- As per the latest Global Trade Outlook issued by the UK's Department of International Trade, India will become the world's 3rd largest importer by 2050
- Well-known theoretical physicist and cosmologist Professor Thanu Padmanabhan passed away.
- As a part of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav", Department of Justice and NALSA launched the "Ek Pahal" drive across the country.
- Japanese Sports equipment company Asics has announced Indian squash player Joshna Chinappa as its new brand athlete.
- Next annual meeting of the World Economic Forum (WEF) will be held in Davos,
   Switzerland in January 2022.
- The **Sikkim** has declared '**Copper Mahseer**' locally named '**Katley**' (*Neolissochilus hexagonolepis*) as the **State fish**
- Rajnath Singh launched a book titled 'Shining Sikh Youth of India'.
- In **Russia**, **United Russia party** of incumbent President **Vladimir Putin** has retained a majority in parliament.

- India has been ranked at 46th place in Global Innovation Index (GII) 2021, that captures the innovation ecosystem performance of 132 economies and tracks the most recent global innovation trends
- The 73rd Primetime Emmy Awards ceremony was held in Los Angeles to honor best U.S. prime time TV program, as chosen by Academy of Television Arts & Sciences.
- R Raja Rithvik (17 years) from Warangal has become India's 70th and newest chess Grandmaster (GM).
- **International Week of the Deaf (IWD)** is observed every year in the full week ending on the last Sunday of September.
- Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) in partnership with Cordelia Cruises has launched India's first indigenous cruise liner.
- SpaceX launched world's first all-civilian crew into Earth orbit under the mission named as Inspiration-4 by SpaceX's Falcon 9 rocket from NASA's Kennedy Space Center in Florida on September 16, 2021 and came back on 19 September
- Ford Motor has announced to close manufacturing plants in India due to the loss of more than USD 2 billion over the past 10 years
- Mahendra Singh Dhoni has been named as the Mentor of the Indian cricket Men's team for ICC T20 World Cup 2021.
- National Commission for Women (NCW) has launched country-wide capacity building and personality development program for women Undergraduate and Post graduate students
