

## Maharashtra Population

- Maharashtra population in 2022 is assessed to be 12.57 Crores, according to UIDAI, updated 31, May 2020, by mid of the year 2020, the projected population is 123,144,223.
- Its second populated state in India after Uttar Pradesh, 9% of India's population live in Maharashtra.
- Maharashtra is the most economically progressive state in India, with a GDP value of \$390 million in 2018-2019, which shares around 15%. It's per capita of \$2500.
- As per Niti Aayog 2016 report, the Total Fertility Rate is 1.8.

### Maharashtra Population 2022

According to estimates, the population of Maharashtra in 2022 will be about 124,904,071.

- Estimated population of Maharashtra in 2022: 124,904,071
- Estimated population of males in 2022: 64,750,685
- Estimated population of females in 2022: 60,153,386

### Maharashtra Population 2011 Census

- Maharashtra has a sex ratio of 929 for every 1000 males, which is less than the nationwide average of 940 according to the 2011 census. In 2001, the sex ratio of females per 1000 males in Maharashtra was 922.
- The total area of Maharashtra is 307,713 sq. Km. Maharashtra has a 365 per sq km density, which is lower than the national average of 382 per sq km. In 2001, the density of Maharashtra was 315 per sq km, while in 2001, the national average was 324 per sq km.

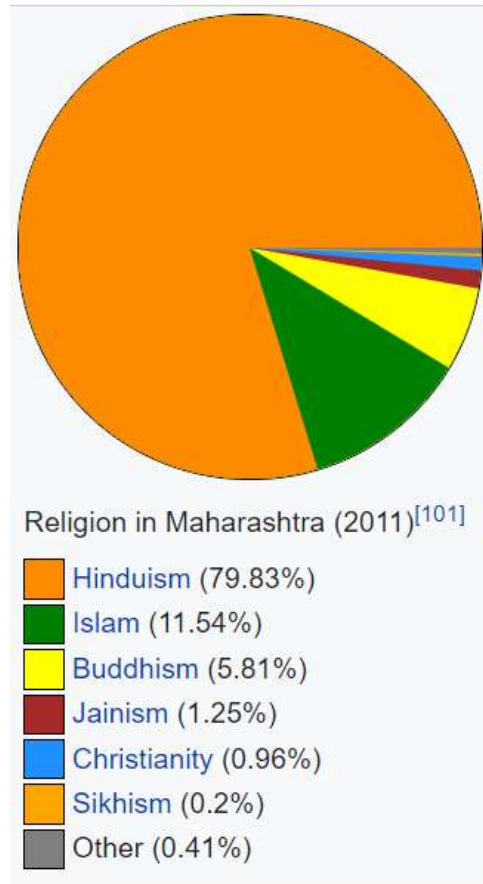

Hinduism is the majority religion in Maharashtra, with 79.83 % devotees. Islam is the second most popular religion in Maharashtra, with around 11.54 % following it. In Maharashtra, Christianity is followed by 0.96 %, Jainism by 1.25 %, Sikhism by 0.20 % and Buddhism by 0.20 %. Approximately 0.16 % stated 'Other Religion'.

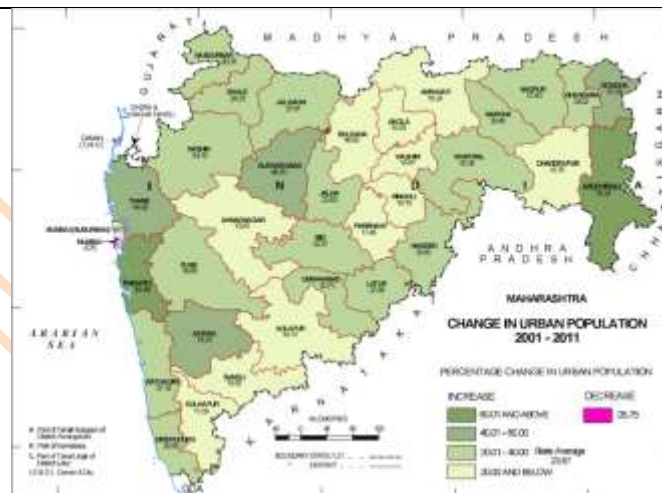

**Maharashtra Urban Population 2011**



- 45.22% of the total population of Maharashtra lives in urban areas. The total population of urban areas is 50,818,259, of which 26,704,022 are males, and the remaining 24,114,237 are females. In the last 10 years, the urban population has increased by 45.22 per cent.
- In urban Maharashtra, the sex ratio is 903 females for every 1000 males. For the (0-6) sex ratio of children, the figure for urban areas is 899 girls for every 1000 boys.

- The total number of children (aged 0-6) living in urban areas of Maharashtra was 5,637,563. Children (0-6) constitute 11.09% of the total population in urban areas.
- The average literacy rate for urban areas of Maharashtra was 88.69%, with male literacy of 92.12% and female literacy of 75.75%.
- The total number of literates in urban areas of Maharashtra was 40,071,529.
