nath Kovind has conferred National Florence Nightingale Awards 2020 at a virtual ceremony to 51 health care workers and nurses for their selfless dedication and compassion, especially during COVID-19.
- South Korea has successfully tested indigenously developed submarine-launched ballistic missile (SLBM).
- Tata Steel has commissioned India's first carbon capture plant that extracts CO2 directly from the blast furnace gas, at its Jamshedpur Centre.
