### 6 September

- Max Verstappen won the Netherlands Grand Prix 2021 and reclaimed the Formula One championship lead from Lewis Hamilton.
- India's **Suhas Lalinakere Yathiraj** won silver medal of badminton SL4 category at **2020 Tokyo Paralympics.**
- Indian shooter Avani Lekhara led India's contingent at the Closing Ceremony of Tokyo Paralympics as the flag-bearer.
- The 1st meeting of the governing body of **Vatan Prem Yojana** was held at Gandhinagar under the chairmanship of **CM Vijay Rupani**.
- Former Union Health Secretary Keshav Desiraju passed away in Chennai.
- PM Narendra Modi has an approval rating of 70% which is the highest among 13 global leaders polled in the survey conducted by **The Morning Consult.**
- Tamil Nadu govt declared 500 sq.km of the biodiversity-rich waters in the Palk Bay as India's 1st dugong conservation reserve.
- Former President of International Olympic Committee (IOC) Jacques Rogge passed away.
- Australia's Northern Territory will host the biennial **AUSINDEX** maritime warfare exercises between the Royal Australian and the Indian navies.
- A **Myanmar** photographer won the top award at photojournalism's biggest annual festival for his coverage of the troubled nation's pro-democracy protests and bloody military crackdown

## 7 September

- Indian Navy and Royal Australian Navy (RAN) have kicked-off bilateral maritime exercise, titled as AUSINDEX 2021. Exercise was conducted for the first time in 2015.
- Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd (HPCL) has unveiled its branded store 'Happy Shop' in Mumbai marking its foray into non-fuel retailing.
- The 130th edition of Durand Cup has been kicked off at the Vivekananda Yubabharati Krirangan in Kolkata.
- **IIT Hyderabad** gets India's first building made of bio-bricks from **agro-waste** to counter air pollution caused by stubble burning
- Centre for Development of Telematics (C-DOT) has launched lab to design and develop a pan-India integrated alert system for disaster management on the occasion of its 38th Foundation Day.
- Ministry of Food Processing Industries is observing 'Food Processing Week' from September 6 to 12 2021, as a part of the celebration of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' to commemorate 75 years of India's independence.
- S Ramesh has been appointed as the Managing Director (MD) of Bharat Petro Resources Limited (BPRL).
- Former France footballer Jean-Pierre Adams (73 years) passed away at Hospital de Lyon.
- India Today Group has launched India's first and only good news channel, Good News Today (GNT) that recognizes that the news doesn't just have to mean bad news.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved loan of \$ 150 million (about Rs 1,095 crore) for a sustainable housing project for the urban poor in Tamil Nadu.

- Pacific Air Chiefs Symposium 2021 (PACS-21) was held in Hawaii at Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam from August 30 to September 2, 2021.
- Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India (TRIFED) in collaboration with Ministry of External Affairs is setting up an Atmanirbhar Bharat corner in 75 Indian Missions/ Embassies across the world in the next 3 months
- Culture Minister G Kishan Reddy has launched Bujurgon ki Baat-Desh Ke Saath programme in New Delhi
- Ministry of Coal has constituted Task Force and Expert Committee to Prepare Road Map for Coal based Hydrogen Production.
- Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has amended Income-tax Rules to ease authentication of electronic records submitted in faceless assessment proceedings
- Gujarat Govt has signed MoU with Amazon India to boost the export of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) sector for taking the local products of Gujarat to global markets
- First India–Japan High Level Policy Dialogue has been held virtually with discussion on issues like Air Pollution, Sustainable Technologies and Transports, Climate Change, Marine Litter, Fluorocarbons, COP 26, etc
- Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL) has won CII 'National Energy Leader' and 'Excellent Energy Efficient Unit' awards at National Award ceremony for 'Excellence in Energy Management'.

## 9 September

- Mumbai teen Ayaan Shankta (12 years) has been named as the 2021 International Young Eco-Hero for his project Conservation and Rehabilitation of Powai Lake.
- India's tallest air purification tower has been inaugurated in Union Territory of Chandigarh.
- World's largest plant designed to suck carbon dioxide (CO2) out of the air and turning it into rock started commenced its operation in Iceland
- El Salvador President **Nayib Bukele** plans to introduce a law that will make it the **world's first** sovereign nation to adopt bitcoin as legal tender.







- **HDFC Bank** has signed MoU with **National Small Industries Corporation** (**NSIC**) for providing credit support to micro, small and medium enterprise (MSME)
- Bhupender Yadav has launched a portal titled as 'PRANA' for regulation of air pollution in 132 cities across India.
- Uttarakhand Governor **Baby Rani Maurya** (64 years) has announced her resignation with effect from 8th September 2021, almost two years before completing her term due to personal reason.
- Cabinet Committee of security has approved the procurement of 56 C-295MW transport aircraft for Indian Air Force (IAF) and will make 40 aircraft in India within 10 years, while the rest will be delivered by Airbus from Spain.
- Jharkhand Assembly has passed 'The Jharkhand State Employment of Local Candidates in Private Sector Bill, 2021' to provide 75% reservation for locals in private sector jobs with a monthly salary of up to ₹40,000.
- PM Narendra Modi has launched Vidyanjali 2.0 portal during the inaugural conclave of 'Shikshak Parv'. Vidyanjali 2.0 is an amalgamation of the words Vidya meaning correct knowledge or clarity and Anjali meaning an offering with both hands in Sanskrit language.
- China has launched **24th Gaofen-series Earth-observation satellite** on Long March 4C carrier rocket from **Taiyuan Satellite Launch Center in Shanxi province.**
- Odisha govt has rolled out the revamped electronic receipt called e-Receipt 2.0 system, facilitating new modes of payment of taxes and other dues to the citizens.
- Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY) constituted taskforce consisting of officers of National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI) and Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) to improve internet connectivity in Karnataka.
